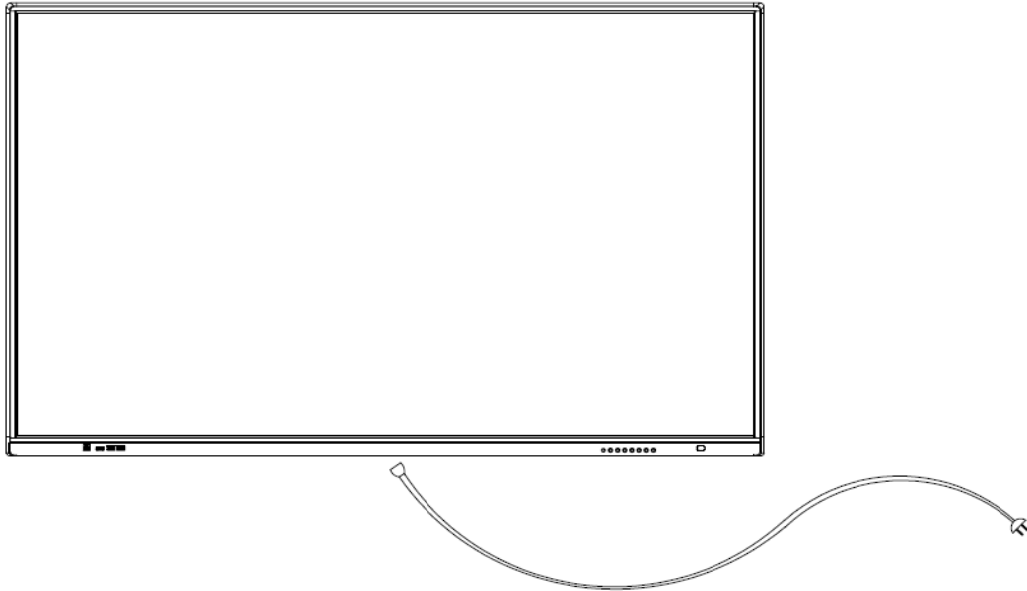

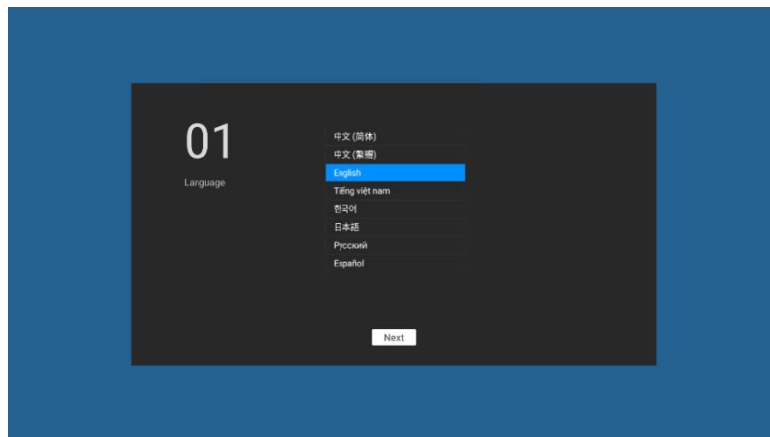
1.Connect the AC power cable to Power socket , Set the AC power switch on



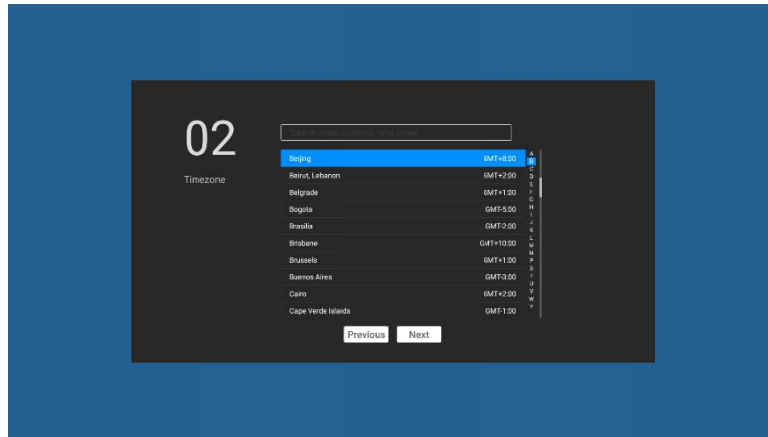
2 . Press Power button , start to boot the device.



