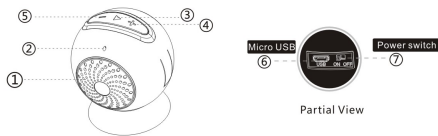

### Instructions for use

Most importantly,switch on the speaker;

Via Computer:

Start computer bluetooth (if there is no built-in computer BT, please insert a BT adapter)-Search KTS - 15 -matching model (When the blue lights flashing fast, KTS-15 is ready to be connected;When the blue light is not flashing, KTS-15 is connected with computer)-so that you can play music via the computer .

Via Mobile phone:

Firstly open the cell-phone bluetooth devices-search the bluetooth outset- Find KTS - 15-connect and play

Phone/Hands-free function:

Firstly check if the connection works, connected by KTS - 15,  
 To press "▶"to cancel the calling;  
 To double press "▶" to callback the last calling;  
 When the call,long press "▶" :Refuse to answer the calling

### The usual situations and the solutions

| The usual situations            | The solutions  |
|---------------------------------|--|
| Can't connect with KTS-15       | ①:Check out KTS-15,make sure you turn on the power,②:Turn off anther devices,and turn on KTS-15,try to connect again |
| Distortion and no voice or less | Check out your cellphone or another connector, adjust with the volume and set the mode                               |
| Sound intermittent              | Make sure you are in the effective distance and there is no barrier between them.                                    |
