Cleaning





Getting Started

Charging

Your device comes with a Lithium polymer integrated rechargeable battery.

New batteries are not charged when shipped. Before you start using your device, you need to charge the battery.

Follow the steps below to connect your device to the power outlet and charge the battery.

- Plug one end of the AC power adaptor into the power jack on your device.
- Plug the other end into a power outlet. The charge Icon turns to indicate charging.

Note: The charging icon will light up when the battery is charging. Once the battery is fully charged, the charging icon will turn green

If your device is totally out of battery, it may take a while before you can power up your device. Only plug the charger/adapter into DC port that the device will be in the charging state.

Battery performance depends on your usage patterns.

Tips to improve battery performance

As the device has a large screen, it will consume a lot of power. To extend battery life, you can consider the following:

- Reduce display brightness.
- Reduce web search.
- Turn off Wi-Fi.

NOTE

- If not use this machine for a long time, in order to avoid damage caused by battery excessive consumption, please be sure to make a battery charge and discharge once within one month to prevent battery from running down.
- With built in Lithium polymer batteries, it has to be charged regularly. The battery damage caused by excessive consumption of polymer battery will not be covered by guarantee. If use the charger which is not exclusively equipped for this machine, the problem caused by it also not be covered by guarantee.

If the device has no quantity of electric charge, you can not connect to the PC to copy files, you should charge first.

If the device has Shutdown condition, you can not connect to the PC to copy files, you should Power on.

Inserting Media

The device supports micro SD card.

You can operate music, Gallery, files, Video and applications on the device through a memory card.

When no micro SD card inserted, your device will read the internal memory.

Note: Do not use any force while inserting a memory card.

Connecting to the PC

Files can be transferred directly into the device by using the USB data cable.

- Make sure that your computer has been started before you start.
- Connect the mini plug of the USB cable to the mini USB port on your device and plug the other end into a free USB port to your PC.
- The computer system detects "New hardware" and starts to install the driver automatically. Wait for the system to finish the installation.
 When it has finished, a new "Removable Disk" will be created in "My Computer".
- The device display "USB Connected" screen, Touch "Turn on USB storage" screen, Then show a yellow interface "Turn off USB storage".
- Drag and drop the files on your computer to the "Removable Disk".
- To disconnect the USB cable from the computer, double click the Safety Remove Hardware icon on the task bar. Click the USB Mass Storage Device, and then click OK. Then you can unplug the player safety.

Note: Before connecting to the PC, make sure that you have turned on your tablet.

If the battery runs down, it needs recharging before connecting to PC.

Please do not disconnect the USB cable during loading. It may cause malfunction of the player and the files.

Turn on/off

- To turn on the device, press and hold the power button.
- To turn off the device, press and hold the power button.

Lock and Unlock

Locking the device manually

Presss the Power/Lock key

Unlock the device

- Presss the Power/Lock key

You can also set the master volume level from the lock screen. Touch and drag **Sound** from top to bottom to toggle sound between ON and OFF modes.



The Home screen is the starting point for using your device.

- 1. Tap to enter Home screen
- The notification panel, shows information about connections, messages and other items. Slide your finger downward from then top of the screen.
- 3. Wifi net connection
- Battery status
- 5. Time
- 6. Adjust volume, V+/V-
- 7. Tap to exit and return to previous screen
- 8. Tap to open menu options
- 9. Tap to enter and browse internet
- 10. Browse internet
- 11. Application icon, tap to open application menu

- 13. Slide to move to the extended home screen
- 14. Search

Extended Home Screen

The Home screen consists of the Home screen, plus 4 screens that extend beyond the display width to provide more space for adding shortcuts, widgets and folders.

Slide your finger horizontally across the screen to scroll to the left or right side screens, As you scroll, the indicator at the left display shows your current position.

Customizing the Home Screen

Customize the Home screen to suit your preferences.

Add Shortcuts

Use Shortscuts for quick access to applications.

- -- Navigate to a Home screen, then touch and hold on the screen to display the add to Home screen menu. Or press Menu key/tap 🗐 on the home screen, then tap Add to pop up the Add window.
- -- Tap Shortcuts, then tap a selection, then follow the prompts to add it to the Home screen: Applicaions, Bookmark, contact, Music playlist,
- Adding Shortcuts from Applications
- -- Navigate to a Home screen
- -- Tap Applications
- -- Touch and hold an application icon. The shortcut icon is automatically placed on the selected Home screen.
- Removing Shortcuts
- -- Touch and hold the Shortcut icon until Application changes into the trash bin , then drag the icon into the trash bin, while both the icon and

the trash bin turns into red $\widehat{}$, after that you can release to remove the widget from the home screen.

