



- -Test monitor before first use, periodically, and when changing location of the camera.

- Make sure there is proper ventilation around all monitor components. Do not place on sofas, cushions, beds, etc. which may block ventilation.





# Setup & use


## Before using the monitor, charge the battery for 6-8 hours.

Keep the temperature sensor away from the back of the camera.

Step1: To test reception, determine a location for the camera that will provide the best view of your baby in the crib (note: do not mount camera in permanent location until initial set up test is completed). Plug adapter into wall outlet and turn camera power on.

Step2: Press and hold the Power / Video button on monitor for 5 seconds until the AXYUE showed on the screen. Video should immediately appear on screen. If video does not appear, go to 'To pair monitor and camera'. If video appears, the initial set up test is completed, and you can install camera according to the instructions below.

Install Camera: Place the camera on a flat surface, such as a bureau or shelf (Figure 1) or mount the camera on a wall (Figure 2). For example: On the desk or cabinet or fixed to the wall, make sure that at least 3 feet from the crib, power line should be placed above or behind the camera, adjust the camera angle, until the display see the entire crib, or do you think the best line of sight.

**WALL-MOUNT** 

- Fixing cable with of 1. Pre-drill a hole in the wall, a 3 / 16" (4.8mm) drill bit.

  2. Insert the wall anchor into the hole and with a hammer, tap gently on the end until the wall anchor is flush with the wall.

  3. Tighten screw until only 1 / 4" (6.2mm) of the screw is exposed.

  4. Insert camera adapter into the camera's adapter jack.

  5. Slide the back of the camera down onto the screw until the camera is secure to the wall.

  6. Plug the adapter into a standard electrical outlet.

  7. Secure the cord to the wall by using the security clips to keep cord away from baby's reach.

## TO USE PLUGGED-IN MODE

- Step 1: Place the monitor in the room from which you want to monitor your baby (ie., living room or bedroom). Plug the monitor AC adapter into the AC adapter jack and other end into standard electrical outlet
- 2: Press and hold the Power / Video button for 5 seconds to power up until the AXVUE logo or video appears on screen. or video appears on screen.

  Step 3: For audio and no video, press the OK OK button.

  Step 4: Press and hold the Power / Video button for 5 seconds to turn the monitor off completely.

## TO USE PORTABLE / BATTERY MODE

## Before using the monitor, charge the battery for 6-8 hours.

- Step 1: Charge the battery for 6 hours at least before using the monitor in portable mode.
- Step 2: Make sure camera adapter is plugged into the camera. Step 3: The battery life can be up to 8 hours if fully charged.

## TO PAIR MONITOR AND CAMERA ( ADD A CAMERA )

The monitor and the camera are paired prior to the shipment. If the monitor and camera are found not paired for some reason, follow steps below:

Step 1: Make sure the monitor is at the same area with the camera

Step 2: Turn camera power on.

Step 3:Press the Power / Video © button for 5 seconds to power on the monitor.

Step 4:Press the Power / Video © button shortly to enter menu.

Step 5:Use the Volume Down ← button to highlight ADD CAM ⊕ and press the OK (SK) button to confirm. Step 6:Choose the number to be assigned on the camera.

Step 7:Press the OK  $\binom{\text{MENU}}{OK}$  button again to start pairing and the red light will flash.



Step 8:Press the Power / Code "�/code" button once within 8 seconds.

Step 9:Wait for 3 seconds, the red light stop flashing once paired successfully and the video will appear.

Long press the button to turn on the split screen.

Long press the  $\P$ - button or  $\P$ + button to choose Cam 1 or Cam 2.

# Setup & use (continued)

The SCAN, SELECT, ADD, DELETE, VIEW CAMERA menu options are used with addtional cameras only. Order the extra camera by visiting us at http://www.axvue.com .

#### TO SCAN ALL CAMERAS (AUTO-SCAN)

The monitor can switch to each camera automatically if it was paired with 2 or more cameras.

Step 1: Press the  $OK (\frac{MENU}{OK})$  button shortly to enter menu.

