Remote Controller

- Unscrew back compartment with a phillips screwdriver to open battery door
- Install 1–9V battery with polarity as shown inside battery compartment
- Extend antenna
- Only different frequency cars can be operated at the same time

Car

- Unscrew plastic holder attached to back of car with a phillips screwdriver
- Install 2-AAA batteries with polarity as shown inside battery compartment
- Turn switch to ON to start car




FORWARD: push both knobs forward
