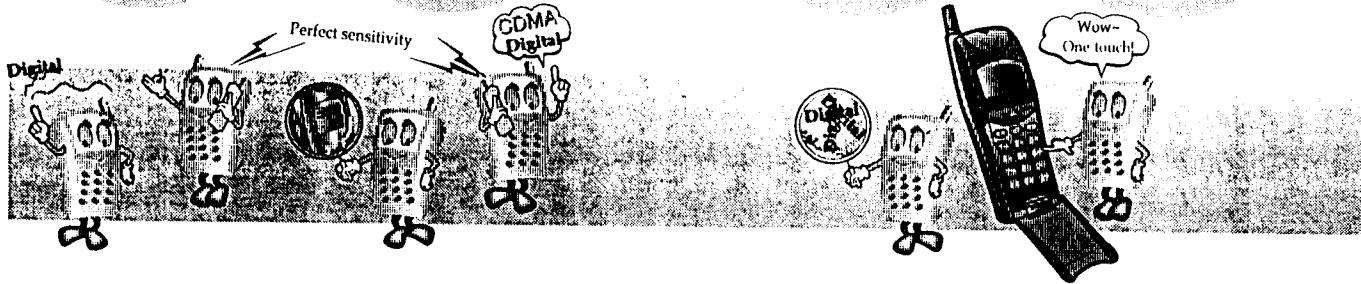

Avoid vibration and impact and keep the phone at a safe place to avoid damages when you do not use it.



