In the Box





Pairing the Speaker

- to the ON position. A tone will be heard indicating. the speaker has power and the LED indicator will flash BLUE.
- 2. Set your Bluetooth-enabled device to search for Bluetooth devices. When the Bluetooth-enabled device finds the speaker, select "SBT5012" from the list of found devices.
- 3. After a successful pairing, a tone will be heard indicating that the device is paired and the LED indicator will stay solid BLUE.

On an iOS or Android Device

Go to SETTINGS > BLUETOOTH
(Make sure Bluetooth is turned O)





Using the Speaker

- · Move the [POWER] switch to the ON position to turn the speaker ON.
 - Move the [POWER] switch to the OFF position to turn the speaker OFF.

- To increase volume, long press the [>>/+] button. When the volume is at its maximum limit, a tone will be heard indicating that it cannot be raised any
- To decrease volume, long press the [=\isid] button.

Playing Music

To enjoy music wirelessly on your speaker, make sure you are paired to a Bluetooth-enabled device. Once paired, you can control media playback and volume adjustment with the controls on your paired device or the controls on the speaker


Playing/Pausing Music

· To pause media playback, quick press the [►II] button. To resume media playback, quick press the [>1]

Skipping Tracks

- · To skip to the previous track, quick press the [-\₩]
- To skip to the next track, quick press the [►►/-+] button

7. DC 12V Power Jack



Setting Up the Speaker


To power the speaker, attach the adaptor's pin to the DC 12V power jack on the back of the speaker. Plug the adaptor into a wall outlet.



Using as a Wired Speaker

To use the speaker as a wired device, connect one end of a 3.5mm auxiliary cable to the AUX jack on the side of the speaker and attach the other end to the headphone jack on your media playing device.

When using the speaker as a wired device, you will be able to adjust the volume using the [-\₩] and [₩/+] buttons, but need to control media playback through the connected device
