ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTION

- 2. Insert Horizontal Roll Bars onto Roll Cage (see illustration 2)
- 3. Insert Vertical Roll Bars onto Roll Cage (see illustration 3)
- 4. Insert Roll Cage onto Roll Door Frame hinges (see illustration 4). Roll Cage can be turned 90 degree away from position shown on picture.
- 5. Place Ramp Panel onto Loading Dock (see illustration 5)
- 6. Insert Wall Panel left end into Roll Doll Frame (see illustration 6)
- 7. Click Roll Barrel Supporting Plate onto Roll Cage Trigger (see illustration 7)
- 8. Pull Roll Door Down until Roll Door End Strip click into locating slot on Loading Dock (see illustration 8)
- 9. Insert Roll Barrels into Roll Cage (see illustration 9)
- 10. Apply labels onto Loading Dock & Ramp Panel (see illustration 10)

1. Insert Roll Door Frame onto Loading Dock (see illustration 1)

1. Press Soda Can button once to allow Roll Door fly up automatically. In the event Roll Door does not completely fly up, manually rotate Door Knob on Roll Door Frame upper left to make roll door complete fly up (see illustration A) 2. Press Roll Cage Trigger once to release Roll Barrels (see illustration B)



TO PLAY WITH THE PLAYSET




