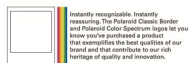

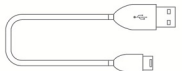

LOCATION OF CONTROLS

(Earpiece - front)

- [POWER] switch: Power ON/OFF
- Micro USB Charging Port (on top of earpiece)
- [−] Button: Long press - Decrease volume
- [⏮] Button: Quick press - Skip to previous track
- [+] Button: Long press - Increase volume
- [⏭] Button: Long press - Reject incoming phone call

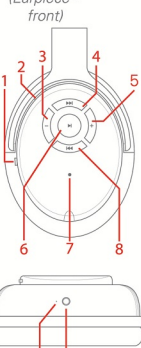
Double press - Redial last number
Quick press - Play/Pause, Answer/end incoming phone calls

- LED Indicator
- [▶] Button: Quick press - Skip to next track

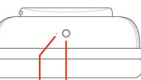
(Earpiece - bottom)

USING THE HEADPHONES

Powering ON/OFF

To turn the headphones ON/OFF, switch the [POWER] switch. A tone will be heard, indicating that the headphones are powered ON.

Answering Phone Calls

- To answer a phone call quick press the [⏭] button.
- To hang up, quick press the [⏭] button. Music playback will automatically resume.

Rejecting Phone Calls

- Long press the [⏭] button to reject an incoming phone call.

Redial Last Number Called

- Double press the [⏭] button to redial the last number called on your Bluetooth-paired phone.

PLAYING MUSIC

To enjoy music wirelessly on your headphones, make sure that they are properly paired to your Bluetooth-enabled device. If you are pairing the device for the first time, please consult the "Pairing the Headphones" section of this user guide.

Playing/Pausing Music

- Quick press the [⏭] button to play/pause media playback.

Skipping/Tracking Songs

- Quick press the [⏮] button to go to the previous track.
- Quick press the [⏭] button to go to the next track.

Adjusting the Volume

- Long press the [−] to decrease the volume of music playback.
- Long press the [+] to increase the volume of music playback.

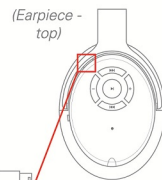


You may adjust the volume from both the headphones and your Bluetooth-paired device.

CHARGING THE HEADPHONES

Attach the small end of the micro USB cable to the micro USB charging port on the top of the earpiece. Attach the large end to a computer or USB charger or to a USB adaptor and plug the adaptor into a wall outlet. The LED indicator will turn solid RED while charging and turn off when charged.

A single charge will provide ~6 hours of working time.

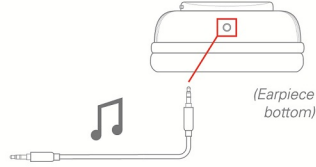


Make sure you charge the headphones for at least 2 to 3 hours before using it for the first time.

USING AS A WIRED DEVICE

Attach one end of the 3.5mm auxiliary cable to the AUX-In jack on the bottom of the headphones. Attach the other end to the headphone jack on your mobile device or computer.

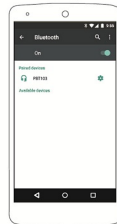
All media playback and volume adjustment is controlled through the connected device.



Any Bluetooth pairings will be disabled when the auxiliary cable is plugged in. They will automatically re-pair once the cable is disconnected.

PAIRING THE HEADPHONES

1. Switch the [POWER] switch. A tone will be heard and the LED indicator will quickly flash BLUE.
2. Set your Bluetooth-enabled device to search for Bluetooth devices. When your mobile Bluetooth-enabled device finds the headphones, select "PBT103" from the list of found devices.
3. After a successful pairing, a tone will be heard and the LED indicator will slowly flash BLUE.



On an Apple or Android
• Go to SETTINGS > BLUETOOTH (Make sure Bluetooth is turned ON)
