Installing the Batteries.





LCD DISPLAY



In VOICE mode



REMAIN: Shows remaining time to record.



REC: Displays while recording in the VOICE mode.



FOLDER A/B/C/D: Indicates which folder you are on.



GL (Gain Low = dictation mode): In the VOICE mode, GL is recommended to select for recording voice messages at quiet places like meetings, classes, etc.



GH (Gain High = conference mode): In the VOICE mode, GH is recommended to select for recording voice messages at noisy places like exhibitions, shows, etc.



SP (Standard Play): In the VOICE mode, SP is recommended to select for recording standard play Max. 230 minutes of recording time is available in this mode.



LP (Long Play) : In the VOICE mode, LP is recommended to select for recording long play Max. 500 minutes of recording time is available in this mode.



LO (Low resolution) : In the CAMERA mode, pictures can be taken with low resolution of 320 x 240 pixels. Total 500 frames can be taken in this mode.




HI (High resolution): In the CAMERA mode, pictures can be taken at high resolution of 640 X 480 pixels. Total 130 frames can be taken in this mode.



USB: Indicates that the device is being connected to the computer via USB cable.



This button is to hold all of function keys. You can see the signal of "HOLD" on the LCD panel for 2 seconds when you switch the Hold on. It returns to the STAND-BY mode for 1minute before power-off. This function prevents accidental operation while carrying the device in a pocket or briefcase.



Low Battery Indicator

HOW TO RECORD VOICE MESSAGE

• When you push the POWER/PLAY/PAUSE button more than 4 seconds, it automatically starts recording in Folder A.



- Push the REC button to start recording. After being shown on the LCD panel for 2 seconds, the recording time is shown on the LCD panel while recording.
- Push the POWER/PLAY/PAUSE button or the REC button to finish recording.

NOTE: Concerning the VOR (Voice On Recording) mode, please refer to the following page.

HOW TO CHANGE MODE

- GL (Gain Low = dictation mode): In the VOICE mode, it is recommended to select for recording voice messages
 at quite places like meetings, etc.
 - GH (Gain High = conference mode): In the VOICE mode, it is recommended to select for recording voice messages at noisy places like exhibitions, shows, etc.
 - NOTE: Only in the recording mode, you can change to the GL (or GH) mode.
- SP (Standard Play): In the VOICE mode, it is recommended to select for recording Standard Play.
 LP (Long Play): In the VOICE mode, it is recommended to select for recording Long Play.
 - NOTE: In the VOICE mode, you can select either SP or LP mode.







- In the recording mode, push the SELECT button to move to the GL mode. The VoiceCam is originally set to the GH mode.
- The signal of GL(or GH) displays on the LCD panel.

HOW TO PLAY OR PAUSE RECORDED MESSAGE

 Move to the right folder by using the MODE & the SELECT button and move to the right file by using the REW & FF button that you would like to play.



- Push the POWER/PLAY/PAUSE button to play the recorded message. When it finishes recording, it returns to the STAND-BY mode.
- Whlie playing, push the POWER/PLAY/PAUSE button to pause playing and push this button again to resume playing.

NOTE: A high quality earphone is included in the package. To listen the recorded message more clearly, you can use the packed earphone connecting to the earphone jack.

HOW TO SELECT FOLDER A/B/C/D & VOICE FILE RECORDED

 In the STAND-BY mode, if you push the MODE button continously, it is blinking in sequence of CAMERA -> LP -> FOLDER A -> Vol: 10 on the LCD panel. To select of any mode blarking, push the select button.



- Move to the right folder by pushing the REW button and the FF button. Push the SELECT button to select one folder among FOLDER A/B/C/D.
- In the STAND-BY mode, you can move to each voice file recorded by pushing the REW and the FF button.

NOTE: The blinking time is less than 4 seconds. You should push the SELECT button to select one folder among FOLDER A/B/C/D while it is blinking. In case of no voice file recorded in the folders, either of the REW or the FF button dose not function.

HOW TO ADJUST VOLUME LEVEL

• You can adjust the volume level both in the PLAY mode and in the STAND-BY mode.



