

**Charging the Bluetooth Headphones** 

- 1. Connect the small end of the Micro USB cable to the charging port on the headphones.
- 2. Connect the large end of the Micro USB cable to your computer's USB port or an AC adapter (not included).
- 3. The LED indicator light turns RED when charging. 4. When fully charged, the LED indicator light turns OFF.
- 5. A voice prompt will be heard indicating that the headphones require charging.








