Charging your Speaker

1. Connect one end of the included TYPE-C Charging Cable to the Charging Port on your speaker. Then plug the other end of the USB Charging Cable into a suitable USB port on your computer, notebook or power bank to recharge your speaker's internal rechargeable battery.
2. When charging, a red LED light will illuminate to indicate that the unit is charging. The red light will turn off when your unit is fully charged(under both turn-on/off speaker status)
3. Use this device in temperate climates only.
4. This device may be used by children aged 8 years or older any by those with reduced physical, sensory or mental abilities, or those lacking experience or knowledge, provided they are correctly supervised, or if the instructions related to the use of the device have been adequately given and if the risks involved have been understood. Children must not play with this device. Children should not clean or maintain the device without supervision.
5. The electrical socket must remain easily accessible if it serves as the means of disconnection.
6. Always unplug the device before cleaning it.

7. Clean the device with a soft dry cloth only. Never use solvents.

8. Attention should be drawn to the environmental aspects of battery disposal.

9. The battery (batteries or battery pack) shall not be exposed to excessive heat such as sunshine, fire or the like.


10. Use the apparatus in moderate climate only.

LED indicator status

When charging your speaker
Red LED solid = charging
Red LED light off = charging completed

When pairing your speaker to a Bluetooth audio source
Rapid blinking blue LED: Bluetooth not connected (Ready to pair)
Solid Blue LED: Bluetooth connected

Light effect (6 modes)

Double click the button '①' to switch the light effect

TWS Mode

After power on, briefly press '①' of a speaker, the Bluetooth indicator flashes quickly and enters the TWS mode. After two speakers are connected, the blue indicator of the main speaker flashes slowly, and the Bluetooth indicator of slave speaker remains blue. After the mobile phone is connected, the Bluetooth indicator remains blue on both speakers. At the same time, briefly press Button '④' to disconnect the TWS connection.

Hands-free Function

When phone or other smartphone is connected to your speaker, follow the steps below to take calls hands-free

1. Press Button '①' to pick up the call
2. Press and hold 1.5 seconds Button '①' to reject the call
3. During a call, press Button '①' to hang up the call

Reconnect and Sleeping Mode

After the unit has paired and connected, it will connect automatically when the unit is powered on and device in range

Note: Bluetooth time out: 20 minutes

Bluetooth mode

The speaker will automatically enter the Bluetooth pairing mode after power on. Open the device to search for the Bluetooth name 'TY-WSP56' and click Connect. After pairing is successful, the LED indicator will always be on blue. Briefly press the Button '④' at the same time to disconnect the Bluetooth.
