#### Connect to Bluetooth device

Turn on the speaker unit and the Bluetooth switch on your mobile or other device and search for the speaker model name 'ktp-23A". Pair the device. Once device is paired Bluetooth will automatically connect when unit is turned on subsequently.

- 1.**4/II: Power Switch.** Press and hold to turn it on for 2-3 seconds, Same for turn off.

#### **USB/TF Card**

Insert the U flash memory or Micro-TF card into the USB/TF slot. KTP-23A will read the MP3 format music automatically. Press the Ill to Play/Pause, and the to Prev. and Next, Long time press the short time press the and button to turn down and turn up the Volume.

### **FM Radio**

Press and hold the III to switch to Aux in Model. Short time press the and the to Prev. and Next, Long time press the and button to turn down and turn up the Volume.
