- When the battery power is Low, the LCD display will keep blinking. Please download all photos from the camera onto your computer as soon as possible as the photos will be lost when battery is low or removed.
- If you do not use the camera for a long time, please take out the battery.
- Please follow local regulations when disposing of used batteries.
- For safety reason, the battery chamber is secured with a screw. Please use a screwdriver to open and close the battery door when changing the battery.
- When the camera is connected to a computer via the USB cable, it will draw its power from the computer, and not from the battery.
- Before using the PC - Cam function, please download all photos in the camera onto your computer to avoid losing any photos.

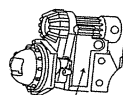

### Getting Start!

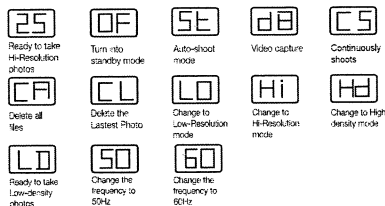
- Load battery to the correct polarity marked on the battery door.
- Turn the camera on by pressing MODE button.

### Selecting Camera Functions

Press the Mode button to cycle through these functions on the LCD display:



Press shutter button to take photo or select mode.

\*For best results in rooms with fluorescent lighting, use the 60Hz setting in the U.S., Canada, Mexico, and West of Japan; and 50Hz in Europe, Australia, Africa, China, and East of Japan.

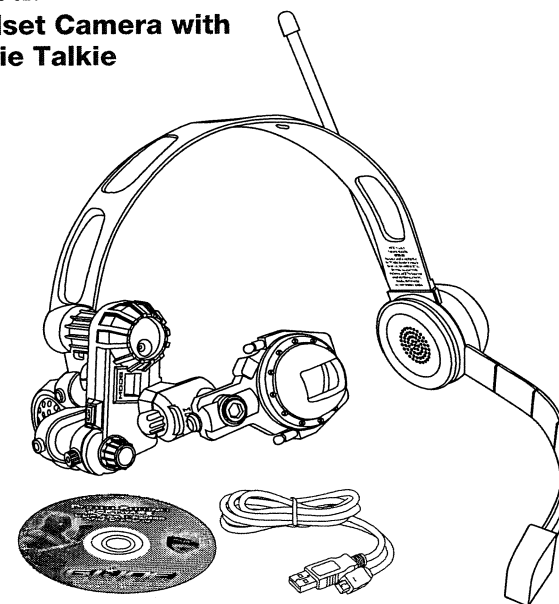
### Taking Photos

- Press "Mode" button to turn on the camera. The camera is set to take high resolution photo. The number of images that have been taken will also be shown on the LCD screen.
- Frame your subject by using the camera viewfinder.
- Hold camera steady.
- Press the "Shutter" button. A beeping sound will tell you photo has been taken, and the number on the LCD screen will go up by one.
- When you choose the "CS" mode, you will take three photos continuously.

### Important Message to Customers

This will help you explain to the child the safe and proper way to use this toy, and to help give it the long-lasting life that our products are designed for.

## Getting Started

### Installing the Batteries

Note: Batteries should always be installed by an adult.

- 1 Use a Phillips screwdriver to open the battery compartment door located on the back of the unit.
- 2 Insert 4 new LR44 batteries into Walkie Talkie and 1 AAA (R3) battery into digital Camera with + and - terminals as indicated in the compartment.
- 3 Replace the compartment door and tighten the screw with a Phillips screwdriver. Do not over-tighten the screw.

### For the Best Possible Performance

- We recommend the use of alkaline batteries for longer life.
- Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium) batteries.
- Batteries are to be inserted with correct polarity.
- Remove exhausted batteries from the unit.
- Do not attempt to recharge non-rechargeable batteries.
- Remove the rechargeable batteries from the unit before charging.
- The supply terminals are not to be short-circuited.
- Batteries should be removed if the item will not be used for an extended period of time, such as a month or longer, to prevent battery leakage or damage.
- Rechargeable batteries should only be charged under adult supervision.
- Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used.

