USING YOUR WALKIE-TALKIE

POWER SUPPLY

Your new Walkie-Talkies use one 9 Volt battery for each unit. Only use the battery specified by the manufacturer.

To install the batteries:

You will need an adult to help you install the batteries. Using a small flat head screwdriver, remove the screw from battery door. Remove battery door and set aside. Insert the batteries, following the polarity markers, then replace the battery door and screw it back into place.

TALKING AND LISTENING

To turn the Walkie-Talkie on, turn the Power/Volume knob clockwise. The Power Indicator Light will turn on.

To turn the Walkie-Talkie off, turn the Power/Volume knob counterclockwise until you hear a click. The Power Indicator Light will turn off.

To talk to the other Walkie-Talkie, press and hold the Push-to-Talk button and speak into the Mic. To hear a reply, let go of the Push-to-Talk button and listen to the Speaker.