Step 2: Use the Volume Down -button to highlight SCAN CAM and press the OK ok button to active.

Step 3: Monitor starts scanning the cameras, showing each for approximately 8 seconds,

with the camera number shown on the screen.



#### TO SELECT A CAMERA



Step 1:Power on the monitor and then press the Power / Video 👲 button shortly to enter menu. Step 2:Use the Volume Down (-) button to highlight DELETE CAM 2 and press the OK (SK) button .

Step 3: Choose the number of the camera to be deleted.

Step 4:Press the  $OK(\frac{MENU}{OK})$  button to delete.




#### TO SET UP VOX - VIDEO ON CRYING

When the monitor is working in power-saving screen off, the video may be triggered on if volume is higher than a value, by turning on the VOX function. Enter the MENU, select highlight the VOX, turn on this function by selecting sensitivity - "3" HIGH, "2" MEDIUM, "1" LOW.



#### ADJUST TO PREFERRED COLOR TEMPERATURE

Turn on the color temperature function and select the mode you want.



# **Favorite features**

The zoom option enables you to get a closer view on screen. Press the  $\mathsf{ZOOM}(\ensuremath{\P}\xspace|\ensuremath{\mathbb{R}}\xspace)$  button once to move the image on the monitor screen to 2x view, press again to return the normal view.

## TWO WAY COMMUNICATION

Your baby is always eager to your voice when crying. Press and hold the Talk Back 🜘 🙉 button on the monitor to activate two-way communication. Release the button to end the two-way communication

## **NIGHT VISION**

The infrared LEDs around the lens are functioning to the night vision, which will be enabled automatically. It is appearing black and white image on the screen when the camera is in a low-light and dark room.

## SOUND LIGHTS

The LED light bar on the top of the monitor will light up as it picks up voices. Softer sounds will light up the green or amber LEDs. Louder noises will light up the all LEDs.

## **VOLUME CONTROL**

Volume adjustments allow higher volume settings for parents who want to hear every little sound from baby, like cooing, and lower volume settings to monitor louder sounds and crying from baby. Easily adjust your desired volume level by press the Volume Down — buttonor Volume Up — button.

## ADJUSTABLE BRIGHTNESS

Brightness can be adjusted to accommodate the level of light in the room. Using the brightness control feature enables lighter or darker video, depending on room viewing conditions. Use the Up of button or Down button to adjust the desired brightness.

To preserve battery life when not plugged into AC Outlet, you can turn off the monitor's video by pressing Power / Video  $\begin{pmatrix} 0 \\ 0 \\ 0 \end{pmatrix}$  button, the screen will go dark. The audio and sound lights will still remain activated allowing you to monitor sounds. Press the button again to resume Video monitoring.

## **FAQ**

## NO PICTURE OR SOUND

- -Make sure the camera and handheld monitor unit are paired.
  -Make sure the camera and handheld monitor unit are both turned on.
  -Make sure the AC adapters are plugged in.
  -Make sure the outlets are working.
  -Make sure the battery is charged before working in portable mode.
  -Keep the camera and monitor away from WiFi router (more than 10 feet off).

## SOUND BUT NO PICTURE

- -Press the ( button once to turn on video mode.
  -Check to make sure nothing is blocking the camera.
  -Test reception by moving the monitor and / or camera to different locations.
  -Pair the camera and monitor again.

## PICTURE BUT NO SOUND

- -Power the monitor completely off, remove and re-insert the battery, then turn monitor back on.
  -Turn up the volume using Volume Control.
  -Make sure the camera and handheld monitor unit are paired.

## PICTURE NOT CLEAR

-Position the monitor closer to the camera, but not adjacent.
-Move the monitor away from other electronic devices, WiFi router, etc.
-Adjust the brightness using Brightness Control.
-Test reception by moving the monitor and / or camera to different locations.

#### SQUEALING SOUND COMING FROM SPEAKER ON MONITOR

- -Move the monitor and camera further away from each other. -Turn the volume down using Volume Control. -Power the monitor completely off, remove and re-insert the battery, then turn the monitor on again.