 Push the SELECT button in the STAND-BY mode or in the PLAY mode.

You can adjust volume level by using the REW button and the FF button.

HOW TO ERASE VOICE FILE

· Before erasing VOICE file, make sure that you move to the right file that you would like to erase.







- Push the ERASE button. The voice message in the file is playing while the signal of "ERASE" is blinking on the LCD panel.
- Push the ERASE button again within 10 seconds. Otherwise, it automatically returns to the STAND-BY mode.

NOTE: The files can be erased either in the PLAY mode or in the STAND-BY mode. The numbers of file are automatically readjusted in numerical order after erasing file.

HOW TO SELECT HI(LO) RESOLUTION MODE

• HI (High resolution): The pictures can be taken with high resolution at 640 X 480 pixels.

Total 130 images are available in this mode.

• LO (Low resolution): The pictures can be taken with low resolution at 320 X 240 pixels.

Total 500 images are available in this mode.



- Move to the CAMERA mode using the MODE and the SELECT button. The VoiceCam is originally set to the VOICE mode.
- Push the SELECT button to select LO mode. The VoiceCam is originally set to the HI mode.


NOTE: The actual number of available shots depends on how many voice files recorded in the VOICE mode.

HOW TO TAKE PICTURE

In the CAMERA mode, it is appropriate to take short distanced subject, such as document, etc.

• In the middle: In the CAMERA mode, it is appropriate to take middle distanced subjects with the interval of 1.5M or so.

Infinity (∞): In the CAMERA mode, it is appropriate to take long distanced subject farther than 1.5M.



- Make sure to be in the CAMERA mode. Select LO(HI) resolution mode by pushing the SELECT button.
- ② Set the focus adjuster either of ☼ or infinity(∞) according to the distance of the subject. Push the SHUTTER button.


- NOTE: 1. Take care that your fingers or the strap do not cover the camera lens.
 - Don't shake the VoiceCam while you are taking pictures.

Installing "the Software for the VoiceCamll on your PC allows you to carry out the following:

- Upload data on the VoiceCamll to your PC, view photo files, and play voice files.
- Save files on your PC with individual file name.
- Print the photo images using the printer connected to your PC.

To operate the device on your PC, you should setup the hardware drive and install the interface program to your PC as follows.

- Connect the device to your PC via USB cable.
- 2. Insert the software CD into your CD-ROM or DVD-ROM driver.
- 3. Follow the installing procedure.



NOTE: If you have trouble in installing, make sure that your PC meets the minimum requirments listed ealier.

SOFTWARE INSTALLATION

When you load the software CD enclosed on the CD-ROM, the followings appear on your PC.



- Driver Install: This is for installation of hardware driver for VoiceCamll on your computer.
- VoiceCam Manager: This is for installing and managing software program for VoiceCamII on your computer.
- DirectX 8.0 : This enables to optimize your computer system for PC Camera.
 If you have already installed this on your computer,
 do not click for installation.

(SCREEN)

NOTE: After installing the software CD on your computer, connect VoiceCam to your PC with USB cable. It automatically recognizes it's driver installed.



- Quite all other applications.







In Window 98, you can use Add / Remove programs in the Control Panel to automatically uninstall the "Software for VoiceCam" application programs and the driver.


- 1. Open my computer to access the Control Panel.
- 2. Double-click on the icon of Add / Remove program.
- Select and remove the applications to be uninstalled.
- 4. To confirm uninstallation, click on "YES".



NOTE: Only use this procedure when you no longer need the installed "VoiceCam Manager" software.

HOW TO PERFORM FILES(VOICE & PHOTO) ON PC

To make uploaded files run on your PC, you should understand the window system of the VoiceCamll If you double-click the icon of the VoiceCam on your PC screen, the Main Window appears. You can use this program, just like the Outlook Express. The Main Window is composed of Outlook Window, Thumbnail Window, Wave Player, Graphic Window, Menu Bar, Tool Bar.



