

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CAUTIONS IN USE

 Please turn on the TV before connecting the MIC to the TV/Video outlet because static electricity might cause trouble in MIC.

 If the product is not working after pressing ON button, please wait more than 5 seconds and try again.

 To insert or eject SD card, please make sure power is out.

 To connect the connector to main body, please make sure power is out.

 If any trouble is occurred with sound of MIC, please check set up status. Or reset MIC settings.
 Press (a) button and power button at the same

time for default setting.

 Pressing power button and ① button at the same time, the systems for TV in the MIC will be changed into "NTSC". (Press power button first)

 Pressing power button and ② button at the same time, the systems for TV in the MIC will be changed into "PAL". (Press power button first)

Power is turned off 10 minutes later the sign is indicated. If low battery sign is indicated as you turn on the product, the product will be turned off simultaneously.

AV Cable connection: To connect the cable to the main body, push it in firmly with indication surface (\$TOP\$) facing up until you hear the "Click" sound. To remove the cable from the main body, pull it back pressing the removing button on right and left side of the connecter.

Do not exert extreme pressure in connecting procedure.

Be careful not to soil the contact part of the connector.



1. Connecting procedure to TV






- Connect AV cable's video connection (yellow) and audio connection (white or red) to TV's AV connection.
- Connect connection (black) from AV cable to adapter and connect connector with the bottom of the MIC.
- Turn on the TV, and set up the channel with video that provides proper image.
- 4. Turn on the MIC's power.



2. Connecting procedure to TV and audio




Connection to audio is possible with normal connecting lines.

Connection procedure


- 1. Turn on the audio (radio, normal audio, car audio)
- Connect provided antenna to MIC's antenna connection.
- 3. Turn on MIC's power.
- Set FM function as ON in the menu (FM frequency range: 104MHz ~ 108MHz)
- After entering the FM frequency set up, make FM frequency and audio frequency identical.
- Select desired song to sing by pressing the numbers or (2) button.
- Song will be played by pressing the (a) button.


WARNING


1. Names of various parts and functions





MODE

If you press 😇 button, icons of every mode appear on the right side of the screen.



Mode

When connecting USB cable with mic a pc, mic becomes USB mode automatically. (Don't connect adapter with mic)



MODE

1. Play mode (m)

In this mode, user can sing starting with playing.

Also, singing and playing can be recorded with high quality.

2. Recording play mode (極)

It provides functions of play, save and delete of recorded materials.

3. MP3 mode ()

It plays downloaded MP3 music.

4. User mode ()

It allows the users to select the graphic file for screen wallpaper, and displays current use of memory.

5. USB mode

In USB mode, desired files can be saved and deleted in MIC by connecting to PC.

Power is applied through USB cable. After cable is connected, USB mode will be automatically set up as you turn on the power. Other buttons will not function. Data of MIC will be damaged if USB cable is pulled out during PC communication.

TIP

If mode is changed to another, all reserved songs will be deleted. Mode

BUTTON EXPLANATION

1. Power (⊕)

- 1) Press Dutton for 2~3 seconds to turn on.
- Another 2~3 seconds of gentle push of the button will turn off the product.

2. Start/Stop (3)

- In stop mode, it starts playing.
- 2) In play mode, it stops paying.

3. Numbers (• ~ •)

In play mode, each button can select song number.

4. Reservation (@)

- Selected songs will be reserved.
 Maximum of 32 songs can be reserved.
- After recording, it is used as confirmation button in deletion of saved files. (Please refer to page 20)

5. Reservation Cancellation (3)

- Reserved songs are cancelled. Cancellation is only possible when reserved song number and selected number is identical.
- After recording, it is used as confirmation button in deletion of saved files. (Please refer to page 20)

6. LIST (3)

- While playing selected song, it allows selection of instrument change.
- While song is not playing, pressing button displays the list of songs.
- To end the list function, just press the button once again. (Refer to page 17, Song selection-List)

BUTTON EXPLANATION

7. Mode ()

Pressing button each time, mode changes from play mode to recording play mode, MP3 mode, and user mode.

8. Record / save (3)

- 1) In play mode, Pressing & button starts recording.
- While recording, pressing button once again stops recording.
- Recorded file can be saved (Please refer to page 20, "Save and deletion of recorded file)

9. Menu / Delete (8)

- button allows selection of menu contents. (Please refer to page 24, "menu")
- In recoding play mode, button is used to delete files.
 (Please refer to the page 20, recorded file's save and deletion)

10. Up (8)

- 1) Menu contents' values can be adjusted.
- Previous song number of the selected one can be chosen.
- In LIST mode, the button allows move to previous one. (Please refer to page 17, "Selection-LIST")

11. Down (9)

- 1) Menu contents' values can be adjusted
- Next song number of the selected one can be chosen.
- In LIST mode, the button allows move to next one. (Please refer to page 17, "Selection-LIST")

BUTTON EXPLANATION

12. Left (%)

- 1) Using it in selection of menu.
- Pressing it while music is playing, the tone is adjusted.
- Pressing it while music is playing, it moves to "Special mode instrumental". (Please refer to page 19, "Special mode instrumental").
- 4) In LIST, it changes to previous page (7 songs)

13. Right (8)

- 1) Using it in selection of menu.
- Pressing it while music is playing, the tempo is adjusted.
- 3) In LIST, it changes to next page (7 songs)

14. USB cable connection

- When power is turned off, connect USB cable and turn on the power.
 Run a provided program. (Program download – please visit site to download. http://www.koritech.co.kr.)
- After finishing download, power goes out automatically when USB cable is pulled out.
 (If USB power is used)
 If other power supply is used but UBS, power does not go out while the cable is pulled out.

