BEFORE YOU BEGIN

To power up your Spider-Man Fire Rescue RC Vehicle, install the following:

 One (1) 9V/6LR61 battery (not included) in the remote control transmitter and four (4) AA batteries for the vehicle.

NOTE: Batteries included are for in store demonstration only. Please change batteries when you take the product home before playing.

INSTALLING BATTERIES

In the Remote Control Transmitter:


Use a Philips screwdriver (not included) to remove the battery door screw and battery door. (See Fig. 1)



- 2. Insert one (1) 9V battery (not included) in the battery compartment with the positive (+) and negative (-) end facing to the proper direction as indicated inside the compartment.
- 3. Replace the battery door and tighten the screw.

In the Amazing Spider-Man Fire Rescue Remote Control Vehicle:

- 4. Slide the vehicle power switch to the OFF position. (Be sure the water tank is empty before changing the batteries)
- Turn the unit over and, using a Philip's screwdriver (not included) to remove the battery door screw and battery door. (See Fig. 2)



- Replace four (4) AA batteries in the battery compartment with the positive (+) and negative (-) ends facing the proper direction as indicated inside the compartment.
- 7. Replace the battery door and tighten the screw.

SAFETY BATTERY USAGE


- 1. Non-rechargeable batteries are not to be recharged.
- 2. Rechargeable batteries are to be removed from the toy before being charged.
- 3. Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.
- 4. Different types of batteries or new and used batteries are not to be mixed.
- 5. Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used.
- 6. Batteries are to be inserted with the correct polarity.
- 7. Exhausted batteries are to be removed from the toy.
- 8. The supply terminals are not to be short-circuited.
- 9. Do not dispose the batteries in fire, batteries may leak or explode.
- 10. Batteries should be replaced by adult.
- 11. Use alkaline batteries for better performance.


QUICK START

Be the first to answer the fire alarm! With you at the controls, The Amazing Spider-Man Fire Rescue Vehicle will be on the job in a jiffy! To get rolling, first:

- Pull out and dispose of the "try-me" tab underneath the vehicle to allow all the functions of the vehicle to operate normally.
- Fill the tank on the Amazing Spider-Man Fire Rescue Vehicle with clean water and close the cap tightly. (See Fig. 3 and Fig. 4)

NOTE: Use <u>only</u> cold water in your Amazing Spider-Man Fire Rescue Vehicle. Any other type of liquid/hot water may cause damage to the vehicle pump.





Now use the following functions on The Amazing Spider-Man Fire Rescue Vehicle and the Three-Position Remote Control to hit the road!

VEHICLE FUNCTIONS


Slide the Vehicle ON/OFF switch to the ON position.

- BUTTON A
 - Press once (do not hold) and the siren lights will flash for 3 seconds.
 - Press and hold and the siren lights will flash until button is released.
- BUTTON B
 - Press once (do not hold) for siren sound.
 - Press and hold and the siren will sound continuously until the button is released.


NOTE: When the Vehicle ON/OFF switch is in the ON position, the headlights will remain on. After 5 minutes without play, the vehicle will automatically shut down to save battery power. Press any key on the remote or turn the vehicle switch OFF and ON again to wake the vehicle up.

REMOTE CONTROL FUNCTIONS

- NORMAL MODE WITH SOUND
- Press the FORWARD button the vehicle moves forward, the engine roars and the siren lights flash. (See Fig. 5)




- Press the REVERSE button – the vehicle moves backward and steers to the left while back-up alarm sounds. (See Fig. 6)



- Press the FIRE button on the remote – the siren sounds and the vehicle will pump water. Pumping will stop when the button is released. (See Fig. 7)

NOTE: the first time the pump is used, allow few seconds before water will shoot out due to the length of the hose.



- Press a combination of the FORWARD or REVERSE button along with the FIRE button and the vehicle will pump water
- NORMAL MODE WITHOUT SOUND
 - The vehicle will perform all functions above without the siren sound.
- · OFF MODE
- The vehicle power will turn off and the battery supply will be disconnected.

 NOTE: The Remote Control will operate the Vehicle up to approximately 30 feet away.

Now, practice driving your Amazing Spider-Man Fire Rescue RC Vehicle so you'll be ready to rush to the next emergency and save the day!
