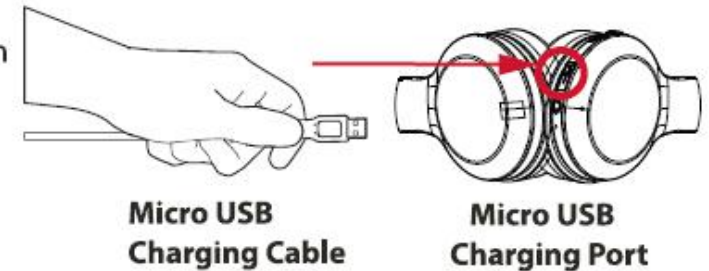
LOCATION OF CONTROLS

1. Microphone
2. LED Indicator
 - Flashes RED and BLUE when pairing.
 - Solid RED when charging.
 - Solid BLUE when fully charged.
3. AUX-IN port
4. Micro USB Charging Port:
5. [-] button:
 - Long press to decrease the volume.
 - Quick press to replay the previous song.
6. [▶|||] button:
 - Power headphones ON and OFF
 - Quick press to pause music.
 - Quick press again to resume music playback.
 - Quick press to answer / end phone call.
7. [+] button:
 - Long press to increase the volume.
 - Quick press to skip to the next song.

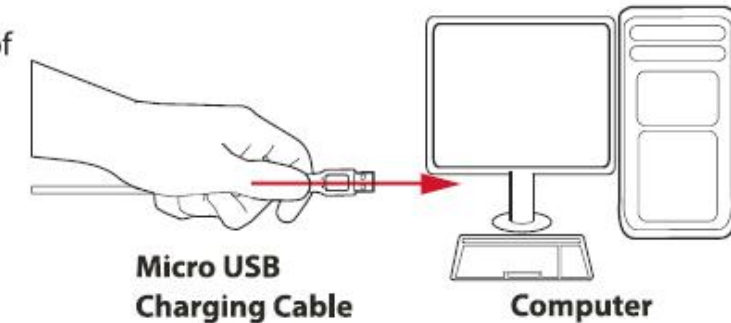


CHARGING THE HEADPHONES

- Connect the **small** end of the micro USB cable to the micro USB port on the headphones.

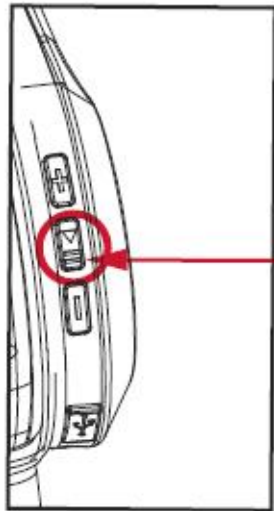


- Connect the **larger** end of the micro USB cable to your computer or AC Adaptor (not included).




- The LED indicator **will** remain RED when charging and **will** turn BLUE when charging is complete.
- When the headphones are **fully** charged, remove the micro USB cable.

PAIRING THE HEADPHONES



Power [ON/OFF]
switch

- Long press the [] button for approximately 6 seconds. A tone is heard and the LED indicator will flash RED and BLUE to indicate that the headphones are in pairing mode.



If there are no paired devices in range when the headphones are in Bluetooth mode, it will go into pairing mode automatically. If a paired device is in range, the headphones will connect to it automatically.

PAIRING THE HEADPHONES (cont'd)

- Set your mobile phone or other Bluetooth-enabled device to search for Bluetooth devices (for detailed instructions for pairing your Bluetooth-enabled device, consult your mobile device's user documentation).



On an iPhone or Android phone
• Go to **SETTINGS > BLUETOOTH**
(Make sure **Bluetooth** is turned ON)

PAIRING THE HEADPHONES (cont'd)



- **Select PBT106 from the list of found devices.**

Found devices

- If required, enter the password 0000. Select YES or OK to pair with your device.
- After a successful pairing, a tone is heard and the LED indicator will remain GREEN.