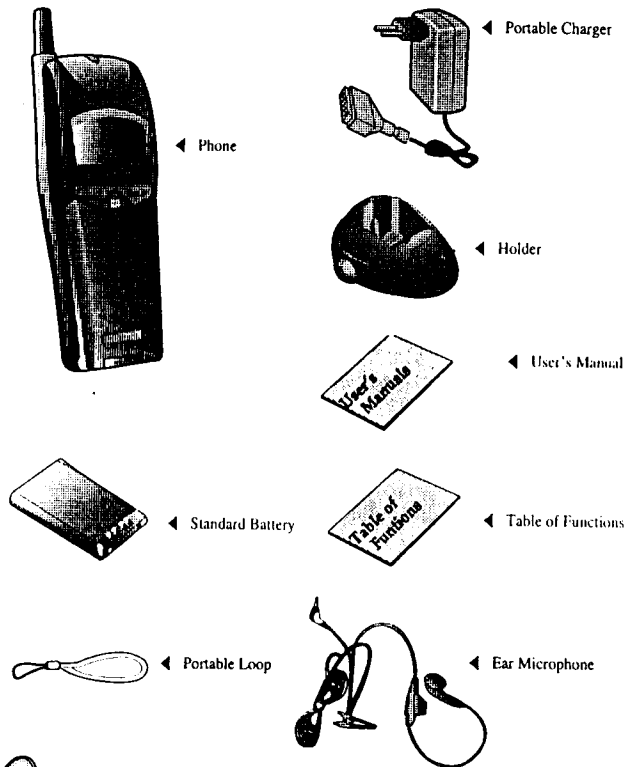

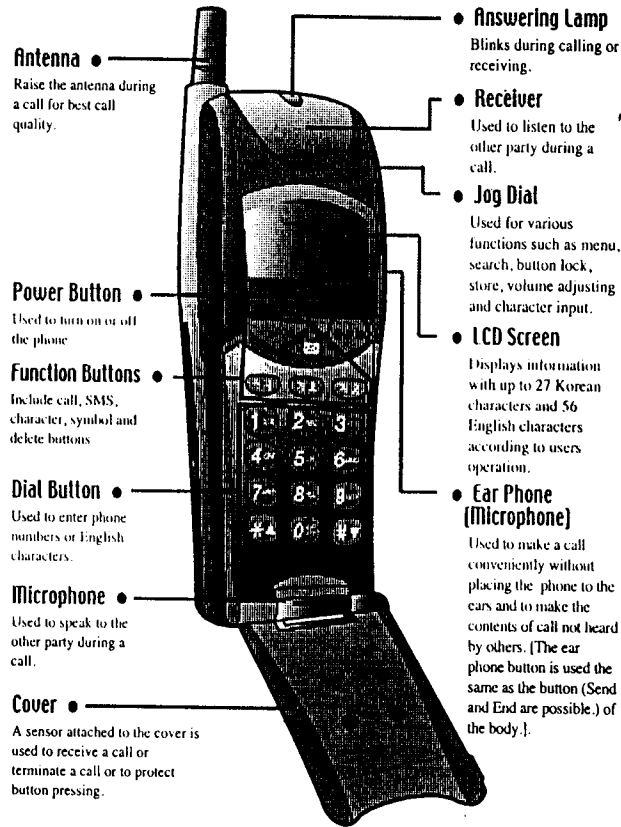

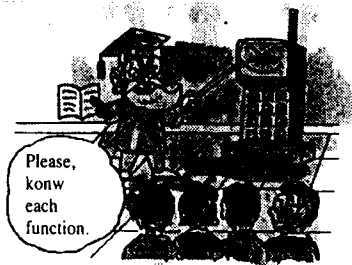

### Functions of Jog Dial


- 1 Jog Dial Push**  
 You can use this to set a function menu or to call a phone number.
- 2 Jog Dial Up**  
 You can search the function menus of the telephone book or calls according to the call history. Also, you can set the display speed to one or two steps (slow, fast).
- 3 Jog Dial Down**  
 Used to search names and numbers of the telephone book and to search the function menus. Also, you can set the display speed to one or two steps (slow, fast).
- 4** You can set/release the button lock by pushing the jog dial long when the cover is closed.

## Name and Function of Each Part


### Function Buttons

Used to enter a submenu or store the setting value and to make a call or receive a call.

## LCD Status Display and Function



### (Signal Strength)

The strength of the signal received is indicated with the number of bar(0~6).





### (Roaming)

Indicates that you are in other service area beyond your service area.



### (Service/No Service)

Indicated as  in a service available area and as  in a service unavailable area.



### (Busy)

Indicated during call attempt or calling.



### (Short Message Service)

Blinks when there are text or voice messages received.





### (Digital Mode)

Indicated during calling or standby in digital mode.



### (Ringer/Vibration Selection)

Indicated as  when the ringer mode is selected and as  when the vibration mode is selected.



### (Battery Power)

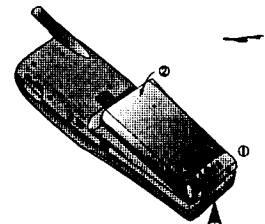

## Battery Installation and Removal

### Battery Installation

Adjust the battery to the battery installing mark as shown in ① and then press it tightly in direction ② until it snaps.



Battery Install Mark

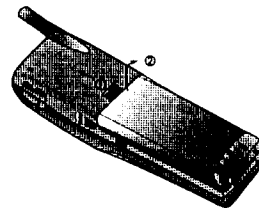


Verify that battery is properly installed as the phone may not work or the battery may be ejected in use if it is not installed tightly.

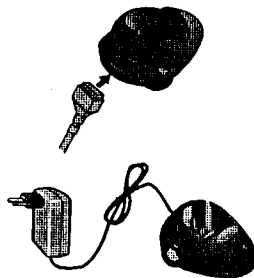
### Charging Progress Status

- The battery is not charged upon purchasing. Use the phone after charging it fully.

#### 1 Power Connection

Connect the jack of the portable charger into the connector on the rear side of the holder and then insert the power receptacle into the plug.

- The charger can be used free for 110V or 220V. After power on, the orange lamp blinks once.

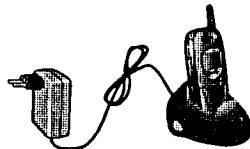


#### 2 Charging battery only

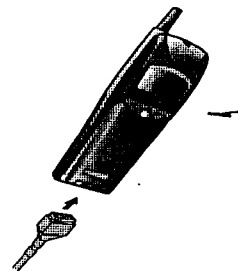

#### Charging during traveling

Connect the jack of portable charger to the connector at the bottom of the phone.

