






# Power On

- Connect power from adaptor to wall and connection on back of speaker
- Conecte la alimentación del adaptador a la pared y la conexión en la parte posterior del altavoz



- Press the power button on the front of the speaker. You will hear "Powering On, Welcome to Altec Lansing" to indicate the speaker is now on.
- · Presione el botón de encendido en la parte frontal del altavoz. Escuchará "Encendido, Bienvenido a Altec Lansing" para indicar que el altavoz ahora está encendido.



- While speaker is connected to power, it will charge. There is a battery icon indicating fullness of internal battery.
   When it is full charged you can disconnect from direct power.
- · Mientras el altavoz está conectado a la alimentación, se cargará. Hay un pequeño icono de batería que indica que la batería está llena. Cuando está completamente cargada, puede desconectarse de la alimentación directa.

# **Bluetooth Pairing**

- Press the BLUETOOTH button. The speaker is now in Bluetooth pairing mode.
- Presione el botón BLUETOOTH. El altavoz está ahora en modo de emparejamiento Bluetooth.



- Search for ALTEC THUNDER 15 on your phone under Bluetooth settings and connect to the speaker
- Busque ALTEC THUNDER 15 en su teléfono en la configuración de Bluetooth y conéctese al altavo




- The speaker will play two tones to indicated that it is now paired with your phone

# Connecting & Playing

- To connect other input sources -
- i. Open front flap to display USB, Aux and Mic inputs on the front of the speaker
- ii. Connect USB cable to USB Input
- iii. Connect Aux cable to Aux input
- Para conectar otras fuentes de entrada yo. Abra la tapa frontal para mostrar las entradas USB, Aux y Mic en la parte frontal del altavoz
- ii. Conecte el cable USB a la entrada USB
- iii. Conecte el cable auxiliar a la entrada auxiliar



- With the speaker turned on, press the SOURCE button.
- i. Press 1 time for LINE IN MODE
- ii. Press 2 times for FM mode
- iii. Press 3 times for USB mode
- iv. Press 4 times for Bluetooth mode
- Con el altavoz encendido, presione el botón FUENTE.
- yo. Presione 1 vez para LINE IN MODE
- ii. Presione 2 veces para el modo FM
- iii. Presione 3 veces para el modo USB
- iv. Presiona 4 veces para el modo Bluetooth







# **Adjusting Volume**

- The MASTER VOLUME controls are located on the front panel of the speaker. Press the VOLUME UP button 1 time to turn the volume up. Press the VOLUME DOWN button 1 time to turn the volume down. VL will appear on screen & you can adjust the levels from 1 to 32
- Los controles MASTER VOLUME están ubicados en el panel frontal del altavoz. Presione el botón VOLUME UP 1 vez para subir el volumen. Presione el botón de BAJAR VOLUMEN 1 vez para bajar el volumen. VL aparecerá en la pantalla y puede ajustar los niveles de 1 a 32

#### Beast Mode

- Enable Beast mode by pressing the BEAST button on the front panel of the speaker. The word BEAST will pop up on the LCD Screen. To turn it off, simply press the button again 1 time
- Active el modo Bestia presionando el botón BEAST en el panel frontal del altavoz. La palabra BESTIA aparecerá en la pantalla LCD. Para apagarlo, simplemente presione el botón otra vez 1 vez





# **Controlling Playback**

- Locate the PLAY/PAUSE, SKIP AHEAD and SKIP BACKWARD controls on the front of the speaker panel. Press the PLAY/ PAUSE button one time to PLAY from BLUETOOTH, LINE IN or USB sources.
- Localice los controles de REPRODUCIR / PAUSAR, SALTAR AL AVANCE y SALTAR ATRÁS en la parte frontal del panel de altavoces. Presione el botón REPRODUCIR / PAUSAR una vez para REPRODUCIR desde BLUETOOTH, LINE IN o fuentes USB



- To repeat a track locate the REPEAT 1 button. Press that button 1 time will enable the current track to be repeated.
- Para repetir una pista localice el botón REPETIR 1. Presione ese botón 1 vez para que la pista actual se repita.
- Press the SKIP AHEAD button to advance to the next track. Press the SKIP BACKWARD button to return to the previous track.
- Presione el botón SKIP AHEAD para avanzar a la siguiente pista. Presione el botón SKIP BACKWARD para volver a la pista anterior.
- To change radio stations in FM MODE.
   Press the SKIP AHEAD button to increase stations forward. Press the SKIP BACKWARD button to decrease stations backward
- Para cambiar emisoras de radio en MODO FM. Presione el botón SKIP AHEAD para aumentar las estaciones hacia adelante. Presione el botón SKIP BACKWARD para disminuir las estaciones hacia atrás





# **Equalizer EQ**

- The Thunder has 5 different EQ settings, NORM, CLUB, VOCL, ROCK, POP. Located the EQ button. Pressing it 1 time will change the EQ settings. The display will indicate what setting you are currently using.
- El Thunder tiene 5 configuraciones de ecualización diferentes, NORM, CLUB, VOCL, ROCK, POP. Ubicado el botón EQ. Si lo pulsa 1 vez, cambiará la configuración del ecualizador. La pantalla indicará qué configuración está utilizando actualmente.



