
BATTERY INSTALLATION

Instruction Sheet

REMOTE CONTROLLER


1. After removing vehicle from package, remove "try me" wire and discard.

 Adults: Replace the batteries in the vehicle and install the batteries in the remote controller for optimum performance. Unscrew the batteries doors to get access to batteries.



 Install 2 x "AAA" alkaline(1.5V) batteries with polarity as shown inside battery compartment.

- Replace 3 X "AAA" alkaline(1.5V) batteries with polarity as shown inside battery compartment.
- Push the power switch on vehicle to "ON" position.




CAUTION WHEN WORKING WITH BATTERIES

- 1. Replace the whole set of batteries at one time, taking care not to mix or use old and new batteries of batteries of different types.
- 2.Do not use non-rechargeable batteries with rechargeable batteries or rechargeable batteries of different capacities.
- 3. Take care to fit your batteries correctly, observing the + and marks on the battery and matching the battery compartment markings.
- 4.Remove all batteries from the Remote Controller and the Vehicle when not in use for extended period of time.
- 5.Do not dispose batteries in fire. Batteries may explode or leak.

OPERATING THE VEHICLE AND THE REMOTE CONTROLLER

- 1. Switch Vehicle to ON position.
- Operate your Vehicle in a dry, clean, flat open area, do not drive in the street. Avoid sand and water.
- 3.If Vehicle does not respond to Remote Controller, try to operate the Vehicle at a closer range. The maximum range for the Vehicle should be between 16 to 19 feet (5 to 6 meters), when operating outdoors.
- 4. For best results, hold Transmitter antenna up, not pointed down toward R/C Vehicle.
- 5. Turn Vehicle switches to OFF position when not in use.

RADIO INTERFERENCE:
