Full One-Year Warranty on Refrigerator

For one year from date of purchase, when this refrigerator is operated and maintained according to owner's instructions attached to or furnished with the product, Sears will repair this refrigerator, free of charge, if defective in material or workmanship.

Full Five-Year Warranty on Sealed Refrigeration System

For five years from the date of purchase, when this refrigerator is operated and maintained according to owner's instructions attached to or furnished with the product, Sears will repair the sealed system (consisting of refrigerant, connecting tubing, and compressor motor), free of charge, if defective in material or workmanship.

The above warranty coverage applies only to refrigerators which are used for storage of food for private household purposes.

Warranty service is available by contacting the nearest Sears Service Center/Department in the United States.

This warranty applies only while this product is in use in the United States. This warranty gives you specific legal rights, and you may also have other rights which vary from state to state.

Things You Ought To Know When Your Refrigerator is Installed

Inspect

For shipping damage. If damaged or parts are missing, notify Sears at once.

Installation

Remove all packing material and tape. Install on a strong, level floor or counter. Avoid any direct sunbeam, heat source and moisture.

Let air circulate freely around refrigerator. Keep rear of refrigerator 5 inchs away from wall and provide at least 12 inches space on top for proper operation.

Caution:

Should you turn off the cold control, allow at least three minutes before restarting in order to give the electric device cooling off time.

Electrical Requirements

120 Volts, 60 Hz (60 cycles A.C.) 15 Amps circuit.

Electrical Grounding

Must be grounded. Uses 110-120 Volt 60 Hz (60 cycle) AC. Do not use extension cord. Use three-prong plug with three-prong grounded wall outlet.

Unless the above grounding method is followed, you are not protected against severe or lethal shock, in the event of a short circuit of an electrical component or wiring of refrigerator.

Things to Remember

- Allow 24 hours for your Refrigerator to reach a new temperature setting.
- The motor will start and stop often. It must, to maintain the temperature you select.
- 3. Keep your refrigerator reasonably level.
- 4. Unplug the refrigerator before doing anything with the electrical system.

Use and Care Information

Tips on Everyday Care and Use

To control the temperature: At first, set the Cold Control on "3". Wait 24 hours for the entire cabinet to cool. Then adjust control, if needed. Setting the Cold Control to "MIN" is the warmest setting. Setting the Cold Control to "MAX" is the coldest. This setting may reduce temperature below freezing, but will not cool refrigerator faster.

Fresh food section should be as cold as possible with freezing vegtables or milk. Adjust as necessary.

Defrost when ¼" frost forms. Set the temperature control dial to "OFF", for defrosting. Remove food. Do not touch freezing plate with bare hands. Do not use electric defrost devices or hair dryers to melt frost. They may damage plastic parts.

When defrosting is completed, wipe the freezing plate dry and reset the control dial. Replace food.

For all cleaning: Mix 2 tablespoons baking soda with 1 quart warm water or use a mild soap. Do not use strong cleaners, scouring powder or pads. For persistent odors, Sears' Service Department has odor removal products. Do not put the drip tray in dishwasher. Vacuum the tubing on outside back when dusty.

Before Calling for Service

Check the plug and fuse. Test the outlet with lamp. Be sure the control is set to on. Read all USE AND CARE INFORMATION. It may answer questions. If not, find your model number (on upper back of refrigerator). Refer your number and problem to the nearest Sears Service Center/ Department.

DANGER-ELECTRICAL SHOCK HAZARD. Disconnect power before servicing.

Energy Saving Tips

Ways to Save Power, Save Money, and Still enjoy your Kenmore.

- 1. Reduce door openings.
- 2. Close the door as soon as you can.
- 3. Keep coils on back of refrigerator clean.
- 4. Adjust temperature control to warmer setting when practical.
- 5. Don't put hot foods in refrigerator.
- 6. Don't allow more than 1/4" of frost to build up in freezer compartment.
- 7. Keep your Kenmore away from stove or other heat sources.