- Be sure to make a call and charge the phone with the portable battery installed.

#### Charging Completion

The red lamp turns on during charging and the green lamp is lighted after charging is completed.

- Charging time may be delayed or charging efficiency may be degraded if the phone is charged in power on state or with the portable charger.
- There is no influence on the phone or charger even it is left with the green lamp on.
- Please charge the battery if the alert tone sounds from the phone and a message Battery Low Power is displayed on the LCD.
- As the memory may be damaged if the power goes off after a message Power off by battery low power is displayed on the LCD, do not turn on the power but immediately replace the battery or charge the battery.



If the lamp does not turn on at all or the red lamp blinks, check the contact part of the battery. If it does not work normally after repeating the above 4-5 times, contact a near service center.

- As power consumption in active call state is more than in standby state, the standby time becomes short as the call time increases.
- Battery run time depends on environment condition such as temperature and charging state, habit of using the phone, radio condition at a service place and key pad lighting time selection.
- Digital continuous standby time may differ depending on the slot mode related service type of the mobile communication system of a service carrier.
- Slot mode means the communication cycle between the mobile communication system and the phone in digital continuous standby. The lower the slot mode is, the more frequent the communication is, so the shorter the standby time is as the power consumption increases.

As the battery is a consumable, the warranty period is six months.

## Efficient Use of Battery

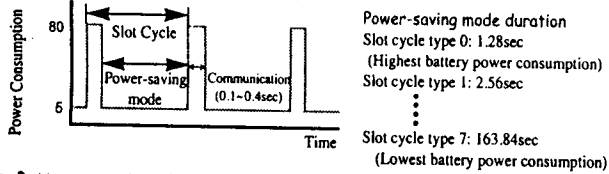
- Do not place the battery near fire and do not disassemble it and connect pins.  
There may be a danger of explosion.
- Do not give a strong impact to the phone nor drop it.  
Pay attention as the battery inside the battery pack may be adversely affected and its lifetime may be shortened.
- Be sure to use the specified battery and the dedicated charger.  
Be sure to use the specified ones as the body and the battery may be damaged or explode.
- As the battery is a consumable, the run time decreases slowly according to repeated charging/discharging.  
Purchase a new one if the run time decreases below a half compared with the battery provided upon purchasing.
- The phone or battery has a good charging efficiency at a normal temperature.  
Do not charge the battery at a place with direct rays of light or direct contact of heat from a heater or wind from an air conditioner.  
Charging efficiency will decrease if it is too hot or cold and charging will restart at a normal temperature.
- Keep the battery at a normal temperature.  
Capacity of the battery decreases and its lifetime becomes short if the battery is left in a car with the windows closed in summer or at a place too hot or cold for a long time.

## Slot Cycle

When a phone is in standby state, the system sends information required for the phone with the specified cycle. In this case, it is called that the phone operates in slot mode and the cycle is called slot cycle. Available slot cycle types are 0 ~ 7 and the phone works in a power-saving mode to reduce battery power consumption while it is not communicating with the system.

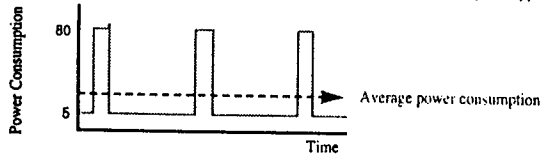


- Battery run time depends on slot cycle types which are used diversely according to service carriers and service areas.

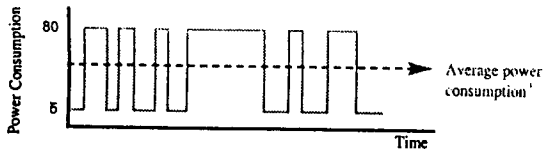
## Power Consumption in Various Service Environments

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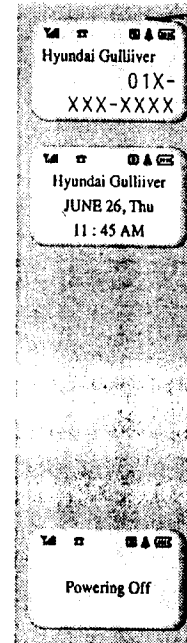
## Basic Operation of the Phone

### To turn on the phone




- 1 Press [  ] button until the lamp turns on.


