

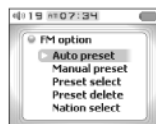


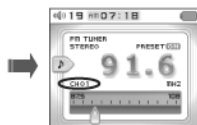
Auto Save

(yes/no)



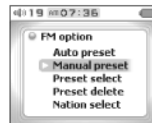
the frequency with stronger signals will be conditionally stored (up to 20 channels)


Manual Save

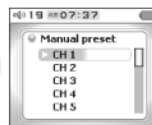
For example: When storing the channel (frequency) 91.6MHz into Ch01;

➡ using , select 'Manual Preset' mode



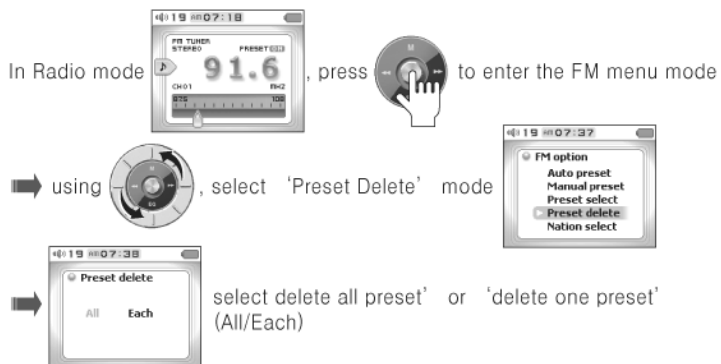
➡ using , store the frequency into Ch01

3. The earphone takes the role of antenna. Always connect the earphone into the device when trying to save channels.

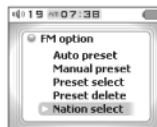



4. Programmed FM recording can be set in the Alarm mode in setting menus. (See P. 65)


6. Voice REC

-  press  to enter  press  shortly to record the voice
-  press  shortly to stop the recording and store the recorded file

1. Press  and hold in Audio mode (stop) to get into 'Rec. Ready' mode.
2. Recorded files are stored in MP3 format in the RECORD folder in the following sequence; VC001.MP3, VC002,MP3...
3. Bit rates for recording can be selected in setting menus 'Rec Setting' among 32, 64, 96 and 128kbps. (See P.68)
4. You may save the memory by recording only necessary parts with the aid of VOR function. (See P.68)
5. The recording will be interrupted when the memory gets full. The recorded voice source only is saved in the memory in this incident.
6. Sound quality may vary according to the distances from the sound source.
7. In the case where the power is not enough to run the device, the recording may not be performed correctly.

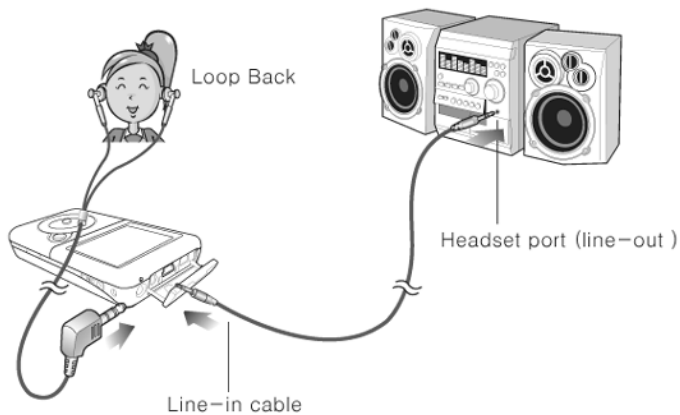

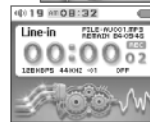

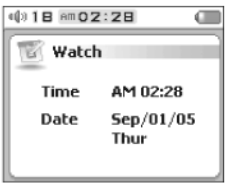
1. Analog sound signals can be converted to digital sound by recording the external audio sources with the Line-in cable supplied in the package.
2. Recorded files are stored in MP3 format in the RECORD folder in the following sequence ; AU001.MP3, AU002, MP3...
3. Bit rates for recording can be selected in setting menus 'Record Setting' among 32, 64, 96, 128 and 192kbps. (See P. 68)
4. When you record music, every single file can be created and stored automatically with the aid of ADT function.
5. You may adjust the input volume using  in the Pause/Stop mode. (See P. 68)
6. The recording will be interrupted when the memory gets full. The recorded voice source only is saved in the memory in this incident.
7. In the case where the power is not enough to run the device, the recording may not be completed correctly.
8. When the volume of the external sound source is too high or too low, the recorded sound quality can deteriorate.