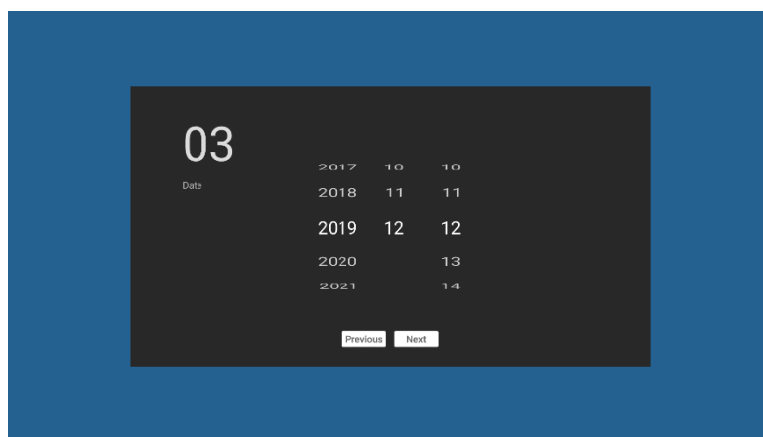

Touch white board ICON, start the app.

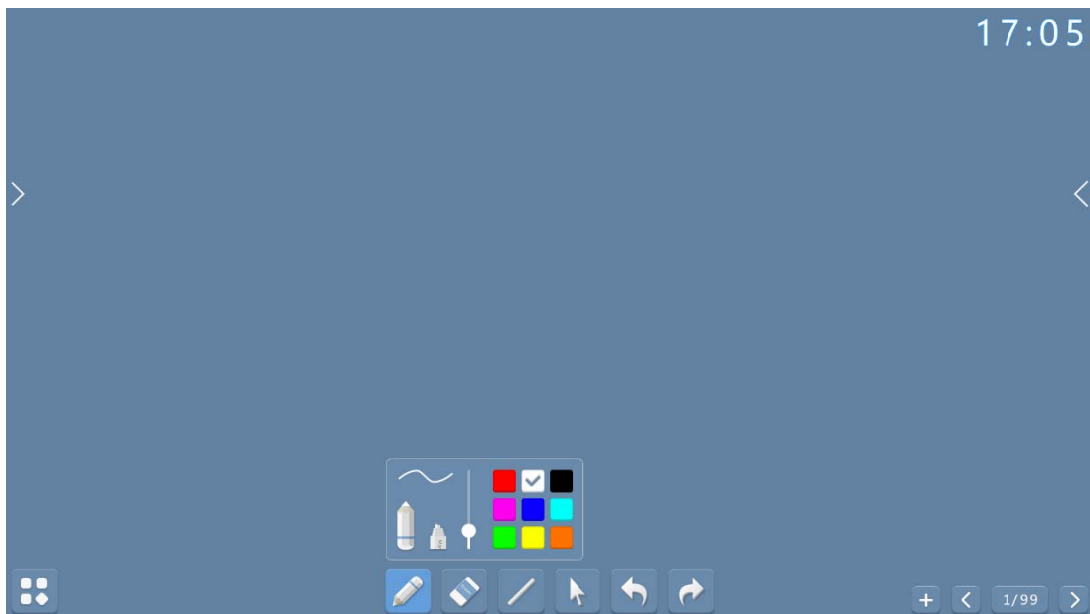


White Board tool

Select the “pencil” tool, start to write. In pencil menu you can set the line’s thickness and color.

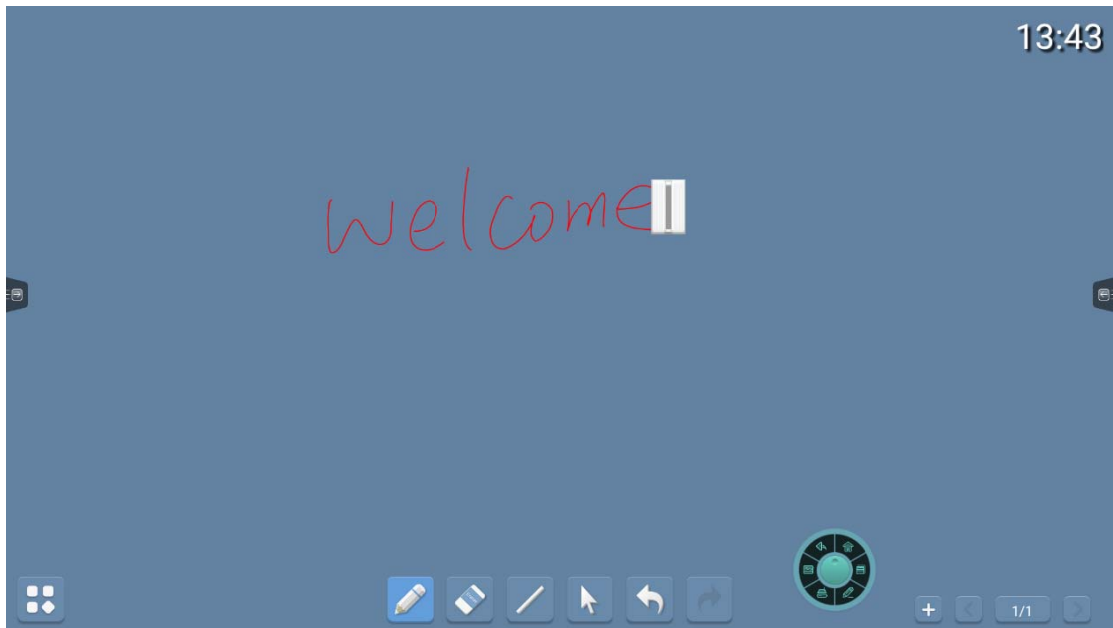
You can also change common pen to mark pen.



