INTRODUCTION

Big Wheelie Cycle is a unique child's motorcycle toy that does "wheelies" on command. The two button controller is easy to use for a preschooler.

CONTROLLER

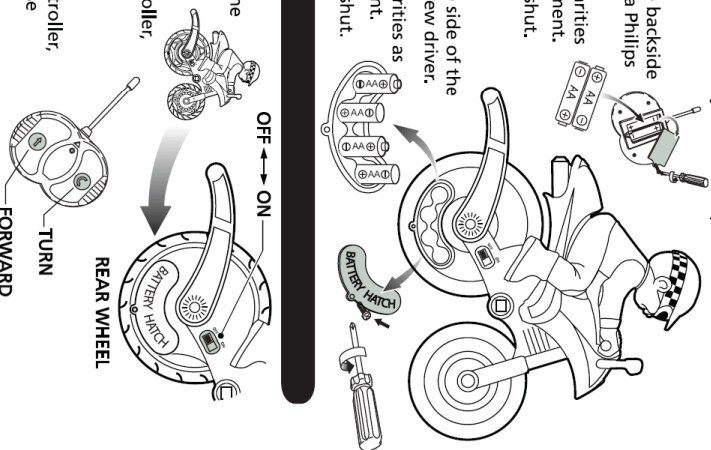
- Unscrew the battery cover on the backside of the handheld controller with a Phillips screw driver.
- Insert 2 "AA" batteries with polarities as shown inside battery compartment.
- Replace battery cover and screw shut.

CYCLE

- Unscrew the battery cover on the side of the cycle rear wheel with a Phillips screw driver.
- Insert 4 "AA" batteries with polarities as shown inside battery compartment.
- Replace battery cover and screw shut.

OPERATION

- Turn **Big Wheelie** over and slide the switch to the "on" position.
- Press the left button on the controller, the cycle will do a "wheelie" and move forward.
- Press the right button on the controller, the cycle will turn until you release the button.
- Your Big Wheelie operates by radio waves. It is possible that it may not perform properly due to interference from devices as cordless phones, hair dryer, radio, walkie talkie or other radio controlled toys.



WARNING!

PLEASE READ THIS CAREFULLY BEFORE USING.

- Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Do not mix alkaline, standard (Carbon-Zinc), or rechargeable (Ni-Cad) batteries
- Battery insertion must be done by an adult.
- Do not short circuit battery contacts.
- Dispose of batteries safely and correctly.
- Do not attempt to burn batteries. Remove exhausted batteries.
- Remove batteries if the product will not be used for a long period of time.
- If your Big Wheelie Cycle becomes stuck under furniture, always ask an adult for help to retrieve it.
- When you are driving your Big Wheelie Cycle, always keep it in your sight.
- Keep your hair and clothing away from the spinning wheels.
- There are small parts included in this product. Do not put any of the parts in your mouth.
- Keep away from fire or hot and/or humid environments.
- Do not disassemble the product.
- Do not use other chargers with your product. Doing so will damage your Big Wheelie Cycle!
