Hatching A Surprise Pet Egg

- Press the B Button to start the process. You will hear instructions in the voice of Barbie telling you what to do.
- Put the Surprise Pet Egg into the incubator (match arrow on egg to line on base) if you want to hatch a new pet.
- Depending on Barbie's suggestion, press the Heart Button to heal the egg, the Feeding Button to feed it, the Music Button to play music, the Heatlamp Button to heat the egg or the MIC Button to talk to the egg.
- Repeat until the egg shell opens then you can see the Pet you've hatched.
- 5. To re-hatch a pet, place a pet in the egg and close it. Place in the incubator as in step 2.

TIP: Is there something in the egg? Shake it find out!

Playing with your hatched Surprise Pet

- Place a pet on swing and you will hear a swing sound effect.
- Place a pet on the slide and you will hear a falling sound effect.
- Once the pet slides into the swimming pool, you will hear its crying sound and sound effect.
- To feed your pet, bring it into the feeding area, you will hear the pet's sound and then feeding sounds.
 To give your pet a drink, bring it to the drinking fountain and press down on the drinking fountain. You will hear drinking sounds.

Maintenance



Playset Assembly

Your Surprise Pet Playset comes complete with everything you need to start having fun fast, but first you need to assemble a few items.

- 1 Tree House Top: Place the three pegs of the green treehouse top piece into the matching holes at the top of the treehouse elevator.
- 2 Treehouse Roof Supports Insert the two roof supports by placing the notched ends into the holes on the platform and the other ends into the holes on the Treehouse roof.
- 3 Trees Place the tree with the post and the slot in its base in the hole on the play park base next to the swing, fitting the post into the end of the tree limb holding the swing. Place the other tree in the base behind the incubator.
- 4 Play Park Sign Place the play park sign in the slot on top of Barbie's information booth.
- 5 Flag Place the flag in the hole on the back corner of the treehouse top.