The screenshots above are typical of many Bluetooth-enabled devices in the market today, and are used to assist in the explanation of the pairing process. Your Bluetooth-enabled device's interface and interaction with the headphones may differ slightly from the illustrations shown.

USING THE HEADPHONES

Powering ON/OFF

- To turn the headphones ON, long press the [▶||] button for approximately 3 seconds.
- To turn the headphones OFF, long press the [▶||] button again for approximately 3 seconds.

Playing Music

- Quick press the [▶||] button to pause music.
- Quick press the [▶||] button again to resume music playback.
- Quick press the [+] button to skip to the next song.
- Quick press the [-] button to replay the previous song.

Volume Control

- Long press the [-] to decrease the volume.
- Long press the [+] to increase the volume.

Answering / Ending Phone Calls

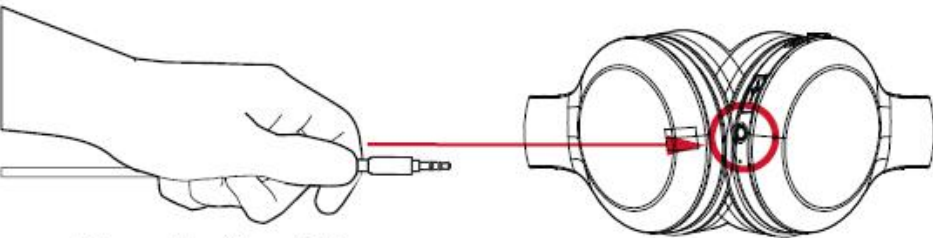
- Quick press the [▶||] button to answer an incoming call.
- Quick press the [▶||] button again to end the call.



You can also adjust the volume from your connected device's volume control.

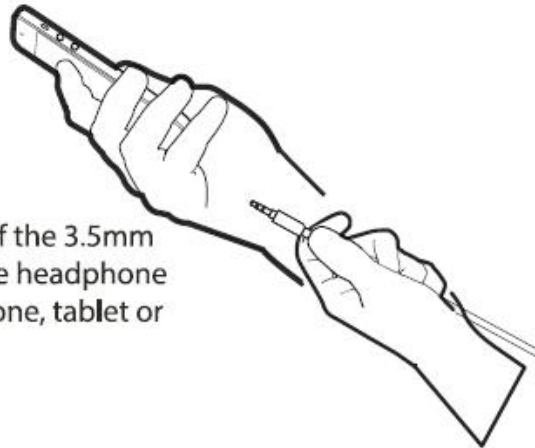
USING AS WIRED HEADPHONES

- Insert one end of the 3.5mm auxiliary cable into the AUX port under the headphones.



3.5mm Auxiliary Cable

Insert the other end of the 3.5mm auxiliary cable into the headphone jack on your smartphone, tablet or MP3 player.



TROUBLESHOOTING

 My Bluetooth device is not able to pair with the speaker.

1. Make sure the headphones are turned ON before beginning the pairing process.
2. Keep the headphones and Bluetooth-enabled device within 3 feet of each other during the pairing process.
3. Check that YOUR device's Bluetooth feature is turned ON.
4. Try repeating the pairing process; see "Pairing the Headphones."
5. Make sure the headphones are charged.

 I cannot get the speaker into pairing mode.

1. Make sure the headphones are turned ON before beginning the pairing process.
2. Keep the headphones and your mobile device within 3 feet of each other during the pairing process.
3. Check that the headphones are charged.

TROUBLESHOOTING (cont'd)

 I can pair the speaker with my Bluetooth device, but I cannot hear any music.

1. Make sure your Bluetooth device supports A2DP profile.
2. Turn up the volume on your Bluetooth device.
3. You may have to unpair the headphones, then re-pair to your device.

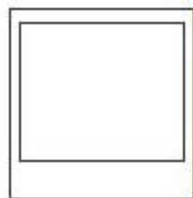