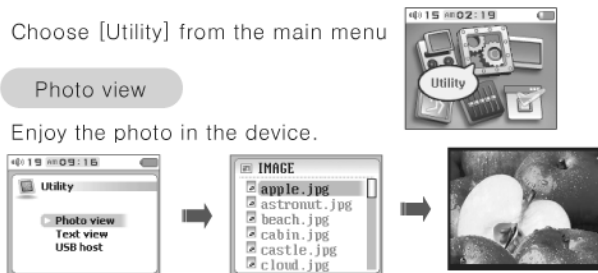

Note!

1. You can enjoy the photo file in the 'Navigation' instead of entering the menu. (See P. 27)
2. Press  and hold to start a slide show (press any key except  to release)
The interval for the slide show can be set in [Slide Show Time] in the Display Menu(P. 60)
3. The view speed for pictures can slow down if the music being played has a higher bit rate.
4. Use  to adjust the volume when enjoying the music file synchronously with the picture view.
5. Only the base-line type can be supported among JPEG types.
6. The optimum view size of a picture on the display is 160 by 128. A large size picture may result in a slow show-up.

Zoom in-out

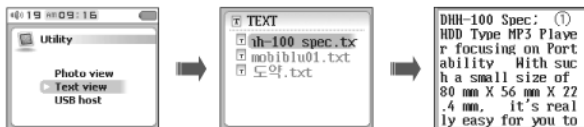
Use  to zoom in or out 2 to 9 times. Press  and use  to view a certain part of the picture.

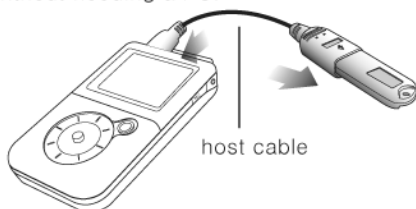

Choose [Utility] from the main menu



USB host

This enables you to connect between the MP3 device and an other audio device without needing a PC.



The power LED will turn on if the USB device has one.



Select ON
(not active if OFF is selected)



Note!

1. Disconnect the device only after setting to OFF otherwise the product may have a fatal error.
2. If the external audio device connected with the host consumes much electric current, the function of the host may deteriorate.
3. The function of USB HOST may be deteriorated when the power consumption of the external device connected with the host is too much or the nm battery is not enough.

For example: When trying to transfer “Bye Bye” from the external device to the device

Move to the external device' s folder

on the popup window ➡ enter the folder where you want to paste the file

1. It takes about one second to transfer 1MB. (USB HOST 1.1)
2. Only the files (mp3, wma, ogg, jpeg, txt, mpeg-4) supported by the USB host are displayed on the screen.

Brightness

The brightness of display can be set within the range below:



Brightness setting : 1~10

Scroll Speed

It enables you to set the streaming speed of file names.



Speed setting : 1~5

Slide Show Time

This is the interval time between the images for the 'Slide Show' .



Time setting: 1~10 seconds

Screen Off

The display will be off when the player has not been in use for a preset period of time.



