

Unboxing Inspection

Charging Method: Dock Charger (Optional)

1. Plug the dock charger power adapter into a suitable AC power outlet.

2. Lift the USB cover on the bottom side of the accessory cover, connect one end of the USB cable to the power adapter, and plug the other end into the TYPE-C port on the right side of the terminal. The blue indicator light turns on to start charging (please charge with the device off).

Installing the Battery

For installation, insert the threaded end of the antenna into the antenna port at the top of the walkie- talkie, and rotate it clockwise until it is tight.

2. To remove the antenna, rotate it counterclockwise.

Align the top of the battery with the battery installation position on the back of the walkle-talkie, and insert the battery.
 Press the battery down and push the battery cover downwards until you hear a "click" sound, ensuring the battery latch is in the correct position.
