Choose from a variety of music sources, including CD/ CD-R / CD-RW / MP3/ WMA formatted Discs, AM/FM Stereo Radio, Audio devices through Line In port and wireless streaming from Bluetooth-enabled devices. Please follow these operational instructions carefully. Save them for future reference.

POWER SUPPLY

Before first use, check that the rated voltage of the unit matches your

- Connect AC adaptor and power cord to AC socket bk and plug into
- When using batteries, disconnect the AC power cord. Battery power will automatically cut off when cord is connected.
- Insert 8 "C" size batteries (not included). When the volume decreases, or the sound starts to distort, replace all of the batteries with new ones.

BATTERY PRECAUTIONS

OPERATION

Pair a Bluetooth-Enabled Mobile Device

- 2. Press CD/BT button 4 for two seconds and Standby LED 4 will rapidly blink Blue. The unit will automatically search for and pair a Bluetoothenabled device.
- 3. Turn on your mobile device's Bluetooth option in settings to search for a discoverable device with a Bluetooth signal. Select "MRX-MP3862" from the device results on your smartphone or tablet.
- 4. When the Bluetooth connection is enabled and the Stereo/BT indicator 19 will light solid when successfully paired.
- 5. Use "0000" if a pairing code is necessary on your mobile device. Find your music selection on your mobile device, select play and enjoy! 6. While connected via Bluetooth, press the Play/Pause button to Play or
- 7. To disconnect from paired Bluetooth device, press and hold PLAY button " 16. If connection is lost after successful pairing, check to make sure the distance between speaker and Bluetooth-enabled device does not exceed 33 feet /10 meters.

Pause and the **Skip** 11 / 12 buttons to go back or advance tracks.

HOW TO USE THE MEMOREX MP3862

CD Player Operation (CD/CD-R/CD-RW)

- 1. Turn on MP3862 by pressing **Standby** button 9
- 2. Press CD/BT 4 and gently lift the CD Door 2
- 3. Insert a disc label side up, close door and press Play/Pause button 10
- 4. Press the **Skip** 11 and 12 buttons to play previous or next track. Press and hold the Skip 11 buttons to search track or within track.
- 5. Press the Mode "M" button 16 to REPEAT a single track, the repeat icon (single arrow) will appear in the display. Press a second time to repeat all tracks, REPEAT ALL PLAY (icon with double arrow) will appear in the display. Press M 16 again to cancel Repeat playback.
- 6. While in the Stop mode, press the **Program** button "P" to enter the Program setting mode. Select a track using the **Skip** 11 / 12 buttons then press the **Program** button 10 again to save the song. Repeat for up to 20 tracks. Press the **Play/Pause** button 10 to play the program; "P" will appear in the display. Press the **Stop** button 18 to resume normal play.

Note: If the CD skips or will not play, the disc may need to be cleaned. Wipe the disc with a clean cloth. Keep CD lens clean from dust and fingerprints.

Listen to Music Using Radio

Enjoy your favorite AM or FM stations as desired.

- 1. Turn on MP3862 by pressing Standby switch 9
- 2. Select the AM/FM mode by pressing the FM/AM button 5.
- 3. Change between bands by pressing the same FM/AM button 5 to toggle between both.
- 4. Select a station by rotating the tuning Channel Selection knob 3 When a station with a strong FM signal is playing, the Stereo/ST indicator 14 will light solid.

Headphones Jack

For private listening, insert Headphones with a standard mini plug into this jack 20. The main speakers will be disconnected when the plug is inserted.

Line-In Jack

Press AUX Button 6 for LINE-IN mode. Insert one end of an audio cable (not included) into the Line Out jack on your external audio unit and the other end into the Line-In jack 20 on this unit; the unit will automatically enter the Line-In mode. Start playback of the external unit and its audio output sound will be heard through this unit's speakers.


