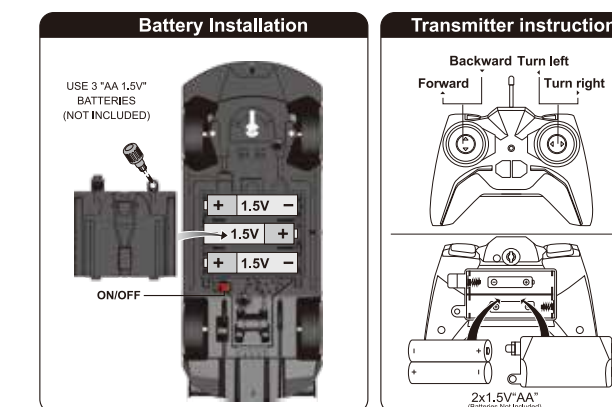
BATTERIES:

- Vehicle requires 3 AA batteries (not included).
- Controller requires 2 AA batteries (not included).

The packaging must be retained since it contains important information.

Caution:

1. Only adults should install and replace batteries.
2. Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.
3. Rechargeable batteries are to be removed from the toy before being charged.
4. Non-rechargeable batteries are not to be recharged.
5. If the device is not used for a long time, remove the batteries.
6. Do not mix old and new batteries.
7. Do not mix alkaline, standard (Carbon Zinc) or rechargeable (Nickel Cadmium) batteries.
8. Exhausted batteries are to be removed from the toy.
9. The supply terminals are not to be short-circuited.
10. Only batteries of the same or equivalent type are recommended to be used.
11. Batteries are to be inserted with the correct polarity.
12. Do not dispose of batteries in the fire. Batteries may explode or leak.
13. Batteries may explode or leak if misused.
