

## Side View Top View

2. Press and hold the [  $\oplus$  ] **button** until the BLUE indicator light on the front of the speaker flashes quickly. A series of tones will sound.

## Charging the Bluetooth Speake

Connect the small end of the Micro USB charging cable into the 5V:DC charging socket on the side of the speaker.

Connect the other end of the USB cable to your computer's USB port.

4. The RED indicator light is illuminated.