Button Explanation

MAIN FUNCTION - PLAY MODE

1. Start/Stop

Song is played when (a) is pressed, and if it is pressed while song is playing, the song stops.

2. Selection of songs

 O~O
 Desired song can be selected by pressing the number button.

2) 🖅

Pressing button while a song is not playing, the list of the song is displayed seven by seven.

With this display, button moves by one line, and button moves by one page.

To end the LIST display, press @ button again.

Pressing (a) button in play mode, previous/next songs of the selected one can be chosen.

3. Reservation

- 1) Press button to reserve a selected song.
 (maximum 32 songs)

 No. of reserved songs are displayed at the top of the screen.
- 2) Reserved songs are played in reserved order.
- Select a desired song in LIST screen, and press button.

4. Reservation cancellation

- For cancellation, press identical number as reserved one and press @ button.
- Cancelled songs disappear from the screen.
- In LIST screen, select reserved song, and press Dutton to cancel the reservation.

MAIN FUNCTION - PLAY MODE

5. Height of tone adjustment

When a song is played, height of tone is set up as default automatically. Height of tone is only adjusted while songs are played.

To adjust the height of the tone, press 🖏 button and then, (3) button.

To end the "height of tone" session, press 🖏 button again.

6. Tempo adjustment.

When a song is played, tempo is set up as default automatically. Tempo adjusts only when a song is played.

To adjust the tempo, press \$\tilde{g}\$ button and then, \$\tilde{g}\$ button. To end the "tempo" session, press \$\tilde{g}\$ button again.

7. Recording

In play mode, press © button to record incoming voices afterward.

While playing, music is recorded as well. If the button is pressed during recording, recording stops. Recording stops when songs are over as well. Please refer to "Save and deletion of recorded files" for save of recorded files.(page 20)

8. Other functions

1) Instruments change

Press
button to change instruments while song is playing.

Select instruments by pressing the 🖨 button.

There are fourteen kinds of instruments.

2) Special mode play

When song is not playing, press \(\bar{\gamma} \) button to select special play.

There are four special mode.

<1>CONTINUOUS PLAY (E1)

The songs on next list are played in sequence.

<2> REPEAT PLAY (23)

Currently selected song is repeated.

<3>RANDOM PLAY(图)

A song is played in random manner.

<4> EXIT

Ends special play mode.

MAIN FUNCTION - RECORDING PLAY MODE

1. Recording play

- In recording play mode, button allows play of saved songs.
 - By pressing @ button, playing stops.
- 2) Playing of saved files.
 - Pressing button, list of recorded files and selection bar appear.
 - Using (a) button, make a selection, and by pressing the (a) button, play recorded files.

2. Save and Deletion of recorded files

Save and deletion of files are only allowed in LIST status.

1) Save

Pressing the **(a)** button, screen for the memory selection appears as follows.

- 1) Internal save INTREC 01, 02...32
- 2) SD card save SD_REC 01, 02...32.

Press 1 button to select internal save or Press 2 button to select SD Card save.

It is possible to record up to 32 songs, which depends on memory capacity.

2) Deletion

In recording play mode, pressing button, recorded and saved file lists are displayed.

To delete files, select a file by using \oplus button and press \bigcirc button.

In confirmation screen, press
button to delete and press
button to cancel deletion.

3. File Selection

Please refer to "Selection of songs-2 ", (page 17), in play mode.

MAIN FUNCTION - USER MODE

Function selection

In user mode, there are functions of screen wallpaper file selection and occupied memory display. By pressing the proper number keys, it moves to screen wallpaper file selection and occupied memory display.

1. Wallpaper image file selection

In standing mode, ① button displays the list of files for wall paper image.

Press either button or button to select After selection, screen changes to standing mode. Selected image appears on the screen.

If a file is not selected, press power button and

button at the same time to change to standing mode. (or turn off the mic and turn on again.)

If there is none of files, screen changes to standing mode after "No Data" sign.

2. Memory Occupation Display

Memory occupation is displayed by pressing

button in standing state.

Currently occupied memory, and left memory space are displayed.

(a) button allows screen to change to standing mode.

SD CARD

1. Insertion

Open the card cover, and insert SD card to the direction of arrow displayed below




2. Removal

3. LOCKING
