








- 1. Turn on the Keyboard:
 - Bluetooth discovery starts automatically and continues for 15 minutes. The Bluetooth light blinks.
 - If the Status light briefly turns red, charge the batteries. For more information, see "Charge the batteries."
- Make sure your iPad mini's Bluetooth feature is on. Select Settings > Bluetooth > On.

- Select "Ultrathin Keyboard Mini" on the iPad mini's Devices menu.
- 4. If your iPad mini requests a PIN, enter the code using the Keyboard and not your iPad mini's virtual keyboard. After the Bluetooth connection is made, the Bluetooth light turns on, and then it turns off.
- Place the iPad mini landscape on the Keyboard.

Charge the batteries





- Plug the Micro-USB Charging cable into the Keyboard and a USB port on a computer. The Status light blinks green.
- **2.** Charge the batteries until the Status light turns solid green.

Battery information:

- A fully charged battery provides about 3 months of power when the Keyboard is used about 2 hours a day.
- Charge the batteries when the Status light briefly turns red after the Keyboard turns on.
- When not in use, turn off the Keyboard to conserve battery power.
- The Keyboard enters sleep mode if powered on and not used. Press any key to wake.

Product features



Displays the iPad mini Home screen



Fn + 1 = Lock screen

Locks or unlocks the iPad mini screen



Fn + 2 = Siri Siri lets you use your voice to send messages, schedule meetings, place phone calls, and more



En + 3 = SearchLaunches the iPad mini search function



Fn + 4 = Switch language Switches the keyboard language



Fn + 5 = Virtual keyboard Shows/hides the virtual keyboard



Fn + 6 = Slide show



Fn + 7 = Previous track



Fn + 8 = Play/Pause



Fn + 9 = Next track



Fn + 0 = Mute



Fn + dash = Volume down



Fn + plus = Volume up



Fn + X = Cut



Fn + C = Copy



Fn + V = Paste



Fn + Left cursor = Select left Selects text on the left, word by word



Fn + Right cursor = Select right Selects text on the right, word by word

Fn + Space bar = Switch applications

Note: Function keys To use, press and hold the Fn key, and then press a key listed above.

Status light indications

Light	Description
Blinking green	The battery is charging.
Green	The battery is charged (more than 5%).
Red	Battery power is low (less than 5%). Charge the batteries.

Bluetooth light indications

Light	Description	
Blinking	Fast: Keyboard is in discovery mode.	
	Slow: Keyboard is trying to reconnect to your Apple device.	
Solid	Bluetooth pairing or reconnect is successful.	

Storing the iPad mini for travel

- Lift the iPad mini from the Keyboard.
 Potate the iPad mini with the screen.
- Rotate the iPad mini, with the screen side down, so the Home button is on the right.
- Place the iPad mini on to the Keyboard. A magnetic clip holds the iPad mini in position.



Connecting to a different iPad mini



- 1. Make sure the Keyboard is turned on.
- 2. Check that your iPad mini's Bluetooth feature is on. Select Settings > Bluetooth > On.
- **3.** Press the Bluetooth Connect Button. The Keyboard is discoverable for 3 min.
- Select "Ultrathin Keyboard Mini" on the iPad mini's Devices menu.
- 5. If your iPad mini requests a PIN, enter the code using the Keyboard and not your iPad mini's virtual keyboard. After the Bluetooth connection is made, the Bluetooth light turns on, and then it turns off.
- 6. Place the new iPad mini on the Keyboard.

Troubleshooting

The Keyboard does not work

- Press any key to wake the Keyboard from sleep mode.
- Turn the Keyboard Off and then back On.
- Recharge the internal batteries.
 For more information, refer to "Charge the batteries."
- Re-establish the Bluetooth connection between the Keyboard and iPad mini.
- Verify that iPad mini's Bluetooth feature is turned on.
- Choose "Ultrathin Keyboard Mini" from the Devices menu on your iPad mini. The Bluetooth light turns on after the Bluetooth connection is made.
