BEFORE BATTERY INSTALLATION

Your new R/C is designed to work with standard 3 (three) "AA" batteries, sold separately.
Controller is designed to work with a 9-volt battery, sold separately.

INSTALLING BATTERIES IN THE R/C

- 3 (three) "AA" batteries (Not included)
- Using a Phillips screwdriver (not included), to remove the battery compartment door underneath the vehicle. (See diagram 1) franty.

 Insert the 3"AQ" batteries, with polarity (+/-) as shown inside battery compartment. Push the ON/OFF to "OFF" position on vehicle.

Replace the battery compartment door and use Phillips screwdriver to lock the compartment door.




