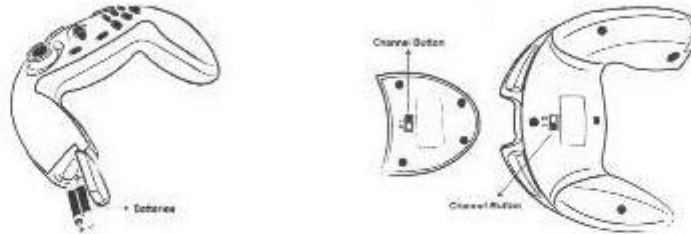

Hardware Installation

1. Install two AAA batteries in this game device.
2. This game device provides two separate channels (CH.1 and CH.2). Please make sure the device and the receiver are using the same channel.



3. Connect the receiver to a USB port.

Warning:

1. This game device with radio frequency gives you free action and an enjoyable experience. For optimal performance, place the receiver at least 8 inches (about 20 cm) away from other electrical devices, such as the computer, monitor, and etc.
2. If you feel this game device does not move smooth as usual, then the batteries have lost their charge, so please replace them.
3. Please do not use the Wireless game pad with a 27MHz wireless mouse or a 27MHz wireless keyboard and mouse kit at the same time, especially when playing a game. If you do, you will encounter interference between the devices.



Software Installation

Once you plug in the USB device, *Windows XP/Me/2000/98* will detect it and install the driver automatically. You have to calibrate your game controller before you play any game. Click **Start / Setting / Control Panel** and double click on the "Game Controller" icon.
