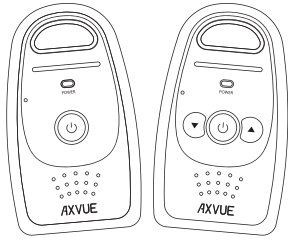

## WARNING

### WARNING

#### THIS PRODUCT CANNOT REPLACE RESPONSIBLE ADULT SUPERVISION.

- Strangulation Hazard - Children have STRANGLED in cords. Keep this cord out of reach of children (more than 3 feet away from the crib).
- Test monitor before first use, periodically, and when changing location of the unit.
- Do not use monitor near water (such as bathtub, sink, etc.).
- Keep monitor away from heat sources (such as stoves, radiators, etc).
- Make sure there is proper ventilation around all monitor components. Do not place on sofas, cushions, beds, etc. which may block ventilation.
- This product is not a toy. Do not allow children to play with it. This product contains small parts. Adult assembly required. Exercise care when unpacking and assembling the product.

### BATTERY WARNING

- Clean battery and product contacts prior to battery installation.
- Do not short-circuit supply terminals.
- Remove battery when product is stored for long periods of time or when battery is exhausted.
- Keep all batteries away from children.
- Dispose of exhausted battery properly.

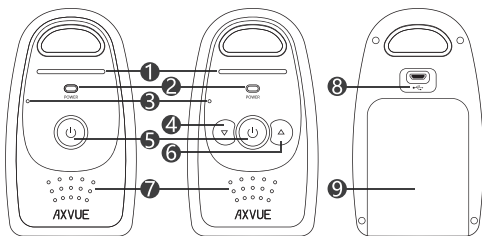

## Features and components

- 1\* Visual sound indicator
- 2\* Power LED inight
- 3 Microphone
- 4 Volume down
- 5 On / Off
- 6 Volume up / Talk Back
- 7 Speaker
- 8\* Micro USB port
- 9\* Battery Compartment

1\* 5-Level Sound Indicator

2\* Green light indicates full charge of capacity and red light indicates low battery. Please replace battery or connect USB cable in time.

8\* Work with no battery, designed with micro USB, just plug it in with a USB cable.

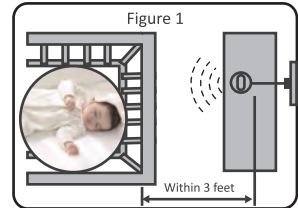
9\* No rechargeable battery included, please purchase six AA batteries by yourself.



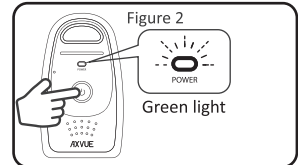

## Setup & use

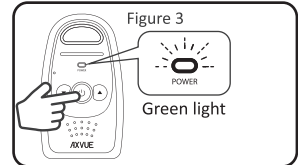
**Install baby unit:** Place the baby unit on a flat surface, such as a bureau, shelf, desk or cabinet (Figure1) . Make sure the baby unit is within 3 feet from the crib and the power line should be put behind the baby unit. Adjust the baby unit until it faces the sound source.



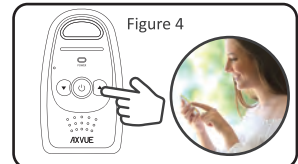
**Step1:** Put the baby unit 3 feet away from baby. Long press the On / Off button (Figure2) for about 2 seconds until the power led shows green to turn on the baby unit.



**Step2:** Long press the parent unit On / Off button (Figure3) for about 2 seconds until the power led shows green to turn on the parent unit.



**Step 3:** Your baby is always eager to your voice when crying. Press and hold the Talk Volume up / Talk Back button (Figure4) on the monitor to activate two-way communication. Release the button to end the two-way communication mode.



**Step 4:** To turn the monitor off completely, press and hold the On / Off button for 2 seconds.

### VOLUME CONTROL

Volume adjustments allow higher volume settings for parents who want to hear every little sound from baby, like cooing, and lower volume settings to monitor louder sounds and crying from baby. Easily adjust your desired volume level by double pressing Volume up / Talk Back ▲ or Volume Down ▼ button.

## FCC Information