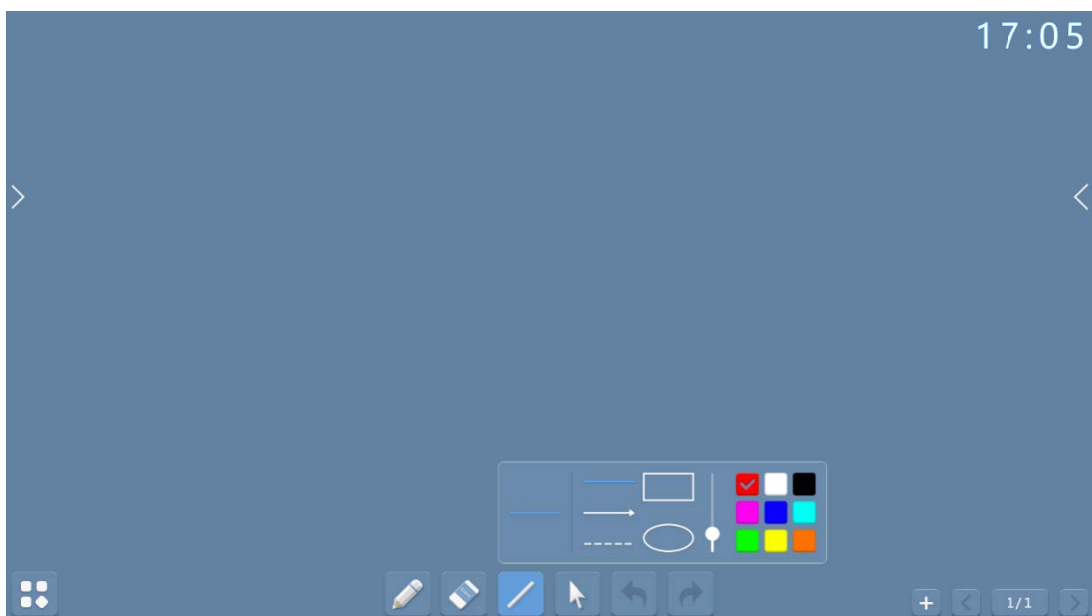
Select the “eraser” tool to erase the content, you can choose “erase all” or part of them

Touch object tool icon , white board will enter a “choose” mode. Circle the content, and you can move it.

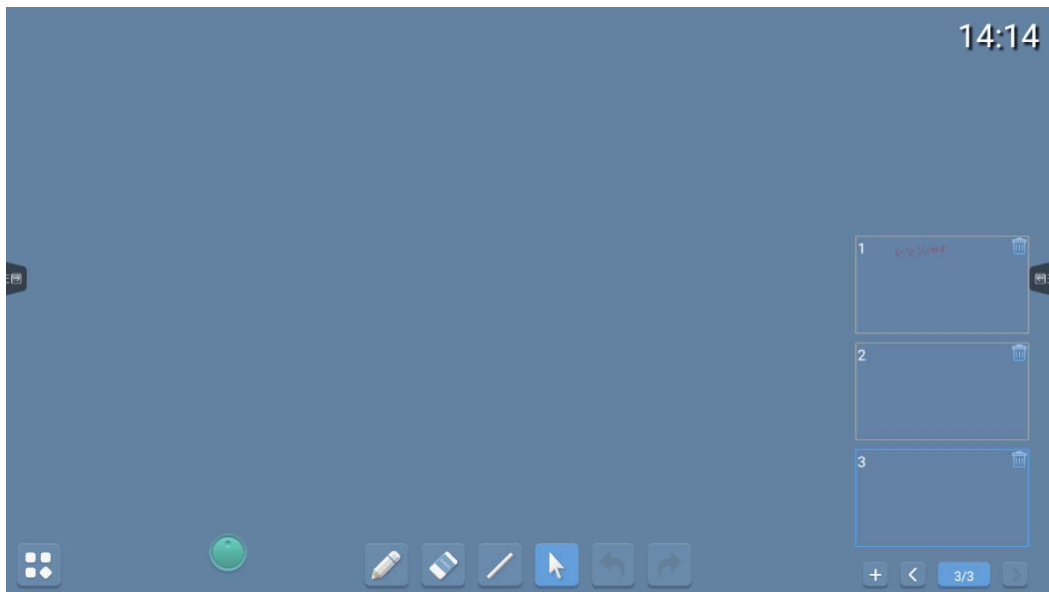
Touch undo icon , back to last status, max undo times ≤ 10 .

