

POWER ON/OFF

To power ON: Slide the Power switch located on the side of the unit to ON position.

To power OFF: Slide the Power switch located on the side of the unit to OFF position.

CHARGING VISOR SPEAKER

The Visor Speaker has an internal recharaeable battery. The battery must be fully charged prior to use. Charging time is approximately 3 hrs. Your Visor Speaker cannot be used while charaina.

Red light ON - Charging Red light OFF - Fully charged



Via AC Adapter Wall Charger

Using the provided Micro USB cable, connect the Visor Speaker (Micro USB port) to the AC Adapter (USB port).




Via Computer

Using the provided Micro USB cable, connect the Visor Speaker to the computer or laptop (USB port).



Via Automobile

Connect to DC automobile car cigarette outlet



PAIRING THE VISOR SPEAKER TO BLUETOOTH DEVICE

Make sure the Bluetooth function is available on your cell phone. Specific pairing procedures will be different depending on different cell phone. For detailed information, please refer to your cell phone's User Guide.



PAIRING TO BLUETOOTH DEVICE (CONTINUED):

- If no device connection is made within 10 minutes of the Visor Speaker being switched on, the Visor Speaker will automatically be switched off to save power.
- After a successful pairing devices will memorize each. Therefore, no pairing will be needed next time.
- 1. Slide the Power switch located on the side of the unit to turn the Visor Speaker ON
- 2. Keep the distance between the cell phone and the Visor Speaker within 3 feet (for pairing only).
- 3. Activate the Bluetooth function of the cell phone, to search for the Bluetooth devices. After finishing the search, select WS101 " in the device list displayed. If you phone asks for a passcode, enter 0000 (four zeros)
- 4. Press "yes" or "enter" key to confirm the successful pairing.
- 5. After the successful connection, the LED indicator will flash blue.
- 6. If pairing was unsuccessful, repeat steps 1-5 above.

CONNECTING TO OTHER BLUETOOTH DEVICES

Note: Your Visor Speaker can only be connected to one Bluetooth device at a time.

- 1. In order to connect to the other Bluetooth device, you must first close the current Bluetooth connection.
- 2. Follow the above steps (under PAIRING TO BLUETOOTH DEVICE) to pair your Visor Speaker to another Bluetooth device.

VISOR SPEAKER CONTROLS

CALLS

Press the Multi-function Button once.

Press and hold the Multi-function Button for 3 seconds during an incoming call.

End a call

Press the Multi-function Button once.

Redial the last call

Double-press the Multi-function Button. The cell phone will redial the last number.

MUSIC

Play music

Press Multi-Function Button.

Volume + Press and hold "+" Button.

Pause/Resume music

Press Multi-Function Button.

Volume -

Press and hold "-" Button.

Go to next song

Press "+" Button.

Go to previous song
