Do not overtighten the screws as this may cause damage to the TV and void your warranty.

Use the screws and wall mounts that meet the VESA standard. Any damages or injuries by misuse or using an improper accessory are not covered by the warranty.

Never place a television set in an unstable location. A television set may fall, causing serious

personal injury or death. Many injuries, particularly to children, can be avoided by taking simple precautions such as:

Using cabinets or stands recommended by the manufacturer of the television set.

Only using furniture that can safely support the television set.

Ensuring the television set is not overhanging the edge of the supporting furniture.

- 5) Do not use this apparatus near water.
- 6) Clean only with dry cloth.
- 7) Do not block any ventilation openings with items, such as newspapers, table-cloths, curtains, etc. Install in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions.
- 8) Do not install near any heat sources such as radiators, heat registers, stoves, or other apparatus (including amplifiers) that produce heat.
- 9) Protect the power cord from being walked on or pinched particularly at plugs, convenience receptacles, and the point where they exit from the apparatus.
- 10) Only use attachments/accessories specified by the manufacturer.
- 11) Use only with the cart, stand, tripod, bracket, or table specified by the manufacturer, or sold with the apparatus. When a cart is used, use caution

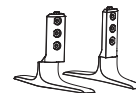

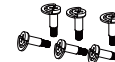

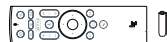

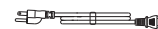

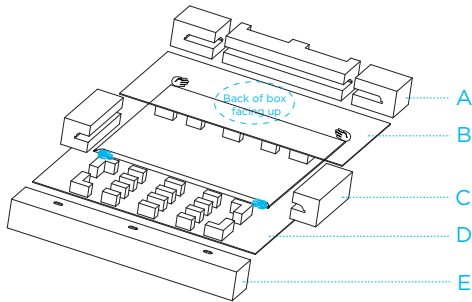

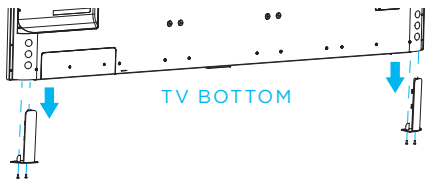
INSTALLING THE STAND



TIP: TWO PEOPLE RECOMMENDED TO REMOVE TV FROM BOX

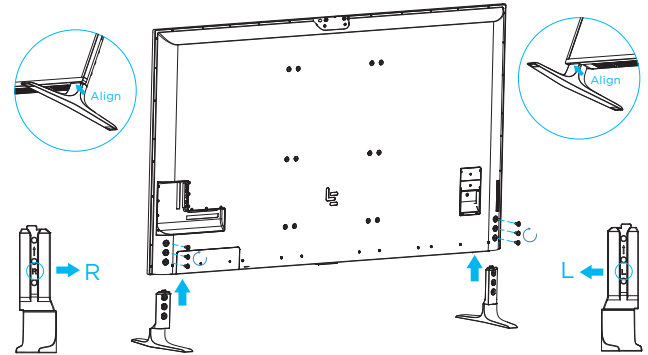


- 1) Place the back of the box on an even surface. Remove the straps and protective cover.
- 2) When installing the TV base, remove B, C, & E. Once base is installed, remove others.
- 3) Place both hands on the box as shown in the diagram and carefully remove the TV.

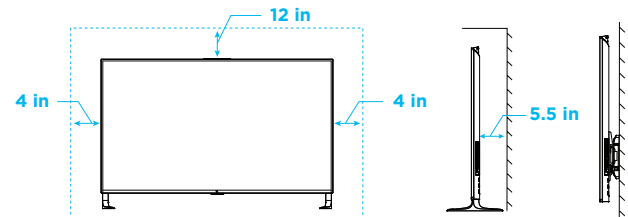


Locate holes corresponding to stands on each side of TV base. Take off the two side covers by removing the screws.

Take the two stands out of the top foam and secure them to the TV tightly with the 6 screws that are provided in the accessory bag.



Make sure there is enough surrounding space as indicated below.



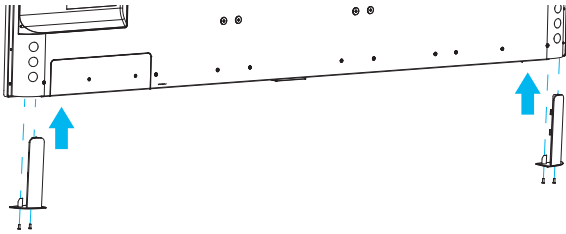
WALL MOUNTING

Please ensure that there is enough space as illustrated on previous page.

Installation will require four to six screws, depending on the wall mount used. See illustration for details.

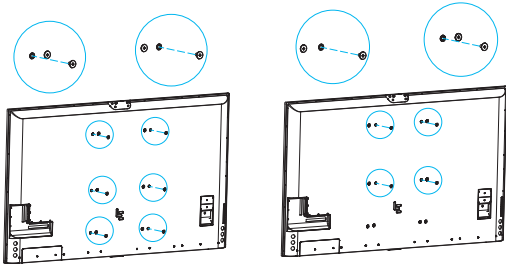
To ensure installation, please make sure that the wall can sustain the combined weight of the TV and the wall mount.

