1. Overview

This document describes how to use the 228-2621 900 MHz VEX Radio Module.

2. Operation

Start with the 228-2530 VEX Controller or 228-2540 VEX Robot Brain turned off. Connect the Radio Module to the VEX Controller or Robot Brain by sliding it in to the radio socket. Power will be applied to the Radio Module when the host device is turned on. Radio Module operation is based on commands from the host.

3. FCC / Industry Canada Compliance Information

FCC Compliance Statement (United States):
