How to Set Multi-Screen [Input Source/Position/Size]

This is to set the Input Source, Position and Size of the Sub-picture



Press Up and Down buttons to move to "SOURCE".

Press Left and Right button, then source changes in order below.

In case of PIP mode, go to step 9 if you need to set the "SWAP" of Main and sub pictures.



Press Up and Down buttons to move to "SWAP".

Press Left and Right buttons to set to "ON/OFF".



In case of PIP mode, go to step 11 if you need to set the "SIZE" of Sub picture.



Press Up and Down buttons to move to "SIZE".



Press Left and Right buttons to set to "LARGE/SMALL".



In case of PIP mode, go to step 13 if you need to set the "POSITION" of Sub picture.





Press Up and Down buttons to move to "POSITION".



Press Left and Right button, then position changes in order below.





How To Directly Select S. MODE: Press



- If the receving conditions deteriorate, Listening will be easier if the mode is set to the Mono.
- If the stereo signal is weak and automatic switching occurs, then switch to the mono.

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Storing channel Automatically

You can scan channels available to you and availablity depends on your country. Automatically allocated programme numbers may not correspond to actual or desired programme numbers. However you sort number manually and clear any channels you do not wish to watch.



Press Menu button.

Menu items appear on the screen.



Press Up and Down buttons to move to "CHANNEL" icon.



Press Left and Right button to select "CHANNEL".

Assigning Names to Channel

Channel names will be assigned automatically when channel information is broadcast. These name can be changed, allowing you assign new names.

Skipping Unwanted Channels

You can exclude the channels of your choice from the channel scan operation. when you scan through the stored channels, those that you have chosen to skip are thus not displayed. All channels that you do not specifically choose to skip are displayed during scanning.

This operation allows you to change the program number of stored channels. This operation may be necessary after using auto store.



Press Up and Down buttons to move to "SORT".



Press Left and Right button to select "SORT".





Press Up and Down buttons to move to "FROM".





Press Left and Right button to select the channel that you wish to move.





Press Up and Down buttons to move to "TO".




Press Left and Right button to select the Number of the program to which the channel is to be moved.

Activating the Child Lock

This feature allows you to lock the television so that it cannot be controlled by manaul keys. It can however still be controlled by the Remote Control. Thus by keeping the Remote Control away from unauthorised users such as children, you can prevent them from unsuitable programme.



Press Up and Down buttons to move to "CHILD LOCK".

Press Left and Right button to select "CHILD LOCK".

Child Lock menu appears.





Press Up and Down buttons to move to "CANNEL".



Press Left and Right button to select the required Channel.

Teletext Feature


Most TV channels provide written information services via teletext. Information provided includes with the next entry it is same :

- TV programme times
- News bulletins and weather forecasts
- Sports results
- Travel information

Teletext information is often divided between several pages displayed in sequence, which can be accessed by :

- Entering the number
- Selecting a title in a list
- Selecting a coloured heading (FASTEXT SYSTEM)
- Travel information

Teletext OSD(On-Screen-Display) Picture






Displaying the Teletext Information

- Information maybe missing or some pages may not be displayed.