Add Widgets

Widgets are self-contained application that you can place on the Home screen to enter your favorite features.

- Adding Widgets to Home screen
- -- Navigate to the desired Home screen, then touch and hold the on the screen to display the **Add to the Home Screen** menu. Or press Menu key/tap
- -- Tap Widgets, then tap a widget to add it to a home screen.
- Removing Widgets
- -- Touch and hold the Widget icon until the Application changes inro trash bin [10], then drag the icon into the trash bin, while both the icon and

the trash bin turns into red 📋 , after that you can release to remove the widget from the home screen.

Add Folders

Place Folders on the Home screen to organize items together on the Home screen. Or press Menu key/tap 🗐 on the home screen, then tap Add to pop up the Add window.

- -- Navigate to the desired Home screen, then touch and hold on the screen to display the Add to Home screem menu.
- -- Tap Folders, and then tap a selection: New folder.

Removing Folders

-- Touch and hold the Folder icon until the Application changes into trash bin it is, then drag the icon into the trash bin, while both the icon and the trash bin turns into red after that you can release to remove the widget from the home screen.

Change the Wallpaper

Choose a picture to display in the background of the Home screen. You can choose from pre-load wallpaper images.

- -- From a Home screen, touch and hold on rhe screen to display the Add to Home Screen menu, then tap Wallpapers. Or press Menu key/ tap on the home screen, then tap Add to pop up the Add window.
- -- Choose a source dor image:
- -Gallery: Choose a picture from an installed memory card. Tap a picture to select it, then use the crop tool to resize the picture, if desired, tap **Save** to save the pictures as wallpaper.
- Live wallpapers: Choose from pre-loaded interactive animated wallpapers. Tap a wallpaper to see an example, then tap Set wallpaper.
- Wallpapers: Choose from pre-loaded wallpaper images. Tap a wallpaper, then tap **Set wallpaper**.

Applications Menu



The Applications menu screen holds all the applications on the device. Applications that you download and install from the web are also added to the applications screen.

You can palce shortcuts to applications on the Home screen, for quick access to the application.

- From a Home screen, tap Applications
- Slide your finger top or bottom to scrool the Application screens.
- Tap an icon to launch the desired application.

Using the On-screen Keyboard





The onscreen keyboard lets you enter text, such as passwords, filenames, email messages, etc. It appears automatically when you launch certain applications or when you tap on a text or number field.

Tap on a text or number field to bring up the keyboard.

- When entering texts or numbers, each letter or number appear above the key you have pressed.
- Tap and hold the word you have typed to activate the following edit text options: Select Word, Select all, Input method. Add" to dictionary
- Press Back key or tap to exit.

Sleep/Wake button

When you are not actively using tablet, you can short press $[{\bf U}]$ button to turn off the display and save the battery. When you turn off the display, nothing happens if you touch the screen. You just need to short press $[{\bf U}]$ button to turn on the display.

Making a Wireless Connection

Before you can surf the Internet, send and receive emails, download content and applications etc, you must join a Wi-Fi network that is connected to the Internet.

For Wi-Fi networks that are not secured with a PIN code, you can easily connect to them and access the Internet freely. However, for Wi-Fi networks that are secured with password, you need to have the password to access the Internet.

- From the home screen or Application menu, tap **Settings** to enter setting interface. Or on the home screen, press Menu key or tap then select **Settings** on the menu bar.
- Tap Settings > Wireless & networks.
- Tap Wi-Fi to turn on wireless connection. ✓ appears in the Wi-Fi checkbox.
- Tap Wi-Fi settings. Your device will start to scan for the networks within range and display a list of available Wi-Fi networks.
- Tap the Wi-Fi network that you want your device to be connected with. If the network is not secured with a password, your device will start

to establish a link with it.

If it is a secured network, you will be prompted to select the security option (for networks secured with WEP) and enter the wireless

- Tap on the password field to launch the onscreen keyboard. Enter the password and tap Connect.
- Your device will start to establish a link to the network. Once a connection established, —Connected will appear below the name of the

Press Home key to return to the home screen, will appear on the status bar of your home screen.

Note: This device does not support 802.11n network, make sure network connection is 802.11b/g/n.

Browser

The device is equipped with a full HTML Browser, which allows you to enter the internet.

Note: You must join a Wi-Fi network that is connected to the internet before you can surf the web via the browser application.

