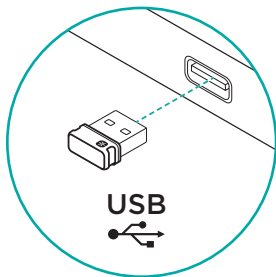

## Set up your mouse

### 1. Plug in the receiver

Plug the Unifying receiver into a USB port.



### 2. Power on the mouse

Move the power switch to the on position.

The status light also indicates battery level. Red means its time to change the battery.

## Using the mouse

### One finger scrolling

Swipe up, down, or sideways on the touch strip.



### Clicking

The Touch Mouse provides full 3-button operation. Click the left, right, or middle area of the mouse surface.



Click the top 2/3 of the touch strip to go to the Windows Start screen (Metro Start in Windows 8)

## Troubleshooting

### Touch Mouse not working?

Troubleshoot the problem:

- Restart the mouse by turning it off and then back on.
- Check the Unifying receiver connection.
- Move the Unifying receiver to another USB port on your computer. (Always connect directly to your computer; do not use a USB hub.)
- Remove any metallic objects near the mouse.
- If the status light blinks red, replace the battery.
