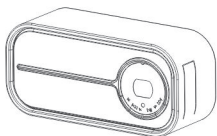

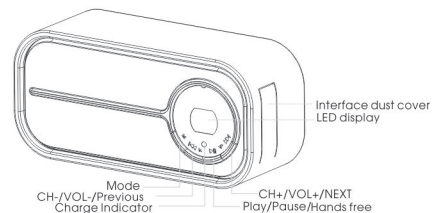

Noted: Connecting the included cable into the LINE-IN port, will allow better station reception, since the cable (connected only on one side, to the device) acts as antenna.

## USAGE

Connect with your mobile phone

1. Turn on POWER, firstly KTS-39 sounds DING-DONG-DING, the LED display is "BLUE".
2. Activate the Bluetooth of your mobile phone, search the Bluetooth device, and then select the device name is KTS-39, whose the original connection code is "0000". Maybe it will cost you about 1 minute, please make sure the original code, you will find it is easy to connection.
3. Press "▶▶" for PLAY/PAUSE, Shortly press "◀v-/▶v+" for PREV/NEXT and long press for volume UP/DOWN.

## Charging

Recharge and recharge indicator .When KTS-39 is charging, the RED indicator will be lighted, when KTS-39 is fully charged, the indicator light will be out. The charging voltage is DC5V.

## Answer a call with hands free function:

When a call comes through, press "▶▶" to get through the call. The speaker includes a microphone to allow you to answer the caller. Press "▶▶" again to hang up the call when end of talking. Press "▶▶" twice quickly you will be able to redial the last call from your cell phone.

## Bluetooth

Press the M button to change to the Bluetooth mode. After pair the device, it can play the music. Press the "▶▶" to Play/Pause, press the "◀v-" and the "▶v+" to Prev and Next, Long time press the "◀v-" and "▶v+" button to decrease and increase the Volume.

## AUX-IN

AUX-IN, Using the audio cable KTS-39 will automatically shift its status and will become AUX-IN. Long time press the "◀v-" and "▶v+" button to decrease and increase the Volume.

## USB/TF Card

Insert the U flash memory or Micro-TF card into the USB/TF slot, KTS-39 will read the MP3 format music automatically. Press the "▶▶" to Play/Pause, press the "◀v-" and the "▶v+" to Prev and Next, Long time press the "◀v-" and "▶v+" button to decrease and increase the Volume.

## FM-Radio

Press "M" to change to the FM Radio mode. To scan frequencies, press "◀v-" and "▶v+". Begin by pressing the "▶▶" button and beginning the scan. This operation will scan all FM stations and Pre-record them to memory. The scan procedure will take several minutes to complete and should not be interrupted. Once complete, you may short press the "◀v-" or the "▶v+" to