NOTE: Before wall mounting, please secure both side covers as illustrated below.



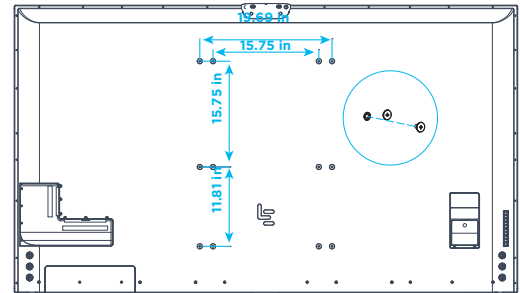

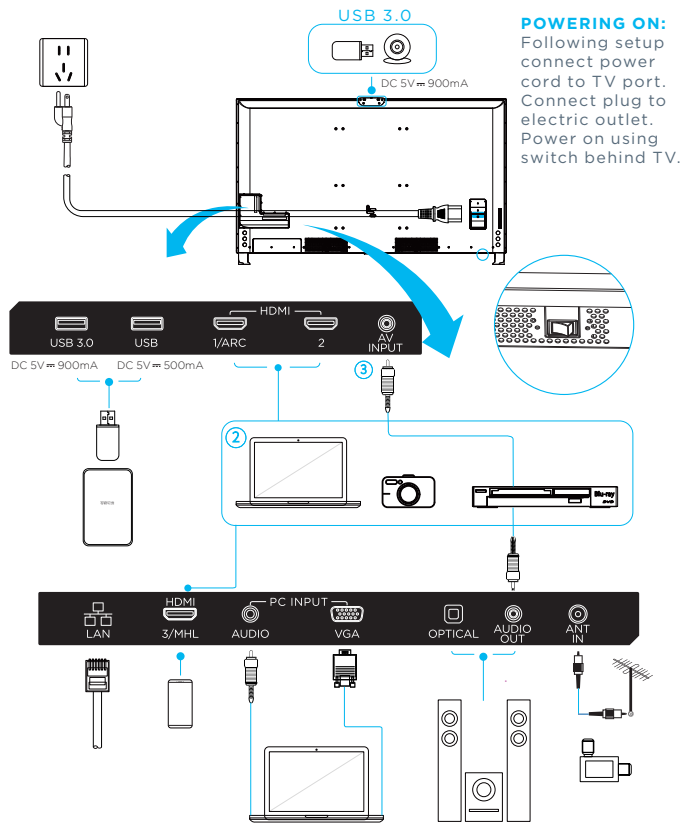

CONNECTING YOUR TV



HDMI: Connect external components (such as Blu-ray and game consoles) to your TV using HDMI.

ARC (Audio Return Channel): Send a digital signal to a compatible device without the need for an additional optical audio connection.

MHL: Use the MHL option for mobile phones and cameras.

A/V (Composite): Connect to an older-generation device, such as VCR, game consoles or DVD player, using the composite cable*.

Digital Optical Audio: Connect to external sound devices using optical audio cable.

Video Graphics Array (VGA): Use your TV as a monitor by connecting your computer with a VGA cable**.

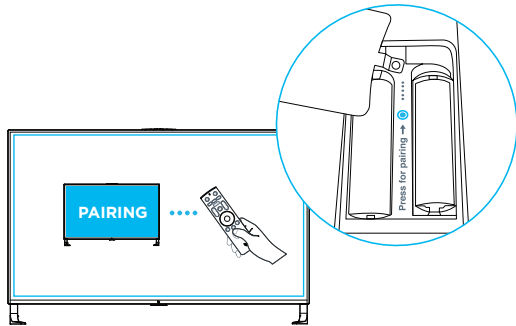
Antenna: Connect to antenna by plugging coaxial cable into the ANT IN connector.

Connecting to Internet: Connect TV to the internet using a wired (LAN) or wireless (built in 802.11 b/g/n/ac wifi) connections.

REMOTE PAIRING & SET UP

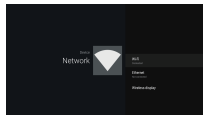


Slide battery cover off of remote and locate pairing button. Insert 2 AA batteries, press and hold button until connection is confirmed on screen.

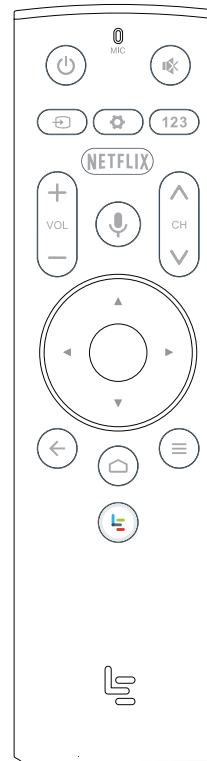
NOTE: In order to connect, remote must be less than eight inches from lower section of TV.

An optional wall mount can be used with your TV. Consult with your local dealer for a wall mount that supports the VESA standard used by your TV model.