### Power On/Off to Walkie Talkie

- Slide **Talk/Off/SFX Switch** to the left to activate the Walkie Talkies.
- Both Walkie Talkies must be turned on in order to send and receive messages.
- Slide **Talk/Off/SFX Switch** to the middle to shut off the Walkie Talkies.

### Sending Voice Messages

Press and hold the **Talk Button** while speaking into the Microphone.

#### You Should Know

For clear transmission, keep the Microphone approximately two inches from your mouth.

### Receiving Messages

- Walkie Talkies must be turned on in order to send and receive messages.
- Messages cannot be received while your **Talk Button** is being pressed.
- Messages can be heard through the Speaker.

## G.I.Joe SFX

Slide **Talk/Off/SFX Switch** to SFX. Please **Talk Button** to listen advices from G.I. Joe.

### Playing Walkie Talkie Games

Walkie Talkies can be used for all kinds of fun games and activities. Here are two suggestions:

#### Hide and Seek

Just like regular Hide and Seek, but with a twist: the "Hider" can send clues to the "Seeker" using the Walkie Talkies.

#### Mystery Sounds

Can you recognize the mystery sound? One kid sends a sound over the Walkie Talkies, while another tries to guess what the sound is. Examples can include an animal, song, TV show, or anything else!

## Maintenance

It is important to keep the Walkie Talkies as dry and clean as possible. You may clean the cabinet with a cloth or sponge moistened with mild soap and water. Do not attempt to use strong cleansers or solvents, as they may cause damage.

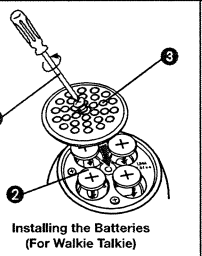
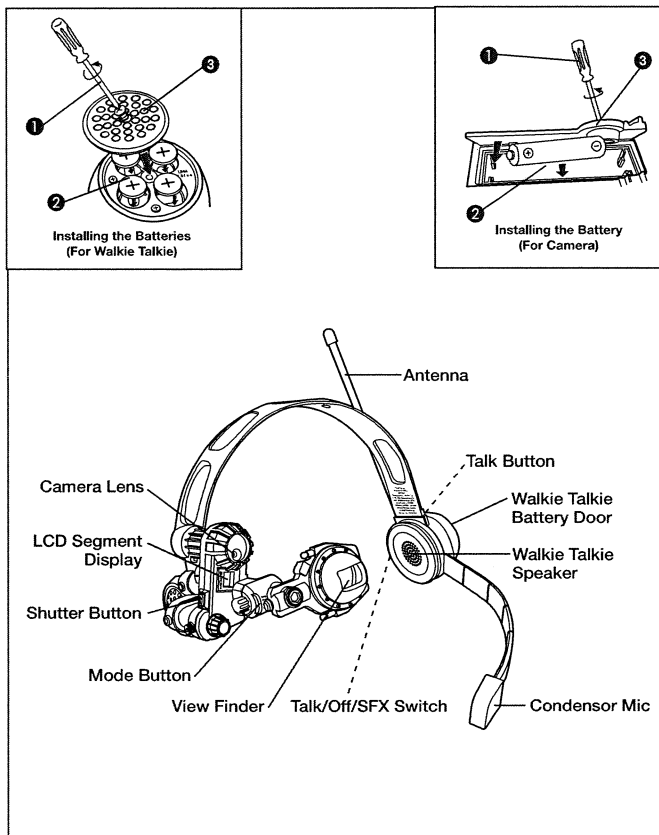
## Troubleshooting

If one or both of the Walkie Talkies do not work, this may indicate that the batteries are weak. Insert 4 new LR44 batteries into each unit.

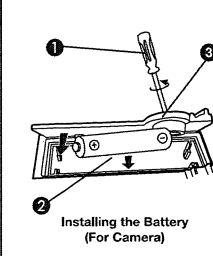
If the signal range of the Walkie Talkies decreases notably, this may again be an indication that the batteries are weak. Insert 4 new LR44 batteries into each unit. Please keep in mind that this product does not transmit well through obstacles such as trees, buildings, and metal structures.

If there is a sizable increase in static, it may be due to the proximity of electric motors, fluorescent lights, power lines, or other signal-disrupting objects. You may have to change your location.