Open Browser

From a Home screen or Application menu, tap **Browser**



Setting your home page

By default, By default, the home page is www.google.com

- To set another home page, press Menu key or tap and tap **More**.
- Tap Settings , then Set home page.
- In the **Set home page** dialog box, tap on the URL input field to launch the onscreen keyboard.
- Enter the web address of the home page and tap **Done**.
- Tap **OK** to confirm.

Open a Web Page

- In the **Browser** window, press Menu key or tap and tap **Go**.
- Enter the web address in the URL field using the onscreen keyboard and tap Go.

Note: As you enter the address, matching web page addresses will appear on the screen. Tap an address to go directly to that web page or continue to enter the web page address.

Refresh a Web Page

- On the web page, press Menu key or tap
- Tap Refresh.

Zoom in and Out of a Webpage

- Launch the zoom control by sliding across the screen in one direction.
- Tap the zoom control icon to zoom in and zoom out.

Open a New Browser Window

You can open multiple browser windows and switch between different web pages.

In the Browser window, press Menu key or tap and tap **New Window**.

A new browser window opens and enters the home page.

Switch between browser windows

- In the Browser window, press Menu key or tap and tap Windows.
- Tap to select the browser window you wish to display.

Finding Text within a Webpage

When viewing a webpage, press Menu key or tap

and then tap More > Find on page.

- Tap on the input field to launch the on screen keyboard.
- Enter the text using the onscreen keyboard and tap Done.

The matching texts are highlighted on the screen.

Tap < or > to go to the previous or next matching text.

Downloading unknown application from the Web

Before you can download web applications, you must first enable downloading from the **Settings** menu.

- Press Menu key or tap

 and then tap Settings > Applications.
- Tap **Unknown sources** to enable or disable the downloading of unknown applications.

When enabled, ✓appears next to the option.

Note: Applications downloaded from the web can be from unknown sources. To protect your device and personal data, download applications only from trusted sources.

View your downloads

• In the Browser window, press Menu key or tap and then tap **More > Downloads**. Or Home screen Downloads.

Manage Bookmarks

You can store as many bookmarks as you want on your device.

Bookmark a webpage

- In the Browser window, go to the web page you want to bookmark.
- Press Menu key or tap

 and then tap Bookmarks.

The bookmark option opens.

- Tap Add bookmark and enter the bookmark name.
- Edit the location if needed.
- Tap **OK**.

Open a bookmark

- In the Browser window, press Menu key or tap and then tap **Bookmarks**.
 - The bookmark option opens.
- Tap to select the bookmark to open it.

You can customize the Browser to suit your browsing preferences by setting the display, privacy, and security options. In the Browser window, press Menu key or tap and then tap **More** > **Settings** to modify the following browser settings according to your preference.

When \checkmark appears next to the option, the setting is enabled. To disable, tap the option again.

Email

Use Email to view and manage all your email accounts in one application.

Note: You must join a Wi-Fi network that is connected to the internet before you can surf the web via the browser application.

Open Email

- From a Home screen or Application menu, tap Email
- Input your Email address and password and tap Next.
- Tap to select your account type: POP3, IMAP or Exchange.
- Tap Next.

Enter the Account name (optional) and Your name (optional) to be displayed on outgoing messages, and then tap Done.

The email application will start to load your messages. It might take a few minutes for the messages to load completely.

Note: When you have set up an email account, the account will open by default when you open Email.

If you have set up more than one email account, the email accounts will appear in Your accounts list. Tap to select the account you wish to

- Enter Emailbox interface, press Menu key or tap ,then you can
 - Refresh: Check for new messages.
 - Compose: Compose and send email messages.
 - Folders: View you email folders.
 - Accounts: View all accounts. To ad a new account, press Menu key or tap to select **Add account**. To delete an email account, tap and hold the email account that you want to delete, then tap **Remove account** to delete.
 - Account settings: Make account settings.

Account Settings

- On emailbox interface, press Menu key or tap to show the menu bar.
- Tap Account settings, then you can
 - Account name: Edit your account name
 - Your name: Edit your name
 - Email check frequency: Never, Every 5 minutes, Every 10 minutes, Every 15minutes, Every 30 minutes, Every hour.
 - Default account: Set your emails will be sent from this account by default.
 - > Email notifications: Set notification on the status bar when a new email arrives.
 - > Select ringtone: Set ringtone from the list for the arrival of new emails.
 - Incoming settings: Modify incoming server settings.
 - > Outgoing settings: Modify outcoming server settings.

Reading Emails

- On emailbox, select a mail and tap to open.
- Reply to email messages, tap Repy or Reply all.
- Delete an email message, tap **Delete**.