Add and Delete pages

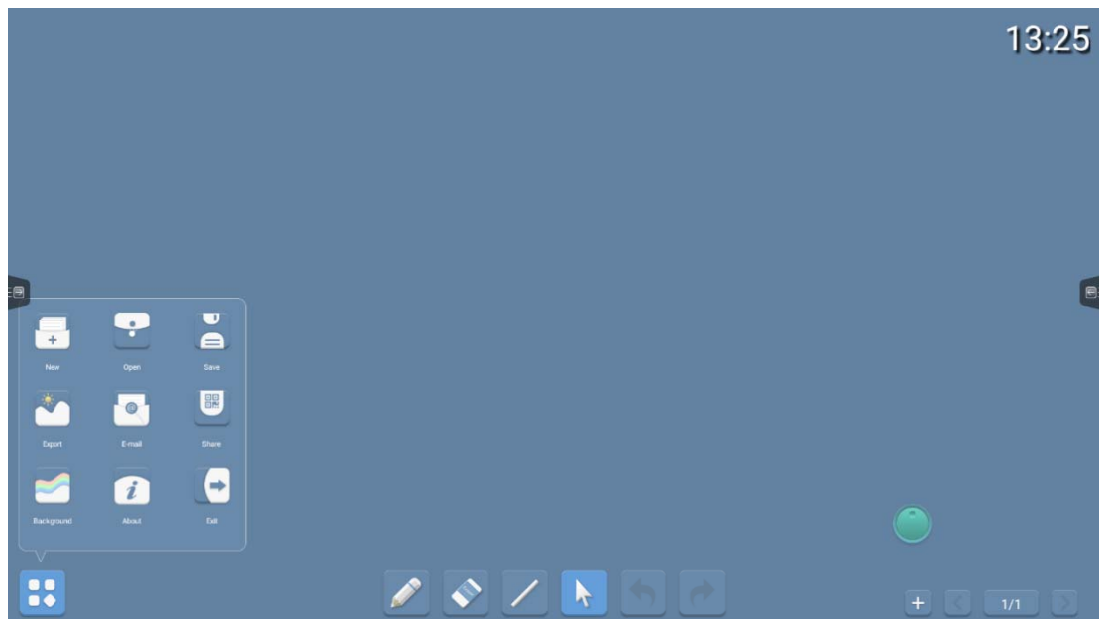
Touch icon “” to add pages, touch icon “” to delete pages, slide to select

In this menu you can save a record file, export to storage , send by email, share by QR code, change the background, and so on.



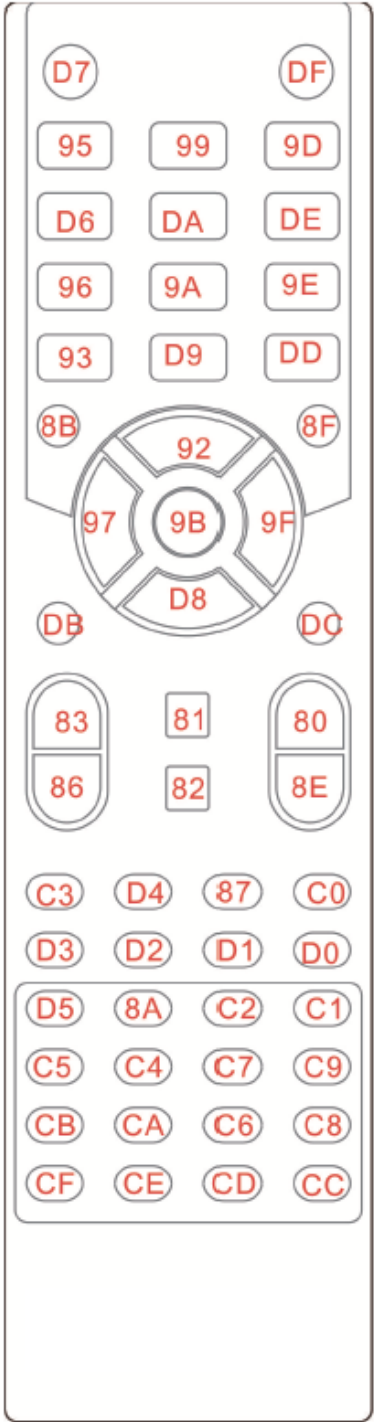
Note Tool
