






5. Replace the Battery Hub with its contacts facing the front wheel of the Stunt Bike. Replace the Battery Cover and the screw.






SAFETY PRECAUTIONS


USING YOUR MXS® RADIO CONTROL SUPER STUNT BIKE

Turn the ON/OFF switch located on the right front side of the Stunt Bike to the "ON" position before starting.

DRIVING FORWARD



- 1. Hold the seat of the Stunt Bike and give the Transmitter forward throttle.
- 2. As the rear wheel speeds up, place the Stunt Bike on the ground and give it a gentle push forward.

STARTING FROM A LEANING POSITION

- 1. If the Stunt Bike stalls or slows down enough to lean on one of the stabilizer wheels, increase the throttle, and it will drive toward the direction it is leaning.
- 2. As it drives in circles, steer the Stunt Bike in the opposite direction of the circle to go straight again.