#### **Bluetooth Linking**

- To LINK your speaker to another ALTEC THUNDER, start by pressing the LINK button. You will hear a set of tones to indicate that the speaker is now in linking mode. The word LINK should appear in the lower left-hand corner of the LCD screen. Press the LINK button on the other speaker and you will hear the same tones. The speakers are now linked.
- Para ENLACE su altavoz a otro ALTEC THUNDER, comience presionando el botón ENLACE. Escuchará un conjunto de tonos para indicar que el altavoz está ahora en modo de enlace. La palabra ENLACE debe aparecer en la esquina inferior izquierda de la pantalla LCD. Presione el botón ENLACE en el otro altavoz y escuchará los mismos tonos. Los altavoces están ahora vinculados.

# **Controlling the Lights**


- The THUNDER speaker has 3 light settings; STEADY FLASHING, FLASHING TO THE MUSIC, FADE IN/OUT. To activate STEADY FLASHING, Locate the LIGHTS button on the front of the LCD display. Press 1 time to turn lights on and activate steady flashing mode. Press 2 times to turn on flashing to the music mode. Press 3 times to activate fade in/out mode. Press 4 times to turn off lights.
- El altavoz THUNDER tiene 3 configuraciones de luz; FLASHING DE SEGURIDAD, INTERMITENTE A LA MÚSICA, FADE IN / OUT. Para activar STEADY FLASHING, ubique el botón LIGHTS en la parte frontal de la pantalla LCD. Presione 1 vez para encender las luces y activar el modo de destello continuo. Presione 2 veces para encender el modo de música intermitente. Presione 3 veces para activar el modo de entrada / salida de fundido. Presione 4 veces para apagar las luces.



- The THUNDER speaker has 12 different light colors. To change colors, Locate the COLOR button. Each time you press the button it will change the color of the lights in the speaker
- El altavoz THUNDER tiene 12 colores de luz diferentes. Para cambiar los colores, busque el botón COLOR. Cada vez que presione el botón cambiará el color de las luces en el altavoz

# Connecting & Controlling the Mic

- To connect a microphone to your THUNDER speaker. Locate the front input connection panel on the front of the speaker. Open the rubber panel door. Connect microphone cable to input labeled MIC.
- Para conectar un micrófono a su altavoz THUNDER, Localice el panel de conexión de entrada frontal en la parte frontal del altavoz.
   Abra la puerta del panel de goma. Conecte el cable del micrófono a la entrada etiquetada MIC.




- To control the microphone volume, locate the MIC - and VOL+ buttons on the front panel of the speaker. Press the VOL + button 1 time to increase the microphone volume. Press the MIC - button 1 time to decrease the microphone volume.
- Para controlar el volumen del micrófono, ubique los botones MIC y VOL + en el panel frontal del altavoz. Presione el botón VOL + 1 vez para aumentar el volumen del micrófono.
   Presione el botón MIC - una vez para disminuir el volumen del micrófono.



#### **ALT-T1500-PK THUNDER Features**

- 1. Power ON/OFF Switch: Turns the unit on and off
- 2. Volume Up: Turns the main volume up
- 3. Volume Down: Turns the volume down
- 4. Beast: Turns on and off Beast Mode
- 5. Skip Ahead: Moves track ahead on Bluetooth/USB mode and moves the radio station forward on FM mode
- 6. Play/Pause: Starts and Stops music Bluetooth/ USB mode
- 7. Skip Backwards: Moves 1 track backwards on Bluetooth/USB mode and moves the radio station backwards on FM mode.
- 8. EQ: Switches between equalizer settings
- 9. Source: Switches between input sources
- 10. Track Repeat: Repeats the current track in Bluetooth/USB modes.
- 11. Link: Initiates Bluetooth Linking
- 12. Bluetooth: Activates Bluetooth Pairing
- 13. Lights: Turns on/off and activates different light modes
- 14. Color: Changes the colors of lights on speaker
- 15. Mic Vol Up: Increases the Microphone volume
- 16. Mic Vol Down: Decreases the Microphone volume
- 17. Aux Input: Attach aux input here
- 18. Microphone Input: Attach microphone input here
- 19. USB Input: Plug in USB input here
- 20. Link Out: To connect output to another source
- 21. DC IN: Plug in power source.

- Do not use the speaker's handles for suspended installation. Doing so can result in damage or injury.
