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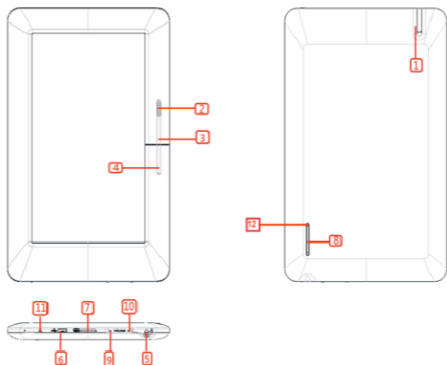

- 1. Power button** – Press and hold for 3 seconds to turn on.
- 2. Return button** – Press once to return to previous menu.

3. **Previous pg button** – Press to turn to previous page.
4. **Next pg button** – Press to turn to next page.
5. **Earphone jack**
6. **USB jack**
7. **Micro SD cart slot** –Insert Micro SD card into it.
8. **Speaker** – A loudspeaker, do not block this area during music/video playback.
9. **Volume+ keys**– Press to increase the volume.
10. **Volume– keys**– Press to decrease the volume.
11. **LED indicator** – when the reader is being charged, red light is on, when fully charged, the red light will go out.
12. **Reset button**

Power On and Off the Reader

- Press and hold the Power button for 32

seconds to turn the reader on.

- It may take a moment for the reader to turn on and load.
- Press and hold the Power button for 3 seconds to select **Power off**, then it will appear a confirmation window, tap **OK** to turn off the reader.

Charging the Reader

- You need to charge the reader prior to use it for the first time or when battery power is low.
 - Charge the reader using AC adapter with output 5V, 1.2A.
 - Charging through PC may not be able to fully charge the reader due to the low output charging current from PC USB port.
 - Please turn the Reader to standby mode to shorten the charging process.
-
- It will take about 6 hours to fully charge the reader in standby mode (LCD off)
 - When DC /USB power cable is connected to the reader for charging, the reader will enter into standby mode after remains idle for 60s. Press the [Power] button to wake up the reader.

Transferring Contents

From Computer

- The Reader supports USB Mass Storage Device function.
- To import contents (ebooks, video, audio, photo etc) into the reader, connect the reader to PC via the supplied USB cable.
- Upon successful connection to PC, the reader will enter USB mode and all operation will be halted.

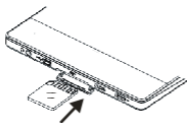
- Go to [My Computer], double click on the reader's disk to open.

From memory card

This unit supports Micro SD card up to 16GB

To insert a Memory card

Insert the card correctly with its label facing up until it clicks into the place. You may damage the card and the reader if Micro SD card is not inserted correctly.





- To remove Micro SD card, push the card once again until it clicks.
- When a Micro SD card is inserted in or ejected from the reader, it may take few seconds for the reader to update the content.
- Please avoid inserting or ejecting Micro SD card when other operation is running as this may cause the system hang.
- Do not remove the card if the content inside the card is being played. This will halt the operation of the reader and cause the reader to restart.
- If the system is not responding, press the Reset button to reset.

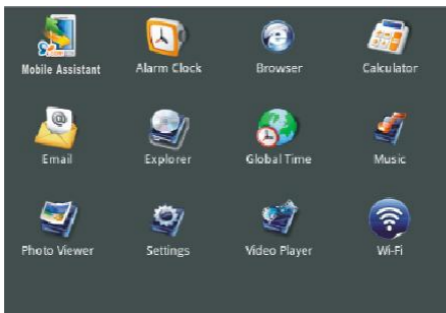

Once you've joined a Wi-Fi network manually, it automatically connects to it whenever the network is in range.

Switching Screen orientation

Screen orientation can be set to vertical, horizontal.

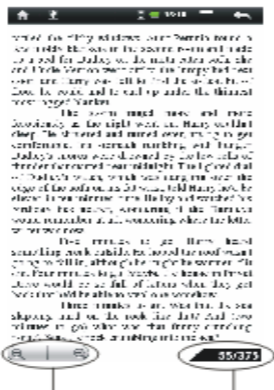

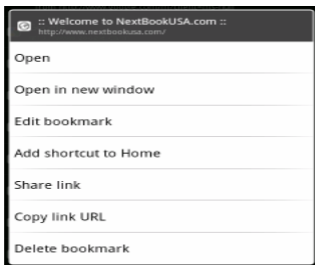

3. Tap **OK** to confirm.

Delete a file or folder

1. In the file list, long press the desired file or folder to show the edit menu, select **Delete** to display a message window..

Importing DRM Contents

The Reader supports Adobe DRM contents. Adobe Digital Editions (ADE) is required.

On computer

Installing Adobe Digital Editions (ADE)

- The ADE installer is preloaded into the Reader.
- Connect the Reader to PC via the supplied USB cable and open the reader as removable disk. Go to [My Computer], double click on the reader's disk to open.
- Make sure your computer is connected to internet
- Double click on the [digitaleditions_172] file to open the installer.

- For first time user, you will need to get a free adobe ID from adobe website. click on the [get an Adobe ID online] link as illustrated:



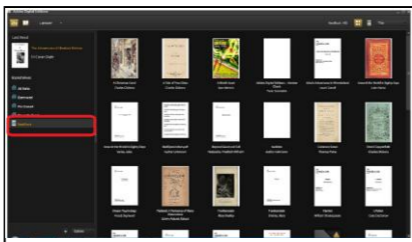
- Enter your email address and complete the online form as per instructed.