 Press Menu key or tap to show the menu bar, then you can
 - Delete an email message
 - Forward an email message
 - Reply email message
 - Mark email message as unread

Gallery



From a Home screen or Application menu, tap Gallery to enter photo mode.

- Select a folder and tap to enter, the photos are displayed in thumbnails.
- If you want to change the view mode, can Select the top right of the screen icon.
- View photo, can tap zoom icon image scaling, tap play slide way to play the photo, or tap menu options
- Tap menu, tap More: On the photo for sharing, delete, pruning, rotation, set as wallpaper and detailed information such as view
 operation.

Play video

- From a Home screen or Application menu, tap Gallery to enter
- Select a folder and tap to enter , the photos are displayed in thumbnails.
- If you want to change the view mode, can Select the top right of the screen icon.
- Select and tap a video, then choose the player to start playback

Share Photo and Video

- From a Home screen or Application menu, tap Gallery La to enter
- Open folders and with thumbnail mode, then Choose the need to share pictures or video
 Select the folder, short press the menu button, touch **Select all,** then tap **Share** to share
 Select a folder of many photo or video, Short press the menu button,
 Then tap the need of the touch share thumbnail to tag, then tap
 Share to share
- Touch the **share way** started to share photos or video

Music

The Music application lets you play digital audio files stored in the internal memory or memory card.

- From a Home screen or Application menu, tap **Music** to enter music library.
- The music is displayed into different categories such as Artists, Albums, Songs , Playlists and Now playing
- Tap to select a category and tap a song in the category to start playback. Press Back key or tap to return to previous screen.

On music library interface, select a song and hold to pop up a window, then you can

- Play the selected song
- Add to playlist
- Delete the song
- Search song from music library or internet.

While listening to music,

- Tap to select songs from the list.
- Tap to turn shuffle on or off.(Shuffle is off when the icon is gray)
- Tap to cycle through the repeat modes: Repeat all songs, Repeat current song, Repeat is off.
- Tap to pause or resume the song playback.
- Tap to go to previous or next song.
- Drag the progressive bar to the desired playing point.

On the playing interface, press Menu key or tap , then there will pop up a menu bar.

- Tap **Library** to go to music library
- Tap Party shuffle to make Part shuffle on or Party shuffle off.

- Tap Add to playlist to add a playlist.
- Tap **Delete** to delete the song.

Video Player


The Video Player application lets you play video files stored in the internal memory or memory card.

- From a Home screen or Application menu, tap Video Player to enter video list.
- Select and tap a video to start playback.

 Press Back key or tap to return to previous screen.

While viewing a video, tap the touch screen to pop up a tool bar. Touch the corresponding icon play select.

Clock



- In addition to display date and time, the clock this application can also engage the slide and music playing, and also can set the alarm.
- From a Home screen or Application menu, tap clock to enter.

Slide show

- The gallery photo slide show mode.
- Tap star slide show, tap end play.

Music Player

- The clock shows the time at the same time playing music
- Tap to music interface. And then to choose to play music.

Alarm screen brightness adjustment

Tap to adjust the brightness of the screen, long press will only display the date and time, the background is black, and then touch screen in any one position restoring brightness.

Set the alarm clock

- Tap to alarm clock setting
- Tap to open or close the alarm, if the icon is green lines, representing the alarm clock has been opened.
- Touch a alarm can reset the time and other parameters, or tap

Tap **Time** to set the alarm time.

Tap Ringtone select alarm ring

Tap **Repeat** to the set alarm repeat time.

Tap Label to the alarm name

If set to end, tap finish.

The alarm interface, Tap , then select the settings to change the alarm set

Tips ✓ represents this option has been activated

When the alarm rang, Touch the pause again ring or cancel.

Calculator

You can use the Calculator to perform simply and advanced arithmetical calculations.

- From a Home screen or Application menu, tap Calculator to enter.
- Tap on the numbers and mathematical operators to perform simple calculations.
- Press Menu key or tap to pop up a menu bar, tap Advanced panel to access operators such as sin, cos, tan, log etc.

 To clear calculation histories, tap

 Press Menu key or tap to exit and return to previous screen.

Appinstaller

The downloaded and installed the application management, installation and unloading.

From a Home screen or Application menu, tap **ApkInstaller** to enter



Select an application device source, memory or SD card, and then into the list of applications

Select and touch an application program, and then select the install or Cancel, touch to confirm.

Or in the application list interface, Tick the application, then the tap popup menu:

Install/Unstall: To install or uninstall the selected application program

Select all: Select all applications

Unselect all: Deselect all

Fresh: Refresh the list of applications

- Select file management, and then Touch the corresponding icon editing management


