# Setting Clock

1. In standby mode, press and hold the MEMORY & TIME SET BUTTON

2. The hours will blink. Press TUNING DOWN & HOUR BUT TON to set the current hour.

3. Press the TUNING UP & MINUTE BUT TON to set the current minute.

4. Press MEMORY & TIME SET BUTTON once and the current time is set. NOTE: The PM indicator will light when the hour is set in the PM

## Setting Sleep Timer

When listening to radio, press SNOOZE & SLEEP & DIMMER & AUTO SCAN BUTTON to enter sleep mode. You can just adjust the sleep timer from 10 to 90 minutes by pressing the SNOOZE & SLEEP & AUTO SCAN & DIMMER BUTTON

The unit will automatically turn off after the selected time expires.

# Playing FM Radio
