

Install Batteries

- 1. Open the battery compartment cover on the back of the keyboard.
- 2. Insert two AA batteries (not included) according to the polarity symbols (+ and -) marked inside.
- 3. Replace the battery compartment cover.




Battery Notes:

- When the battery LED () flashes red, the batteries are low. Replace the batteries with new ones.
- Use only fresh batteries of the required size and type.
- Dispose of batteries promptly and properly. Do not burn or burv them.
- Do not mix old and new batteries, different types of batteries (alkaline or rechargeable), or rechargeable batteries of different capacities.
- If you do not plan to use the keyboard for an extended period of time, remove the batteries. Batteries can leak chemicals that can damage electronic parts.

Plug in the Receiver

- 1. Take out the USB receiver donale from the battery compartment.
- 2. Turn on your computer.
- 3. Plug the receiver into your computer's USB port.



Pair the Dongle and Keyboard

When using your keyboard for the first time, you need to pair the dongle and keyboard.


CONNECT

ON/OFF

- 1. Position the keyboard within 20 in. (50cm) of the dongle. Slide the **ON/OFF** switch on the back of the keyboard to **ON**.
- 2. Press CONNECT. Pairing is completed automatically. If pairing fails, press **CONNECT** again

Note: If you do not plan to use your keyboard for several minutes, slide **ON/OFF** to **OFF** to save battery power.

Use the Function Keys





- **f1** and **f2** only function on Mac monitors.
- **f3** functions only on Mac OS X 10.7 and above.