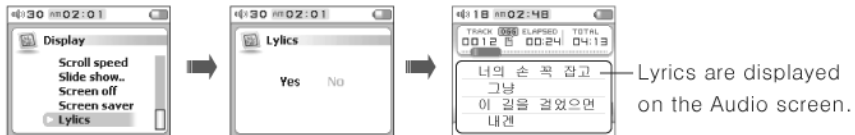
Screen Saver

Lyrics

It enables lyric streaming

1. Only marked files, by the LDB manager, support lyrics. (see enclosed instructions)
2. Lyrics are not available in the Pause/Stop mode.
3. Short cut: Press  and hold in Play mode to view lyrics

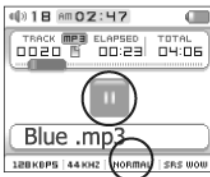
Choose 'Playmode' from the Main Menu.



1. Normal : All music files play once in sequence
2. Normal folder : The files in the current directory only play once in sequence

You can select REC menu options including FM, Voice and Line in.

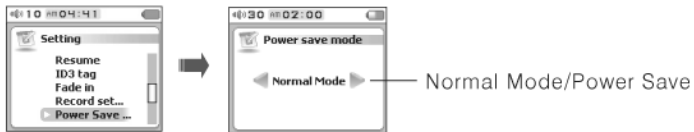


VOR : This enables you to only activate the recording when there is at least more than one sound source found in the peripheral area to save the memory space. (Off, Library, Office and Street)

1. Click on Transcoder following the insertion of the CD.



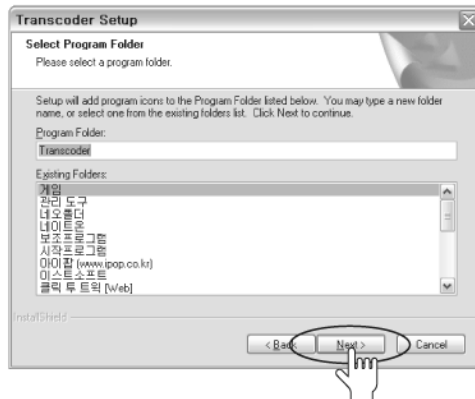

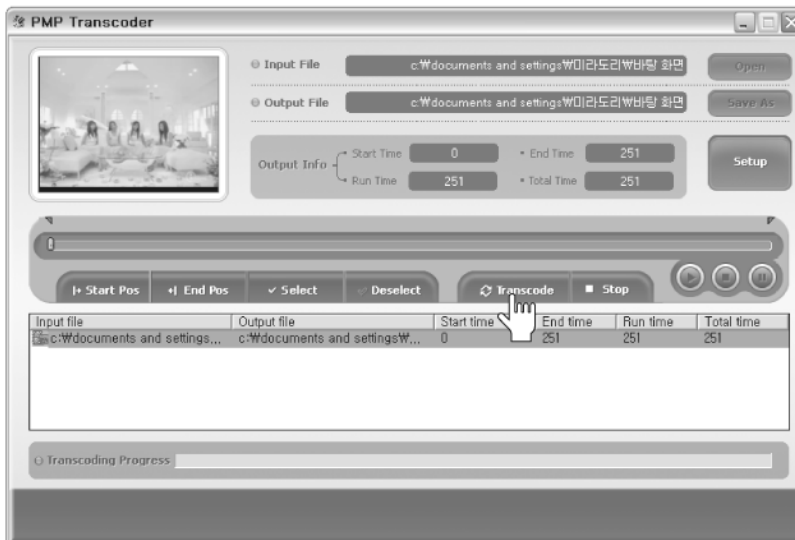

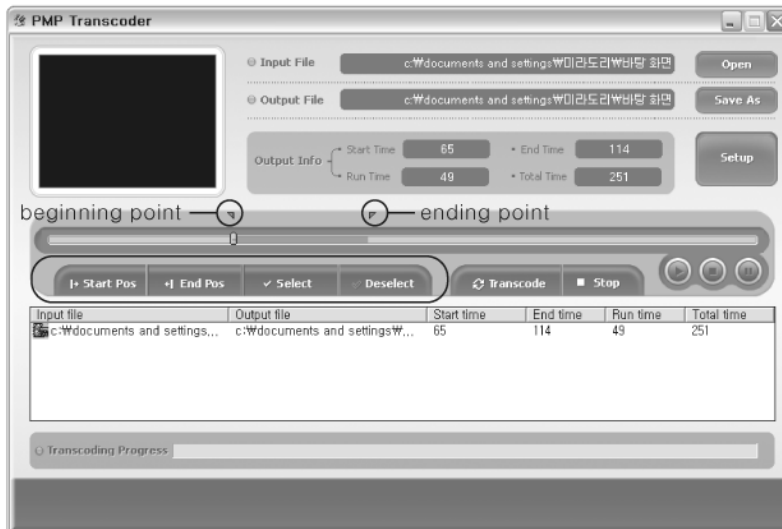
[Transcoding in process]

