

- MP3, short for MPEG-1, AUDIO LAYER 3 (an standard referred to as the Moving Picture Experts Group), digital audio is a compression algorithm that achieves a compression factor of about 12:1 while preserving sound quality. MP3 is an open format for making large music files smaller without radically degrading their audio quality. It is widely recognized components of the Internet. as the most popular format for storing music on the World Wide Web and other aucio subset of an industry
- In addition, it is an efficient way to store music or other audio content on your computer. MP3 files can be anywhere from 1/4 to 1/20 the size of a commercial CD audio file, while retaining a high sound quality. These files have the extension of \*.mp3 and can be downloaded from the internet. They can also be converted for personal use from your library of favorite CD's.