MAIN WINDOW

HOW TO UPLOAD DATA TO PC VIA USB CABLE

After completing installation of PC interface program, you can see an icon named VoiceCam on the screen.

- Double-click the VoiceCam icon on your PC screen.
- Connect the VoiceCam to your PC via USB cable.
- 3. Click the icon



in the Toolbar, or click "Upload All" or "Upload Photo", "Upload Voice" of the Data in the MENU bar

- 4. When the message of "Previous Uploaded data All Deleted!!" appears, click "YES".
- 5. While uploading, the signal of "UPLOADING" is blinking on the Window.
- Wait until the message of "Upload Complete!" appears.

NOTE: While USB cable is being connected to the VoiceCam, any functions of each button are not available.
Do not disconnect USB cable during uploading data.

HOW TO VIEW PHOTO FILE & VOICE FILE

To view PHOTO files,

- Click "PHOTO Folder" in the Outlook Window.
- The PHOTO files (cam001.jpg.....) taken display in the Thumbnail Window.
- Click the right file that you would like to view in the Thumbnail Window.
- 4. You can see the big sized image in the Graphic Window.
- NOTE: The available functions with PHOTO file are SaveAs, Copy, Cut, Remove, Paste, Rename, Send To Mail, Photo Rotate (Left, Right, Reverse), Info, etc.


To play VOICE files,

- Click the right folder among the Folder A/B/C/D/ in the Outlook Window.
- 2. Whenever you click each folder, the recorded files (cam001.wav.....) are shown in the Thumbnail Window.
- 3. Double-click the right file that you would like to listen.
- 4. While playing, you can adjust the volume level with the Volume Adjuster.
- NOTE: The available functions with VOICE file are SaveAs, Copy, Cut, Remove, Paste, Rename, Send To Mail, Info, etc.

To Save Files,



To Turn the Beep Sound ON / OFF,


To Turn the VOR Mode OFF,

- 1. Click the "Option" of the View in the MENU bar.
- 2. Click the "VOR (Voice On Recording)."
- 3. Click "Apply" or "OK".
- NOTE: The VoiceCam is originally set to the "VOR" mode on.



To readjust the "Maximum pause time in VOR mode", In case of selecting the VOR mode on, it is automatically converted to the STAND-BY mode after 5 minutes with no external voice recognized while recording.

- 1. Click the "Option" of the View in the MENU bar.
- Write the number of time that you would like the device to be paused before being converted to the STAND-BY mode in case of the VOR mode on. You can select the time among 1~30 minutes.
- 3. Click "Apply" and "OK".



■ NOTE:

In the VOR mode on, it begins recording as long as microphone senses voice signals, and it stops recording in case of no input of external voice recognized. During recording, it is automatically converted into the STAND-BY mode if any external voice is not recognized for 5 minutes. The duration of the STAND-BY mode can be easily adjusted from 1 to 30 minutes on the software provided. In the VOR mode off, During recording, the VoiceCam continues recording even while any external voice is recognized until the batteries are exhausted or the memory is full.

IN PC CAMERA MODE

When you connect the VoiceCam to the computer with USB cable, you can use it as a PC Camera. In the PC Camera mode, you can take pictures and record video clips with the VoiceCamII.

Features

- 1. You can contact anyone in the world and attend in meeting through Internet using Netmeeting supported by Microsoft.
- 2. You three of screen size 640 x 480, 320 x 240, 160 x 120 available.
- The method of compression supported are RGB and YUV.
- 4. The speed of PC Camera depends on the computer system as well as the server that you connected.
- 5. In this mode, the device utilixes the power from USB and does not consume any battery power.

To start PC Camera mode,

Click start -> Programs -> InterMagic -> InterMagic Mv 301 Video Driver -> InterMagic PC Camera VFW Capture

To Use Netmeeting,

First, you have to download the updated Netmeeting Program from http://www.microsoft.com/netmeeting/ You can see the icon of Netmeeting in you taskbar.

For further information of using Netmeeting, refer to the HELP file of Netmeeting.

NOTE: The WDM driver is recommended that it gives better performance in terms of frame rate.