- After power on of the phone, all indications (screen and indicators) will appear on the LCD for a while and disappear and then the message Hyundai Electronics HGC-900 and your phone number will be displayed in turn. Then, the receive field strength and battery voltage indicator will be displayed in turn. If you are in a no service area,  will be turns on.
- If the battery voltage is extremely low, the phone will go off immediately and, if very low, Battery Low Power will be displayed on the screen and the alert tone will sounds periodically.
- If the Lock Code? message is displayed on the LCD, as the phone is in lock state, enter a four-digit lock code to unlock it (Refer to page 97).
- An error message displayed on the LCD indicates a fault of the phone. Please contact a near service center in that case. (Emergency calls (Ex: 112, 113, 119) can be serviced even in lock state.)



### To turn off the phone

- 1 Press [  ] button until the lamp turns on again.



Be sure to turn off the phone using the [  ] button. call time, previous call and priority area code may not be stored normally if you turn off the phone by removing the battery.

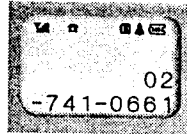
- In the event of abnormal operation during using the phone or power failure, remove the battery, install it again and then turn on the power.
- To turn off/on the phone, turn on the power after at least five seconds after power off.

## Basic Operation of the Portable Phone

### To make a call



**1** If is lighted on the LCD, please escape from the present area as you are in a no service area.

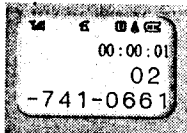


**2** Enter the area code and then a phone number.

- You can enter up to 32 digits for a telephone number. Ex) To call 408-7722 in Seoul, press 024087722.
- To correct a wrong number entered ([] Button)
  - Correct one digit: Press [] button short.
  - Correct all: Press the [] button longer than one second.

**3** Press [] button.

- will be lighted on the LCD and the phone number to be connected will blink. If the call is connected, call time will be displayed, otherwise Connection Fails message will be displayed.



**4** If the called party is busy, press [] button and then press [] button.

**5** Press [] button after the call is finished.

- To dial the phone number called last, adjust the [Jog] button up to display phone numbers by call history. Select a desired number and press the jog button. Then, the phone number will be displayed and the call will be connected if you repress the jog button again.

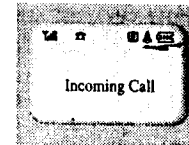


- To recall the phone number called last, press the [Send] button. (If the ear microphone is used, press the button of the ear microphone to connect a call and press the button again to disconnect the call. This operation is allowed even the cover is closed.)
- is lighted on the LCD, please escape from the present area as you are in a no service area.
- If automatic area code dial function is set, you need not enter the area code (Refer to page 65 for automatic area code dial function setting and release.)
- You can not make a call with collect call service (080).

## Basic Operation of the Portable Phone

### To receive a call

**1** The receive lamp blinks and the ringer rings.



- Refer to p.66 to change the receive mode (Ringer/Vibration/ Vibration + Ringer)
- Default receive mode upon purchasing is Ringer.

**2** The call will be connected automatically when you open the cover.

- You can connect the call by pressing [jog]/ [] [] [] buttons even the cover is closed.
- If you set the automatic answering function to receive calls automatically, the ringer will ring by the count specified and then the call will be connected automatically (Refer to p.69.)

**3** When the call is connected, and the call time will be displayed on the screen. Press the [] button or close the cover to terminate a call.

## Chapter 3

### Memory Function

When you use the memory function, you can store up to 500 numbers in the memory. You can also search for a number stored in the memory by using the memory search function. You can also delete, modify, and group the numbers stored in the memory.

