BEFORE BATTERY INSTALLATION

Controller is designed to work with a 9-volt alkaline battery, "AA" alkaline batteries, sold separately. Your new R/C is designed to work with standard 3 (three)

sold separately.

INSTALLING BATTERIES IN THE R/C

- 3 (three) "AA" Alkaline batteries (Not included)
- Using a Phillips screwdriver (not included), to Push the ON/OFF to "OFF" position on vehicle. the vehicle. (See diagram 1, remove the battery compartment door underneath
- Insert the 3 "AA" alkaline batteries, with polarity (+/-) as shown inside battery compartment.
- Replace the battery compartment door and use Phillips screwdriver to lock the compartment door.

9 VOLT BATTERY INSTALLING CONTROLLER -

- 1 (one) 9V Alkaline battery (not included)
- Install one 9V battery with polarity (+/-) as shown Open the battery cover as shown (See Diagram 2) inside battery compartment.
- Replace battery cover.


- Insure that battery polarity is correct.
- Use only batteries of the type recommended (or equivalent).
- Do not mix old and new batteries


PUCK TIPS

Cleaning instruction:

DO NOT IMMERSE IN WATER and DO NOT CLEAN compartment dry up before putting batteries back into clean, dry battery VEHICLE WITH ANY CHEMICALS. Let the toy completely Wipe toy clean with wet cloth using plain water. Wipe dry. To clean, wipe excess dirt from toy. Remove batteries first
