

## 2. Installation Steps

### 2.1 Connecting HDMI cable

Connect the HDMI cable to the HDMI port on the back of the receiver.

### 2.2 Connecting the Antenna

Connect one end of the antenna cable to the ANT IN on the back of the receiver and the other end to a terrestrial antenna connection or the jack for the public antenna on the wall.

### 2.3 Connecting Power cable

Connect the Power cable with the receiver as well as the electric socket.

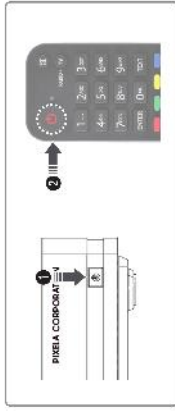

### 2.4 Turning On and Off Your Receiver

#### Power On

- Turn on the power switch located at the back of the receiver.
- Press the **STANDBY** button on the front of the receiver or on the remote control.



#### Power Off

Press the **STANDBY** button on the receiver or the remote control. The receiver will display "OFF".

### 2.5 Connecting other equipments

#### 2.5.1 Connecting Audio & Video cable

If you have Audio cable and Video cable (CDS or HDB), you can watch TV by connecting them with TV and the receiver.

#### 2.5.2 Connecting the receiver with VCR

You can connect the receiver with VCR by using S-Video cable or Audio & Video cable.

#### 2.5.3 Connecting the receiver with Audio System

You can connect the receiver with Audio System by using audio cable.
