

Getting Started

You should follow three steps before using your speaker

- 1. Charge your speaker
- Turn vour speaker on 3. Pair your speaker to your mobile phone

Charge your speaker

- a. Plug one end of the USB cord to a computer/notebook device and the other end to the Bluetooth speaker
- b. While charging LED light will be red when the light turns
- blue, the device is fully charged. c. Make sure that your speaker is fully charged for two hours
- before you start using it. d. When the LED light flashes with beep, it means the battery
- level is low, please charge immediately.

e. Charge in a-20 to +50°C temperature range environment. f. Charge time: around 3, 5hours.

Turn your speaker on and off

- a. Press the power/answer/end button for 2-3 seconds, blue light will flash 3 times with a beep, and then the light will flash quickly meaning power is on.
- b. When the speaker is on, it will automatically detect the previous device which was paired (if that device is also on and within 10 meters range) and will be paired with the device. The LED light will be flashing continuously for 2 seconds, meaning the device in paired mode.
- c. Press the power/answer/end button 4~5 seconds to turn off your speaker. Red light will flash for 0.5 seconds with a been and the device will be off.
- d. standby status: turning off power after 4~5 minute if it does not connect other equipment.

Pairing with your phone

Speakers are connected to phones using a procedure called 'pairing'By following a few simple steps, a phone can be

paired with the speaker easily.

- Put the speaker in pairing mode
- a. Press the power button for 5-6 seconds, when you see the blue and red LED light flashing alternately, the device is in pairing mode.
- b. Please make sure your mobile device with bluetooth function is on, please read your device user manuals to learn the bluetooth functions
- c. The words 'HKTC-9020'will appear in the menu of devices found in your mobile phone or device being paired. Select 'HKTC-9020'
- d. Enter the passcode 0000 to pair and connect the headset to

- your device, the LED light will switch from the alternating red and blue to a blue flash, meaning the pair is successful.
- e. If pairing is unsuccessful after some time, the speaker will automatically enter standby mode and the blue light will flash quickly but you will not be able to use the speaker. Please follow the above steps to repair.

Call handling

When you receive a call, you hear a ringing tone through the speaker. To answer the call, press the answer key lightly. To reject an incoming call, press and hold the answer key for 2 to 3 seconds until you hear a been and let go.

To end a call, press the answer key lightly, or wait for the other party to hang up.

The voice control function depends on your mobile phone

Volume Control

This device has only one multi-function button, please adjust the volume from your phone and other devices.