The 1000 phone numbers that are supported by the phone are stored in the memory. The phone numbers are stored in the order of names (Korean/English) and numbers and the same information is not to be stored. (The memory stored in a group is displayed overlapped on the telephone number list screen of the group, but they are the same memory.)

## To store a phone number preferentially

You can store maximum 500 phone numbers frequently used in the memory and make a call fast and conveniently using various call methods. The phone numbers stored are automatically aligned in the order of names (Korean/English) and numbers and the same information is not to be stored. (The memory stored in a group is displayed overlapped on the telephone number list screen of the group, but they are the same memory.)



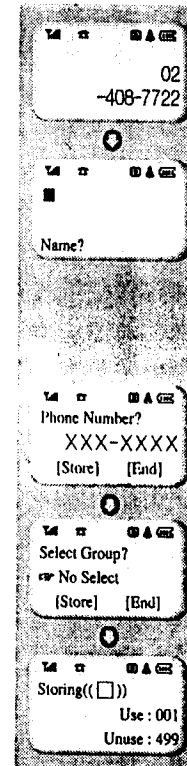
- 1 Press a desired phone number and then press [Character] button.
  - A message requesting a name entry will be displayed on the LCD.

If 500 numbers have already been stored when [Character] button is pressed, All memories were used will be displayed and the screen will return to the initial LCD.

- 2 Enter name.
  - Use the [Jog] button for a Korean name and use the dial button for an English name.
  - If you need not store the name, press the [Jog] button to store it directly.

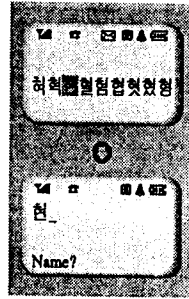

- 2** Press the [ ] button to enter the following characters.

## To store phone numbers automatically in the telephone book

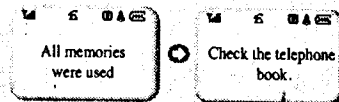
Call history for maximum 500 numbers is automatically stored in the telephone book. The history is stored based on outgoing calls and the identical information is stored just updating the call details. The call history is aligned in the order of call time in the telephone book.

- Press [▼] or close the cover after call is finished.

- Call details are automatically stored and the LCD automatically returns to the initial screen.
- If all of the 500 memories are used, the oldest one of the numbers not protected will be deleted automatically and the new number will be stored.
- In this case, the following alert message will be displayed.



- As it is impossible to store outgoing numbers if all of the 500 memories are used and coded or each memory has never attempted a call, a new phone number will not be stored. In this case, the following alert message will be displayed.





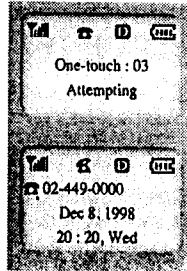
## To use the stored numbers

This section describes various methods to dial maximum 500 phone numbers stored in the telephone book.

### One-touch dialing function

You can assign the frequently used phone numbers to memory a location number 00-09 and directly dial the ten numbers designated without pressing [▼] button. (location number 00 is used for the international call function.)

- 1 Press the one-touch number longer than one second or dial the one-touch number and press the [▼] button to attempt a call to the phone number corresponding to the one-touch number.



- The content of memory assigned to the one-touch location number will be displayed on the screen and the number will be dialed automatically.
- If the number entered is not assigned to an one-touch number, Not assigned message will be displayed along with the one-touch number.
- If no number is entered in the memory assigned to an one-touch number, No number will be displayed along with the one-touch number.
- If the memory dial assigned to a one-touch number is stored with phone number hide function (Refer to P.52), the phone number will not be displayed but indicated as \*\*\*\*\*.
- If the area code automatic insertion function (Refer to p.65) is set, the area code will automatically be inserted into the number entered by one-two-touch dial. This function does not affect dial.

### Two-touch dialing function

You can assign the frequently used phone numbers to memory location number 10-99 and directly dial the 90 numbers assigned without pressing [▼] button.

- 1 Press the first digit of a memory number (10-99) short and the second digit long.

- The phone number of the memory location number will automatically be displayed on the LCD and the number will be dialed automatically.

