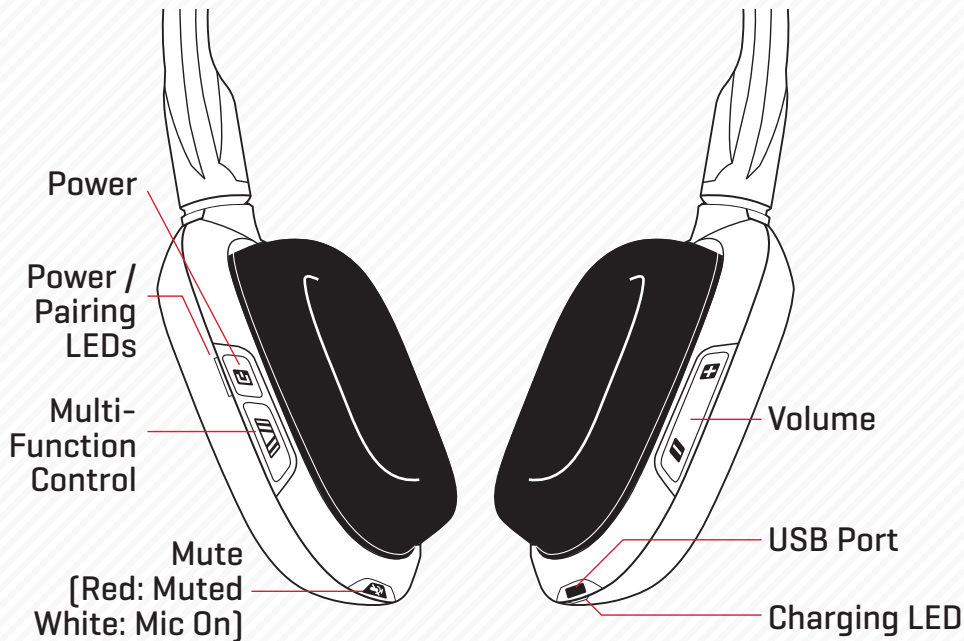
USB CHARGING CABLE

POWER

To turn on: Press Power Button once
[Audio Wake Up Tone Confirmation]

To turn off: Hold Power Button for 1s
[Audio Power Down Tone Confirmation]



Blinks Blue: On

Pairing

1. Enable Bluetooth Pairing / Scanning on device host
2. Hold Power Button on A38 for 3s to enter pairing mode
[Series Beep Confirmation, LED alternates red and blue]

Pairing Successful: [Audio Rising Tone Confirmation]

Pairing Failed: [Audio Failure Tone Confirmation]

Device is listed as "ASTRO A38"

To connect to previous device, turn on A38 and hold power button for 2s.

For optimal connectivity, minimize obstructions between Bluetooth device and Bluetooth Antenna on A38

A38 will auto power off after 5 minutes of inactivity

NFC PAIRING

1. Enable NFC on device
2. Hold NFC device to A38 left ear cup

To disconnect from NFC device:

Hold NFC device to A38 left ear cup

To power A38 on and pair with NFC:

If A38 is off, enable NFC on device

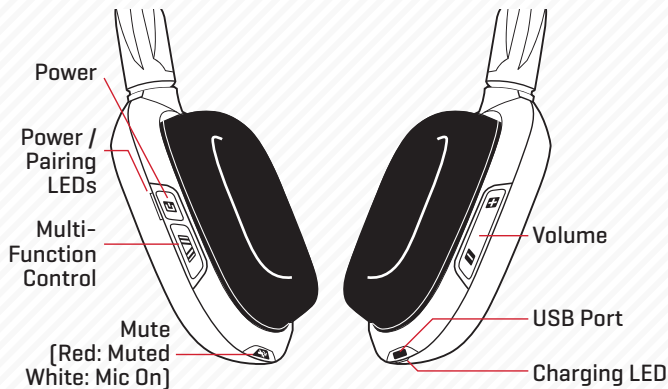
Hold NFC device to A38 left ear cup

A38 will turn on and pair.

CONTROLS



Multi Function Control

Pick up / End Call: Press once

Reject Call / Call Waiting: Hold for 1s

Answer Call Waiting: Press once

Track Forward: Press twice

Track Back: Hold for 1s and release

Play / Pause: Press once

Airplane Mode On / Off:

Hold for 5s [Red + Blue]

Volume Control

Increase Volume: Press or Hold +

Decrease Volume: Press or Hold -

Charging

Plug in USB to any power source

- **Solid Amber:** Charging
- **Amber Off:** Charge Complete