Authorizing PC and Reader

- Upon registration, return to the ADE window. Enter the username and password to activate your Adobe account.
- After activation, connect the Reader to PC. ADE will detect the Reader and you are prompted to authorize device.
- After authorization, you will be able to find the Reader recognized in ADE as below.⁴⁶

Contents inside the Reader will be displayed on the right hand windows.



- You can now start downloading or buying ebooks from online Ebook stores supporting Adobe DRM.
- Purchased or downloaded ebooks will be stored in [My Digital Editions] in [My Documents].

Transferring DRM ebooks to Reader

- From ADE menu, click on [All Items] on the left hand column
- Items in [My Digital Editions] will be listed down in right window.

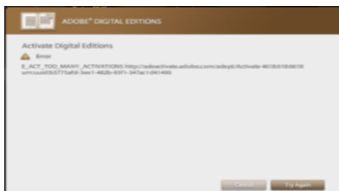
Notes For using ADE

Each ADE ID supports only 6 devices, this includes the master device (the reader) and the slave device (Micro SD card).

When the reader is restored to default settings, ALL DRM activation record and data (including DRM books purchased) will be erased from the reader. You are required to authorize the device with your ADE ID again.

When the number of authorized device has exceeded the allowable amount, you will come across the following error message:

To request for extension and reset of your ADE ID, go to <http://www.adobe.com/support/digitaleditions/> → [Submit a web case]. You are required to key in your ADE ID info.

On the reader

- Upon registration, from the homescreen, tap **ADE** to enter online ebook store specified by the user.
- Start downloading or buying ebooks from online Ebook stores supporting Adobe DRM.
- Purchased or downloaded ebooks will be stored in the BK7005 ebook reader.

Note: If you use the reader for the first time, please enter the adobe ID and the password to enter the store.

Limitations with NTFS file system:

- Books in the card are not recognized by ADE when connected to PC.
- Direct copy of files from internal memory to card is not supported.

Managing third party applications

This unit support third party applications (such as MSN, etc.), you can install or uninstall applications for the system.

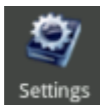
Download and install the application

- 1、 Download the desired application .
- 2、 Copy the downloaded application to the unit (note: The system only supports XXX.APK format).
- 3、 Disconnect this unit from the computer.
- 4、 On the homescreen or Main menu, tap **Settings**→**Application**→**unknown source**.
5. Find the directory where the application is installed to tap to start the installation.
- 6、 After finishing the installation, you will see the Applications on the Main menu.

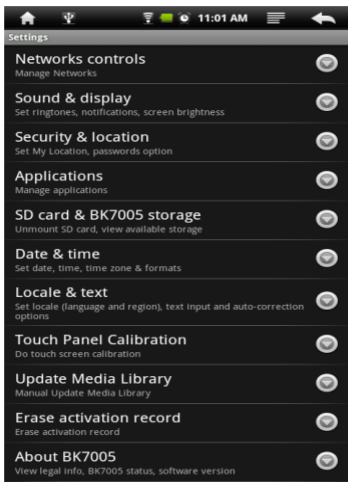
Uninstall application

If more than one previously used network is in range,

BK7005 joins the one last used.When BK7005 is connected to a Wi-Fi network, the Wi-Fi icon at the top of the screen shows connection strength.

Sound and display

Customize the sound /display settings.

Sound settings: Silent mode, Notification volume, Media volume, Notification ringtone, Micro SD card notifications, motor switch.

Display settings: Orientation, Animation, Brightness, Screen timeout.

Security and location

Set your location sources and passwords option.

Applications

Manage the application installed on the unit, including unknown source applications, installed applications, application development.

Micro SD card & BK7005 storage

View the memory status of Micro SD card and MID, format Micro SD card memory and restore the settings to factory value.

Date & Time

Set date, time, time zone and display format.

Note: Time zone setting is needed to calculate the expiry duration for book borrowing / returning.

Locale and text

Set region and language, text input and auto-correction options.

Touch Panel Calibration

Allow you to do touch screen calibration. Use your finger to carefully press and hold on the center of target briefly. Repeat as the target around the

Update media library manually.

Erase activation record

Erase all the activation records. you can use this function if you want to re-authorize the device.

About BK7005

Display the information about BK7005, such as legal info.,product status, software version and so on.

Chapter 4 Troubleshooting

If the reader does not function as it is expected, please try the following steps.

The Reader is not responding or can't be turned on.

- Reset the reader by pressing the reset button at the bottom. The reader will be forced shutdown if it is on and you are required to restart the reader again.
- Battery has been fully depleted. Please charge the reader via USB or USB AC Adapter.

Battery Life seems short

- The operating temperature is below 5°C. this is due to the characteristics of battery and not a malfunction
- The battery is not used for prolonged period. Please recharge the battery of the reader again
- The battery is not fully charged. Please charge the reader for 4 hours.
- The battery needs to be replaced. Please consult the authorized dealer for service.

Chapter 4 Troubleshooting

The reader cannot be operated during USB connection

- The reader cannot be operated while it is connected to PC.
- Eject the reader from computer to resume operation.
- To use the reader while charging, click on the [Safely Remove Hardware] button located on the left lower corner to disconnect data connection with computer. After the reader is safely removed, computer will only charge the reader and you can now resume normal operation.

Touch screen problem

If the touchscreen does not respond, use the "calibrate the touch screen" function to calibrate the screen.

Maintenance

- If reader does get wet, turn off reader immediately. Wait for reader to dry completely before turning on again.
- Clean the screen with a soft cloth; be careful not to wipe it with anything abrasive. When carrying your reader in bag, keep reader in the protecting case supplied to avoid scratches