Sectioned File Conversion

Only a specified section in a file can be Transcoded.

File selection → File Play → shift Seek Bar to desired position

→ press **Start Pos** to set the beginning point → press **End Pos** to set the ending point → press **Select** to enter the section.
(press **Deselect** to cancel the section)



Converting Multiple Files

Multiple files can be transcoded at one try by selecting them in the window.

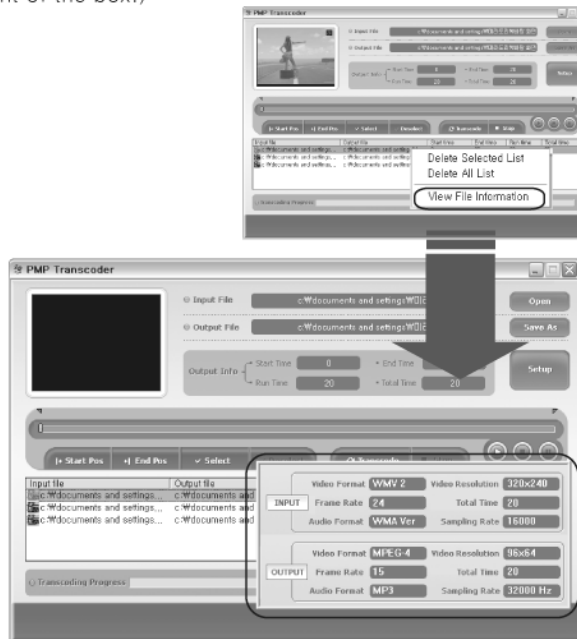
Use **Open** to select files → press **Transcode** to transcode the files

To cancel a registered file, click on the file in the List Box and choose Delete Selected List using the right mouse– button. Click on Delete All List in the box to cancel all registered files.



Viewing File Information

You can see file information by choosing View File Information by double-clicking on one of file lists with keys registered or by using the right mouse-button. (The file information dialog box will disappear when clicking on ESC or clicking on the top-right of the box.)



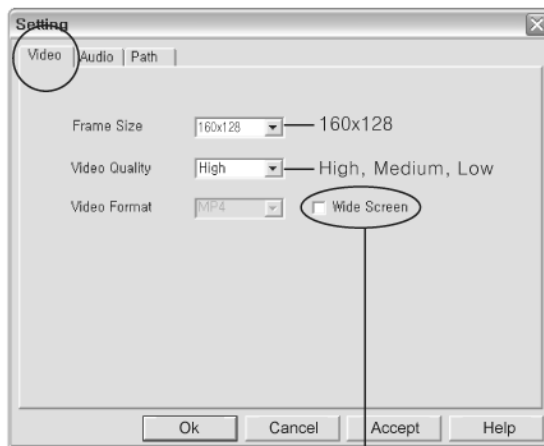

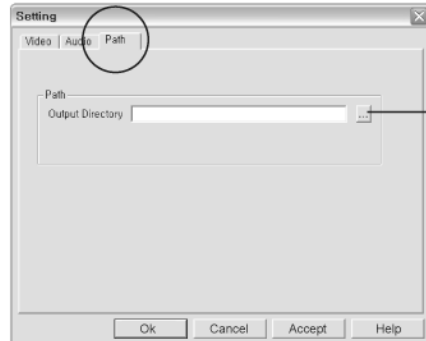
