## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

### Remote Controller

- Unscrew back compartment with a phillips screwdriver to open battery door.
- Install 1.9V battery with polarity as shown inside battery compartment.

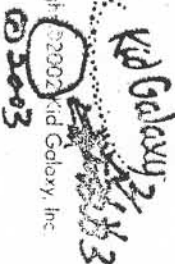
### Vehicle

- Unscrew back compartment with a phillips screwdriver to open battery door.
- Install 3 -AA batteries with polarities shown inside battery compartment.
- **Race Car and Airplane** - Push driver down to turn the vehicle on. Push the driver down again to switch the vehicle off.
- **Dump Truck and Excavator** - Turn switch to ON to start the vehicle.

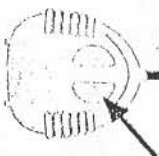
The radio circuitry in your vehicle and remote control is sensitive. Radio interference can affect the control of your vehicles. You may have to choose another location to operate your vehicles.
