






USER MANUAL



HOW TO USE

Power On/ Power Off:

Press and hold the PLAY button for 3 seconds to turn the headset on or off.

Charging:

- -While charging. The LED indicator will show a solid red light.
- -When completely charged, the LED indicator will show a solid blue light.

Low Battery:

- A low battery alert will play once every 2 minutes.
- If the battery is not charged, the headset will turn off

Pairing:

Before using the headset for the first time, you must pair it with a Bluetooth-enabled device. For pairing the **ZONE - Wireless Wrap Earburds**

- Press and hold the PLAY button to turn on the headset
- If it's your first time paring the device it will automatically enter pairing mode.
- If it has been paired but no paired device is in range it will enter pairing mode after 10 seconds. The LED indicator will alternate between blue and red.
- On the device you wish to pair, find the Bluetooth menu and search for or add new devices.
- -Select "ZONE" from the list of devices
- If asked for a pass/pin code enter 0000 (4 zeros)
- Once the devices are paired, you will hear "connected"

MULTI-CONNECTION

Advanced Multi-point

The **ZONE** Earbuds are capable of having two devices connected to the headset at the same time. This way you can listen to music from one device, and accept calls from another device without switching your connection.

Connection

- -Pair the headset with one of your Bluetooth-enabled devices
- -Turn off the headset and the first bluetooth device
- —Turn the headset and connect your second device.
- Once the headest is paired and connected, go back and connect the originally paired device to the headset manually. This will now be your secondary handset.

Auto-reconnect

- If the ZONE Earbuck are turned off while connected to a device, the device will disconnect. The device will automatically reconnect when the ZONE Earbuck are turned back on while in range.
- If there was a secondary device connected it will need to be reconnected manually. Select "ZONE" from the list of devices in the Bluetooth menu and pair.

Out of range

- If the paired devices are separated by a range of 33ft (10 meters) or more, the device will disconnect and the **ZONE** Earbuds will vibrate to alert you.
- If the device does not automatically reconnect when it is back within the required range, briefly press the call button on the **ZONE** Earbuds to reconnect manually.
- -While in multi-connection mode, if the inactive paired device is disconnected when out of range the ZONE Earbuds will not attempt to reconnect.

CALLING

Answering a call

- -When there is an incoming call, the headset will ring.
- -Briefly press the phone button to answer the incoming call

Transferring a call

If you make a call from your device, the call will automatically transfer to the headset (depending on the phone settings). If the call is not automatically transferred, you can manually transfer the call to or from the headset by pressing and holding the volume up button for 3 seconds on the ZONE Earbuds (handset and headset must be paired)

Last number redial

-Double click the call button to redial the last number called. The headset will then redial from the device that made the last outgoing call.

Ending a call

-Briefly press the call button

CALLING

Volume control

-Briefly press the volume up or volume down button to adjust the headset volume during a call

AUDIO STREAMING

Pause

-While playing music, briefly press the play/pause/stop button to pause

Play

-Briefly press the play/pause/stop button to resume

Stop

 While playing music, press and hold the play/pause/stop button for 1 second to stop all media

Next Song

-Long press the volume up button to skip the current song

Previous Song

-Long press the volume up down
