Please read the entire guide before beginning the installation and follow all steps as described. Please keep this manual for future reference.






A CAUTION!

24 hours is required for all adhesives to completely cure and reach full adhesive strength. Please do not use the products immediately after the placement of the adhesive.


Part 1: Recoiler Installation




Clean the fixture with the alcohol wipe provided. Let it dry completely.




Peel the liners from the adhesives on the bottom of the recoiler



Optional: If routing the cable across a fixture, press the power cable down into the channel on the bottom of the stand.




Optional: If desired, route the cable through a hole or slot in the fixture.



Place the recoiler in the desired location and apply pressure for at least 10 seconds.

Part 2: Tether Installation



Remove the pin cover from the fob tool.




Insert the pin into the hole opposite of the cable.




Pivot the fob tool back to remove the retainer.

Note: Be careful not to lose the clip when removing.




Remove the sleeve and separate the upper and lower halves of the stylus clip.




8 Pull the tether from the recoiler.




Place the end of the tether into the channel at the back of the bottom stylus clip.




Prepare the stylus for installation into the clip by making sure that it is clicked open.



With the S-Pen clicked open, place it into the cavity of the bottom stylus clip piece. The button on the S-Pen should face upwards.




Orient the sleeve cover so that the gap will align with the cable. Slide the cover up the length of the S-Pen and over the 2 pieces of the stylus clip



Insert the retainer into the hole on the sleeve cover and through the bottom piece of the clip. It should sit flush when properly assembled.




Place the S-Pen into the display.




Place the top half of the stylus

clip over the S-Pen and tether.


Plug the power cable into a power supply.



Plug the power supply into a power outlet.



When docked, the LED on the tray will illuminate Blue. It will change to Red when the S-Pen is lifted.



If the S-Pen loses Bluetooth connection with the device, insert a small pin tool (such as a paper clip) into the hole to press the button to reestablish the connection. Make sure that the S-Pen is correctly docked in the tray

Part 3: Removal




Insert the pin fob tool into the hole next to the cable.




Pivot the fob tool back to remove the retainer.


Note: Be careful not to lose the clip when removing.



Slide the sleeve off the pen and separate the upper and lower halves of the stylus clip.



Unplug the power supply from the outlet.

Use the scraper removal tool (DNTX93) to break the adhesive bond between the recoiler and fixture.