## To use the stored numbers

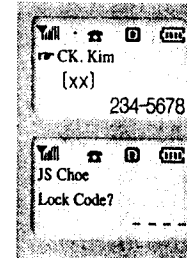
You can display the stored phone numbers including one-touch dialing and dial a desired number after checking the content of memory.

### Call after checking the content of one (two)-touch numbers



- 1 Enter a desired one-touch number on the initial screen.

- Allowed location numbers are 01 ~ 99.



- 2 Press the [Jog] button to display the detailed information on the phone number assigned to the specified number.

- If a phone number is not assigned to the specified number, One-touch: XX not assigned will be displayed and the LCD will return to the initial screen.

- If number modification or additional input is required after name modification, press the [Character] button. Then, the LCD will automatically return to a LCD to enter a number.

3 Select a desired setting value using the [Jog] button or scroll button and then press the [Jog] button.

- Yes : Overwrite with the modified phone number.
- No : Store the modified phone number in a new address



## To manage the stored phone numbers by groups

This section describes how to register or cancel a group or change a group name when the phone numbers stored in the telephone book are managed by groups such as business group, friend group, etc. Basically, six groups are supported and each group can contain maximum 30 phone numbers or less depending on memory registration condition.

- "Recognizing" message will be displayed on the LCD and then the registered voice will sound.
- ✖ Pronounce it same as the first as much as you can.
- ✖ If the voice is not recognized, the recorded voice will not sound and "Please start again" message will sound.



- 7 "Storing" message will be displayed and then "Registered" message will sound.

- The LCD automatically returns to the telephone book screen after storing the voice.

- 8 To cancel the voice dial of a selected phone number, press the [Jog] button on the Voice Dial menu in step (4).

- If the voice dial has been registered, "Voice Dial Registered" will be displayed.
- Select a desired setting value using the [Jog] button and press the [Jog] button.
- Yes: Cancel the voice dial set of the phone number and return to the telephone number list screen.
- No: Return to the detailed information on phone numbers screen without canceling.



If a voice dial is registered, "Voice Dials" will automatically be created. A voice dial group contains just the memories stored as voice dials. If voice dials are selected from the phone number list, detailed information on the phone number memories will be displayed and the voice registered will be regenerated. The memories registered for "Voice Dials" can be included in other group. (For example, a number can be included in "Voice Dials" and "Friend 1" group.)

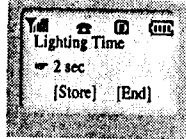

### Button screen lighting function

This function controls the key-pad lighting time, so that you can easily use the portable phone in a dark place.

- 3 Enter the lock code of four digits.
  - The default lock code is 0000 on delivery.

  - Yes: When power on the phone, the phone is locked.
  - No: The phone is not locked.

When the automatic lock function is set, "Lock Code?" is displayed on the LCD whenever you power on and the lock function is executed. Therefore, you cannot make a call except receiving a call. When you enter the lock code of four digits, the lock function is released and you can use the phone. However, when you power on after off, the phone goes to the lock state.



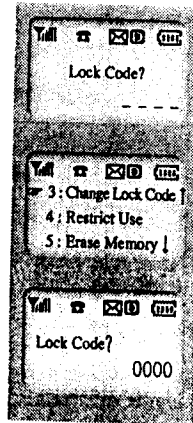

Alert tone sounds (call failure tone) when making a call.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>There is no call channel nor communication with a base station.</li> <li>Repress (Send) button after ending, then the number will be redialed automatically.</li> </ul>
When powering on, "Lock Code?" is displayed and making a call is not possible.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Unlock the phone.</li> <li>Refer to P.97 for unlocking the phone.</li> </ul>
The use time of battery is different from that of manual.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Since the battery is a kind of supplies, its use time gets shorter than that of new product.</li> <li>When placing at low or high temperature, the use time may be changed.</li> </ul>
The phone does not turn on even though the battery is enough charged.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Reinsert the battery into and power on the phone.</li> <li>Clean the contact terminal of battery and phone.</li> </ul>
